Happy New Year from your friendly neighborhood Arts and Sciences Minister. We have exciting plans coming up in 2023. There are quite a few events our Barony is hosting, a Kingdom project for our Barony to accomplish, and many Arts and Sciences activities and competitions to prepare for.

In January we have Mid-Winter Merriment. The A&S competition will be an item representing the winter holiday, from any culture and in any media. We will also be hosting Winter War Maneuvers in February, Coronation in April, Masters of the Duel in May, and Valor in June. We will all be very busy bees, so let's start preparing competition entries soon, as I'd like to see our Barony enter as many during this A&S competition season as possible to bring great fame and honor to our Barony.

#### **OFFICERS' MEETING MINUTES**

#### OFFICERS' MEETING—October 5, 2022

University Congregational Church, Inc. 9209 East 29<sup>th</sup> St N, Wichita, KS 67226

19 members attended: 13 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ event stewards; 6 members of the populace; [2 attended by ZOOM]

The Fall schedule is very full. October 22<sup>nd</sup> is the regional fighter practice in Joplin, Mo. This is the same day as the Ren Fair demo in St. Joe that members have been invited to participate in. October 29<sup>th</sup> is Calon Con which will be online. It is also the same day as Vindheim's Samhain in Eldrin Hills [Holliday Texas]. November 19<sup>th</sup> is Toys for Tots with the traditional competition between groups to donate the most toys to the Marine Corps. Toys must be a minimum \$5 value. Cash donations to buy toys for Vatavia's contribution will be collected at local meetings. December 3<sup>rd</sup> is Crown Tournament; December 10<sup>th</sup>, Kris Kinder. Theobald's Winter Yule is December 17<sup>th</sup>.

November 16<sup>th</sup> movie night's presentation will be **Lady Hawk**. Wednesday meetings November 23<sup>rd</sup> and December 21<sup>st</sup> are canceled for the holidays.

The Chronicler's next deadline for submissions to the *Dragonflyre* is December 15<sup>th</sup>. Photos showing the scope of what we do are requested. The Castellan has arranged for all types of Baronial handouts and the Gold Key to be at the Renaissance Festival this coming weekend. The Web Minister will be transferring parts of the old web site to the new site. Items to be posted on Vatavia social media, on Facebook need to be sent to Social Media Minister Ld. William by email or chat. At this time the question of having written permission is unanswered.

Arts and Sciences will have materials available October 12<sup>th</sup> to make Viking glass bead pendants for largess. Currently the schedule is open for classes in November and December. Unused Baronial banner making materials should be returned to Her Excellency Genèvieve.

The Exchequer reported a balance from the last statement of \$17,165.17. A \$500 minimum gratuity is expected from volunteer work at the Renaissance Festival pop booth. Budget requests for 2023 need to be in November 2<sup>nd</sup> Officers' meeting. Requests should be detailed and specific. There will be a finance meeting after the Officers' meeting. The Property Master will be packing up for the Renaissance Festival Friday 7<sup>th</sup> at noon. It was announced that a more economical source for arrow parts has been found.

Sunday fighter practice has moved to the front of OJ Watson Park. Winter indoor practice still needs to be scheduled with Exploration Place. Classes for cut and thrust continue. A future class will be on period training books. Puncture resistance testing will be done by the marshals this fall. It was stated that several members of HEMA will be coming to Ren Festival to participate in cut and thrust presentations.

Their Excellencies will be holding archery practice at Their residence October 15<sup>th</sup>. It will include thrown weapons since the SCA Fall Challenge includes thrown weapons. It was announced that Master Jóhann took top place in the National SCA Seasonal Shoot in the open crossbow category in October.

Her Excellency announced that They will be at the Ren Festival set up Friday and on Sunday. All Baronages are required to attend Coronation this coming weekend.

The University Congregational Church has asked our group to provide homemade bread for communion October 30<sup>th</sup> and presented to the congregation by members in garb. Also His Excellency Lawrence is building stocks for the Church's madrigal

presentation during the holidays. Anyone who would like to help in the construction should contact him. Vatavia has also been asked to help in a Church clean up at some future date.

Her Excellency will be taking orders and payments from those members wishing to get hoodies with Vatavia's emblem on them. Cost is 20 for S – L and an additional 2 added for each larger size.

The Seneschal encouraged all officers to have deputies; and, reminded officers that they can have more than one. Valor bids are due by the end of November. The church camp used in the recent past is not available. Any site suggestions would be appreciated.

There bring no other business the meeting closed.

#### FINANCE MEETING— October 5, 2022

A meeting of the financial committee was held at the University Congregational Church, Inc., 9209 East 29th St N, Wichita, KS 67226, May 4, 2022 after the monthly Committee members present were Kris Griffith-Bumgardner/ HE Genèvieve de Chambéry; Kevin Larsen/ Úlfr Halfdane Amy Dyke/ Ly Tove Brianesdohter; Robert Botkin/ Ld. Robert the Scott; Mary J. Day/ HE Marie . Also present were event stewards Court Dyke/ Ld. Joachim Courtenay der Marxbruder and L. Mills/ Ld. Hieronymus plus two members of the populace.

A bid to host the Kingdom event, Masters of the Duel, here May 6, 2023 was presented by two of the event stewards. The proposed site is at OJ Watson Park utilizing the shelter building near the entrance. Donations will be sought for site tokens, and awards. The site fee will cover the event expenses with the average number of fighters that usual attend this event. After discussion it was moved and seconded to accept the bid and its budget. It was approved. The bid will be sent to Kingdom for consideration.

It was proposed to schedule the local Midwinter Merriment with the Church for January 14, 2023 The last time it was possible to hold this event was 2019. It was proposed to do a committee like last time with communication being via a Facebook group. This event was already in the budget so a formal bid is not required. The Church site would be \$100 for 8 hours with fighting required to be done outside. A recommended donation of \$5 will be requested of attendees. It was moved and seconded to reserve the site for the event and do the donation cover charge. The motion passed.

The question of minimum donations for local events was tabled for a future discussion. There being no other business it was moved and seconded to close the meeting. Approved; the meeting closed.

114 members attended: 9 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ -two on ZOOM; 5 members of the populace

Her Excellency went through the calendar of events. For the Kingdom there is November 12<sup>th</sup> Heraldic, Scribal and Dance Symposium in Ames, Iowa. November 19<sup>th</sup> Toys for Tots in Jefferson City, Missouri. December 3<sup>rd</sup> Crown Tournament in Fayetteville, Arkansas which is not a camping event. December 12<sup>th</sup> Kris Kinder in Independence, Missouri when HL Vashti will be elevated to Laurel. December 17<sup>th</sup> Mid Winter Knight's Dream in Ark City. Clothiers will be January 28<sup>th</sup> in Independence, Missouri. It was stressed that this was much earlier than the traditional date for this event. February 28 is Winter War Maneuvers here in Vatavia. February 25<sup>th</sup> is Chieftains in Bridgeton, Missouri. There are two Society wars the beginning of the coming year. War of the Phoenix in the Kingdom of Atenveldt at Phoenix, Arizona February 2<sup>nd</sup> -5<sup>th</sup> and Gulf Wars March 11<sup>th</sup> -19<sup>th</sup>. It was stressed that War of the Phoenix is **not** Estrea.

Locally the Church has asked we participate in their Madrigal presentation December 9<sup>th</sup>. They asked for members to come in garb, some to do fighting, and have us make some stocks to be used. His Excellency requested assistance to construct the stocks. Midwinter Merriment on January 14<sup>th</sup> is also scheduled to be at the Church. Plans for this event are to be available in December. Details are to be worked out with Exploration Place to have indoor fighter practice there starting in January. They do want the group back. Plans for the Master of the Duel are continuing with four confirmed teachers and locking the date in with the site with a deposit.

The Chatelaine reported that the Gold Key is back in his custody. He will receive the box of all handouts this weekend. The budget request for this office will be submitted after consulting last year's budget. The Chronicler's deadline for submissions is before or by December 15<sup>th</sup>. Permission to publish forms are needed for all items, including photos. There are several changes coming in the heraldic office at the Kingdom level. January 1<sup>st</sup> there will be new forms for proposals and PayPal, like done for events, will be possible for paying fees.

Arts and Sciences class suggestions are requested. Classes do not have to be about making items or take the full two hours. Classes could be about running a list, being an event steward, administering a certain local office, etc. Offers for future classes were made by present members. November 9<sup>th</sup> will be a class on creative writing presented by Ly. Elizabeth. It was suggested to hold a round table to discuss future classes and interests including sessions schedule with fighters in mind.

The Exchequer reported a balance as of today of \$18, 197.17. The gratuity checks from the Fall Great Plains Renaissance Festival of \$150 and last year's Museum of World Treasures presentation of \$50 have both been deposited. At Calon Con the Exchequers discussed online banking. It is allowed as long as there is no ability to move money. Our bank is researching our options. This would mean having the monthly statement in 2 days instead of 10-13 when mailed. Two offices turned in budget requests for 2023. The Cut and Thrust Marshal verbally presented a request for \$100 for three pairs of loaner gloves. It was stressed that the Exchequer is to be contacted through the new address system so a record can be maintained for the office.

There will be a finance meeting after the Officers' meeting.

Officers having problems establishing the new address on the new web site should contact Ld. Hieronymus. Officers should be watching their new email address and are encouraged to check periodically. The Web Minister is waiting to be given the green light by Kingdom to populate our Baronial web site.

The Marshals for the fighters and archers are planning meetings with their members to discuss future needs, what they want from their practices, and how to build back participation post COVID. The fighter practices will start at noon November 6<sup>th</sup> for the remaining outdoor practices and the indoor winter practices.

Her Excellency reported that at Lilies the Vatavian floor section was received. The previous Purple Pavilion was lost when the Kingdom was lost. A new floor is needed. Next week will be a planning session on the 9<sup>th</sup> after the creative writing class. The goal is for groups to have the floor sections completed and ready by Gulf Wars.

The group printing the hoodies will try to have them available by Thanksgiving. Payment will be needed by that time from those who have placed orders.

The Seneschal announced that COVID procedures are to be lifted November 19<sup>th</sup> in Calontir and Society wide effective December 1<sup>st</sup>. Once indoor meetings resume during the winter months circumstance may require bringing back some policies. She announced that she would be emailing officers with the new addresses to see how long it takes to get a reply.

Price needed to be set before the steps for sale and the decision on the method of selling are made. The garages are, at a minimum, 10-12 years old. At Ren fair a potential buyer asked about the garages. After a discussion of new prices, consideration of age and condition, Larry Bumgardner/Baron Lawrence moved to set the garage price as \$150 or best offer. Amy Dyke/ Ly. Tove seconded. The motion carried.

There being no other business Kris Griffith-Bumgardner/ HE Genèvieve moved to adjourned the meeting. Robert Botkin/ Ld. Robert seconded. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned.

#### Calontir's Expedition to Vindheim

On the morning of October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022, a small group travelled South, gathering as many Calontiri as they could to attend Vindheim's annual Samhain event. Adelaide, Randlar, Ebhilin, and Kim from Cum an Iolair, Judith from Moonstone, and Lugaid from Vatavia all gathered supplies for adventure and camaraderie. Randlar, who steered our vessel, reports that current mapmakers are shorting the length of journeys by two full hours, and that Lugaid, in particular, is a wonderful traveling companion.

The travelers did not go empty-handed: Their Majesties Logan and Ylva bestowed many gifts for them to offer during their visit to foreign lands. Their Majesties Ansteorra, Her Highness Ansteorra, and The Serene Prince and Princess were all in attendance at the event. We were welcomed into morning court, where we thanked their populace for their support of Calontir's Tournament of Valor last spring and presented the gifts that we bore. Randlar took note of the cultural reference to the royals as "All's Yall's, with this being just one word in those lands. In addition, Adelaide participated in their largess derby with dozens of bronze bodkins that she made, and both Randlar and Judith came prepared for the evening merriment with mead and cordials made by their own hands. Adelaide has decided that their success in making friends by sharing their beverages, that she immediately began her own digestif upon her arrival home.

Samhain holds a very personal and spiritual meaning to so many, marking the end of the harvest season, and the beginning of winter. Kim's first event was Samhain, and while she enjoyed the thrown weapons tournament that day, the fire is her favorite part. The bonfire was lit shortly after sunset, and true to the celebration, many joys and losses from the past year were shared in the light of the fire. Kim shares, "Hearing everyone talk about their lives in such an intimate way brings a feeling of togetherness: We're not all alone when we have such an amazing group of friends and chosen family around!" Eibilin also named the fire as her favorite part, that it lifted some weight off her heart. She also noted the distinctive yipping of coyotes nearby during the celebration.

Lugaid shared some of his heart over a log for the fire, after which Randlar and some residents of Moonshadowe lifted his spirits and he enjoyed the evening games and fun, well into the wee hours of the morning. There is no pact of "what is said at the fire, stays at the fire," but the gravity and emotional levels of the fire encourages many to share emotional pain that they would not normally be able to express – and then, with a lighter heart, they walk away from the fire and leave that heaviness to burn with their log, until the sun rises in the morning.

Adelaide particularly enjoyed the sunrise the next morning: over a large field, bordered in forest, with the Samhain fire still lit in the center. It is a good feeling to see that fire still burning strong and know that someone who cares about you – about everyone and the logs and pain the put into the fire – kept watch over the fire that burned your sorrows to ashes, so that you can walk light and free into the world the next day.

Judith writes that Randlar displayed great prowess on the field, he was unmatched for three of five fights as the tournament sought the new Champion for the Barony of Eldern Hills (Adelaide would like to note that, had he won, he would be required to attend next year) The valor of Lugaid was clear as he fought with great courage on all of his five matches. She and Eibhilin enjoyed the peace of the site, while watching our Calontir fighters engage the Vindhomies (there was a very brief discussion during morning court on the official vernacular!) and Ansteorrans in a great tournament. Randlar and Lugaid both noted many differences in the fighting styles and customs, and are eager to prepare themselves for the challenges they encountered in the future.

All in all, the beds in the cabin were VERY comfortable, the people were welcoming and friendly and amazing, and everyone can agree that Adelaide is a bit of a trixter that should not be trusted when adult beverages and an internet connection is involved. She is also very fond of long conversations and goodbyes, which occasionally are combined.

We are glad to have had the opportunity to learn so much more about each other, but also increase the bonds of friendship between our great Kingdom and the new Principality of Vindheim. For Lugaid, those in our expedition began as strangers but turned into people he feels like he's known for years! The welcoming attitude we found in this foreign land has us excitedly planning our next visit, and also hoping that many of our newfound friends will be able to travel North, to visit us sometimes, too. As Randlar says, "SCA people are AMAZING people, no matter where ya go!"
