Last and not least, if you are an Officer or a Deputy that needs to submit one, remember your reports are due by JulyI5th, please have them in on time and cc me in on your reports.



What's the matter with the SCA? By HL Thomas Bacon



In a recent discussion the old lament about the division between fighters and A&S folks came up. (A related lament is the tug of war

between being fun and being authentic). These laments have been voiced since the early days of the SCA. There was even a booklet published in the eighties on this topic. Often accompanying with these laments is a touch of nostalgic about how things were when they first joined. But this dynamic is but a part of human nature.

There are several reasons why these laments keep reappearing. One is the nature of anyone's career curve in any field. When you start in a field, the tendency is to explore all aspects of that field and to want to try everything. But gaining mastery in any skill requires focus on that skill and to forego others, there is only so much time, energy, and resources. So the fighters stick to fighting, and the A&S folk settle on a particular craft. As they gain mastery, they also desire increased authenticity. The common mistake made at this point, is that they then turn around to demand the same level of authenticity from those who are new or of less skill, forgetting their own mistakes made when they were first starting.

This leads to the next reason for the lament. And that is people tend to look at the Society through the lens of their own activity. People like to assume that their contribution is central to the success of the Society. And get upset when others devalue that contribution in favor of their own contribution. This is embedded in people's need to fill important. But all contributions are needed to make the Society work. After all, A&S without the fighters is just a dressed up arts & crafts show. Fighters without the artisans is just a gussied up fighter practice.

That first reason is also behind the sense of nostalgia, particularly among those who started with new forming groups. When groups first form, everyone is involved in everything, and so they do everything together. As they begin to specialize, that cohesion weakens as subgroups form around specific activities. Also as groups grow, it becomes increasing-ly difficult to coordinate to a single activity. And as people come and go, that shared experience also fractures. So people begin to feel nostalgic for that sense of family they were previously experiencing.

All too often these of losses leads many to leave the Society as they perceive the Society as being no longer fun, has become too political, or the authenticity demands become too high. Particularly by those who have not found a niche, or are not progressing in whatever skill they were focusing on. They are not finding in the Society what they are looking for.

I am not sure there is a cure for this, as this is the natural evolution of human dynamics. I have watched plenty of other organizations go through the same thing. The ones that survive over the long term have done so in one of two ways. One is the constant renewal by incoming new members. This is generally how most Society groups survive. The second is for the membership to find a way to tolerate and acknowledge these differences.

So what is the matter with the SCA? Nothing that any other organization also deals with. No structural changes in the organization will change this dynamic of human behavior. All we can do is acknowledge where other people are coming from, and find ways entice them to broaden their activities.

But above all else, pine not for what was, but work towards what could be.
