OFFICERS' MEETING—January 4, 2022

13 members attended: 10 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ 1 event steward; 2 members of the populace;

The flier for Winter War Maneuvers here February 18th is done. HE Genèvieve is looking for an individual to take care of gate. This event will not have pre-registration, no COVID check or ability to take credit cards which will make gate less detailed. Their Majesties and Their Highnesses Calontir, and Sanguine Highness Vindheim are expected to attend. Spring Coronation here April 8th flier has been submitted but not yet posted.

May 8th is Master of the Duel at OJ Watson Park. Re-serving the site, producing the flier and creating the web site are in process of being done. Valor is on the books. Deputy positions need to be filled. Ld. Robert is organizing the event. The event will be at Taillefer Farms in Benton, site of five previous Valors. This is a primitive site. It was noted that this will be a good prep for Lilies. Our previous site, Whispering Winds is up for sale. The site prep is currently underway.

The flier for our local Midwinter Merriment is up. A sign up sheet for the pot luck is available for those who still needed to do that. The gift exchange is an SCA, all age appropriate, wrapped item of no more than \$15 cost.

Exploration Place has requested special themed presentations two times a month when possible. January 8th is 'Arms, Armor, Archery'; January 22 Eastern and Western calligraphy for the Chinese New Year of the Rabbit. A new presentation is being arranged on Valentine's Day for February 12; February 'Things That Go Bump in the Night'. These official presentations are set up in front of the entrance to the area for fighter practice.

The *Dragonflyre* for the first quarter is posted on Facebook. Photos are requested for the next publication, especially Vatavians at local and Kingdom events. Members were advised to not check the top choice on the permission to print form which gives all rights to the Society. The Castellan reported that his quarterly report to Kingdom is already sent in. A newcomer round table was scheduled for February 8th. The Arts and Sciences Minister announced the January 11th Ld Torin's hands-on class on fly tying, the follow up top his previous class on period fishing. She also noted Ly Avigail's Calon Swan award and two victory in competitions at Midwinter Knights Dream. The 'dirty dozen' largess deadline for delivery is January 14th at Midwinter Merriment.

The Web Minister has been resolving the new site's calendar issues. It is intended this month to move to the new site. The date will be posted on Facebook. The old site will be taken down approximately a week after that. The Kingdom intend for all groups to switch to the new Kingdom OP system currently being made.

The Exchequer reported a balance of \$17,772.17. Discussions with the bank indicate online banking will not be possible due to required restrictions on administrators of accounts. Our Margaret MacKenzie will be the next Kingdom Exchequer. It was noted that will make doing the new signature card easier to complete. A finance meeting will be done after the officers' meeting to discuss funding the paint for the Baronial section of the Kingdom pavilion floor project. The Property Master needs all officers to inform him of Baronial property in their possession by January 15th. This is needed for the Exchequer's Domesday report. A receipt system will be set up this year to track property.

It was noted that winter fighter practice is not an official demo for SCA purposes or part of the special presentations at Exploration Place. It was announced that His Majesty Duncan with others plans to attend the January 8th practice here. Cut and Thrust will be testing equipment this quarter. This includes jack-

ets that are two years old or older.

Archery plans two classes over their winter hiatus. The March 29th arts and sciences session will be on arrow making. Baronial arrows will be repaired at that time also. Making cross-bows needs to determine a date based on the availability of a wood shop.

The Seneschal reminded all officers that quarterly reports are due

January 15th. The Society Board of Directors is working on Society level pre-registration for events. They have asked to be given three months to get this established. Pre-registration for Spring Coronation is "...up in the air..." as a result. It was noted that some of the major wars are nor effected since pre-registration was set up prior to Society level being initiated.

Her Excellency Genèvieve asked members to check their OP entry on the old Baronial web site before it is shut down. She also thanked those who have helped with car pooling to events. Clothiers January 28th will be another opportunity to travel together.

Their being no other business the meeting concluded.

FINANCE MEETING— January 4, 2022

An unscheduled meeting of the financial committee was held at the University Congregational Church, 9209 East 29th St N, Wichita, KS 67226, January 4, 2023 t Committee members present were Kris Griffith-Bumgardner/ HE Genèvieve de Chambéry; Kevin Larsen/ Úlfr Halfdane Amy Dyke/ Ly Tove Brianesdoh-ter; Robert Botkin/ Ld. Robert the Scott; Mary J. Day/ HE Marie. Amiee Moisa/ Ly. Alia Martialis also joined the meeting. The budget for the year, 2023, had not included the materials for the Baronial section of the Kingdom Pavilion floor project. Receipts were presented totaling \$263.85. It was noted that the cost of the smaller can of paint, being a different base, would not be included in the cost. This would become the personal property of Her Excellency Genèvieve/ Kris Griffith Bumgardner and not be part of payment. It was moved by Amy Dyke/ Ly Tove Brianesdoh-ter to approve the increase to the 2023 budget of \$263.85, minus the cost of the one small can of paint. Robert Botkin/ Ld. Robert the Scott seconded the motion. The increase was approved. In discussion it was noted that the 2023 web minister budget may not be as expected with the change to Kingdom hosting. These funds or a portion of these funds may be available for reallocation.

10 members attended: 9 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ event stewards; 1 member of the populace

Winter War Maneuvers is February 18th here in Vatavia A back up registration person is needed for this event. Extra wagons are requested to help fighters haul their equipment. It is stressed that there is no outside food allowed in the site. Gulf Wars is March 11th-19th. Pre-registration and listing on the muster is needed for the land allotment for the Calontir camp. Coronation is in Vatavia April 8th with the local Renaissance Festival the following weekend, April 15th – 16th. Each officer will be responsible for their offices activities at the Festival.

Arts and Sciences meeting are canceled for March 8th and March 15th due to Gulf Wars. Exploration Place special presentations have been scheduled for this month: February 12th, "St. Valentine's Day"; and February 26, "Things That Go Bump in the Night."

Caltrop staff reported no new items in process. Decision will be made this month for Tove's and Deidra's heraldic proposals; the results are expected in April. The second class on Medieval Fishing- Fly Tying was in January. A new comers round table will be done next Wednesday February 8th. The deadline to deliver largess items for delivery at Winter Way Maneuvers is also February 8th. The Baronial Weekly Herald has gone to monthly posting. The deadline for letters and submissions for the first quarter *Dragonflyre* is March 15th.

Event information needs to be sent to the Social Media officer to get posted on the groups different official platforms. The new Baronial web site is up. The new QR code signs were received today. \$17,772.17. Her Majesty has asked for award recommendations. The awards recommendation form is available on the local site. Questions about members' awards should be directed to Her Excellency or Marie who have hard copies of the OP. That part of the local website is still down.

The Exchequer reported a balance of \$17,772.17. Midwinter Merriment made \$211. The finance committee approved the expenditure of \$443.43 for paint for the pavilion floor project. This was an unexpected, non-budgeted item. The property Master has requested written list of those property items needing fixing, repair, or replacement for the upcoming events and Spring Ren Festival.

Current fighter cards are available online. Instructions on the procedure to do so will be posted. Updated cards will be needed by those attending Gulf Wars. Puncture testing has been started by the Cut and Thrust Marshal. Protective gear over two years old must be tested; one year old is recommended to be tested. Calibration for fighters will be done this weekend in preparation for Winter War Maneuvers held here.

Both Her Excellency Genèvieve and the Seneschal reviewed the busy Spring schedule. Members are, as always, encouraged to car pool to events. The pavilion floor project needs to be completed before Gulf Wars.

The meeting adjourned.

FINANCE MEETING— February 1, 2022

A meeting of the financial committee was held at the University Congregational Church, 9209 East 29th St N, Wichita, KS 67226, February 1, 2023. Committee members present were Larry Bumgardner/ HE Lawtrence Taillfer the Leech, Kris Griffith-Bumgardner/ HE Genèvieve de Chambéry; Kevin Larsen/ Úlfr Halfdane Amy Dyke/ Ly Tove Brianesdohter; Mary J. Day/ HE Marie. Amiee Moisa/ Ly. Alia Martialis and Bridgett Russell/ Valerino di Ros-sialso joined the meeting.

The bid for Valor XLII (42) this May was presented for consideration. After discussion recommendations were made for changes to the budget: increasing the site fee for adults, admitting minors for free, and increasing the tavern food budget to allow for increases in food prices. Motions on each of these recommendations were approved. Information will be requested from the rental service on replacement costs for chairs should the need arise. It was moved and seconded to tentatively approve the budget for Valor XLII. The motion was passed. The event steward will be sent the recommended changes. The flier for the event will be made and sent.

It was reported during the meeting the end of year balance on the Domesday report showed a gain of \$923 for the year 2022. There being no other business the financial meeting adjourned.

It was noted that the Baronial supply of Gatorade would not be adequate for the upcoming Winter War Maneuvers. Sources were checked. The need for non-sugar individual packets was discussed. Kris Griffith moved to increase the budget for Winter War Maneuvers by \$32 for the purchase of the Gatorade and non-sugar packet mixes. Amy Dyke seconded. The motion passed.

It was just learned that a security deposit will be needed for the Masters of the Duel event at OJ Watson Park. This was not known until recently and was not part of the event budget. Mary Day moved that the Masters of the Duel event be increased \$50 to cover the security deposit that will be returned and to document the expenditure for future event planning. The Westumbria event, Feed the Beast, has been postponed until a later date to be determined. Coronation is here in Vatia April 8th. The site is open from 8 am – 7 pm. However access to the meeting hall will not be available until after 10 am. Volunteers are needed as greeters at the front of the church. There will be fighting at His Highness's request. May 6th is Masters of the Duel held here at OJ Watson Park. The site has been reserved and paid for. May 26th - 29th is our Valor event. A work day at the Valor site is scheduled for March 25th. Lunch will be provided. A list of projects for the day will be posted.

Wednesday meetings the 8th and 15th of March are canceled due to Gulf Wars. The schedule of SCA presentations through May at Exploration Place has been decided. Those wishing to know the subjects or participate should contact the demonstration coordinator. The weekend following Coronation is the Spring Great Plains Renaissance Festival April 15th - 16th. Officers will be in charge of organizing activities for their area of the Dell.

It was announced that the name reconsideration had been registered for Lugaid mac Erka. New member Þjóðríkr Ulfsbani proposals were hand delivered at Winter War Maneuvers and are expected to be on the next internal letter. Caltrop staff is waiting for the next external letter for the status of other proposals in process. The deadline for the *Dragonflyre* has been changed to March 20th due to Gulf Wars. Due to continuing address issues for the Chronicler, letters, submissions and permission to print should be sent directly to the Chronicler and not through the new website address.

March 29th arts and sciences class will be on arrow making. Jigs to fletch up to two dozen arrows will be available. Those planning to work on personal equipment should bring their own supplies. Repairs to Baronial archery equipment will be done at this time. A future project/class to make falcon tabards was proposed. The Castellan reported on the Exploration Place special presentations. All the Baronial handouts in property have been modified with the new web site information. It was noted the old QR code on brochures will need to be crossout.

Any changes in the Baronial property in an officer's possession should be reported to the Property Master so that the inventory can be kept current. The Exchequer reported a balance of \$19,979.74. Winter War Maneuvers made a profit of \$1149.39 after expenses. Half of the Baronial tithe was made at this event leaving \$649.39.

Fighter practice at Exploration Place is canceled for March 12th due to Gulf Wars. Practice will resume March 19th at OJ Watson Park, weather permitting. Practice will continue on Sundays starting at noon until summer's start time for heat starts. Participation at practice has been well attended. There are several new members in both styles and crossover between heavy and cut and thrust fighters continues. The Cut and Thrust Marshal has been working on calibration for cut and thrust and for heavy rapier. Cut and thrust has a different, lighter standard from that for heavy rapier.

Archery will resume, weather permitting, at OJ Watson Park as soon as the insurance certificate is turned in. It has been requested from National.

Saturday March 11th the Great Plains Renaissance Festival has invited Vatia to participate in the St. Patrick's Day parade in Wichita. Those members not at Gulf Wars may attend if they wish; there will be no official SCA presence. Those who are not attending Gulf Wars are encouraged by Her Excellency Genèvieve to consider attending in the future. The site for Masters of the Duel has been confirmed and is on the books. Changes in the Valor budget were presented with some items increasing and others decreasing. Some additional costs have come up. The specifics on others still needs to be determined. Once all the information is obtained a final budget will be presented to the finance committee.
