#### OFFICERS' MEETING—April 5, 2023

University Congregational Church, Inc. 9209 East 29<sup>th</sup> St end. N, Wichita, KS 67226

11 members participated: 1 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ event stewards; 1 member of the populace

A very active Kingdom schedule of events are planned here. Coronation is here April 9<sup>th</sup>. There may be a need for guests to park across the street due to another organizations unexpected increase attendance in the morning. Activities for newcomers at this event were announced. Masters of the Duel, May 6<sup>th</sup>, has changed the event site. There were policy requirements that OJ Watson Park had not divulge earlier. Valor is Memorial weekend, May 26<sup>th</sup> - 29<sup>th</sup>, at Taillefer Farms near Benton. Deputies to run gate and water bearing are still needed. Final rental contracts are being done.

Members are encouraged to attend Queen's Prize Tournament April 29<sup>th</sup> in Manhattan Kansas. Those wanting to enter can find local willing sponsors. Other activities besides the Queen's Prize are planned at the event.

Baronial plans for Lilies in June have started. Ideas and suggestions are requested ASAP for a Baronial hosted activity at the event. Once something is decided it will be put on the event calendar. A Baronial encampment is planned like last year. The Baronage would like to hear from those wishing to be included in the encampment.

The weekend after Coronation is the local Great Plains Renaissance Festival, April 15<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> . Set up will be Friday April 14<sup>th</sup> starting around 4 pm. The layout will be the same as the last Festival. Each shift at the pop booth still needs workers to sign up. April 23<sup>rd</sup> is the next themed presentation at Exploration Place. The subject has not yet been determined.

There has been no information on the status of the various Vatavian heraldic proposals in process. Joachim's shield design is now in process at national. The first quarter issue of the *Dragonflyre* has been posted. The Web Minister is working on getting the local Order of Precedence on the Baronial web site before stepping down. The Chatelaine will have loaner garb available at Coronation. A round table discussion and a class on court and feast etiquette for newcomers is planned for that event. It was noted that there are new signs with the new QR code for the new Baronial website. There is no arts and sciences class planned for next week; preparations for the Renaissance Festival will need to be done at that gathering.

The Exchequer reported a balance of \$18,444.74 after accounting for the last War Maneuvers site payment, non-member surcharge to Kingdom, returned security deposits and seed money. Paperwork was received from the bank today; the quarterly report will be done this weekend. There will be brief finance meeting after the Officers' meeting regarding the change of site for Masters of the Duel. After the current events this month the Property Master will be planning the work needed on the Baronial property.

Fighter practice has returned to outdoor practice at OJ Watson Park at noon. June 1<sup>st</sup> the start time will move to 11:00 am. The Cut and Thrust marshal reminded fighters to check the condition of their weapons and to stay

hydrated. His Highness has requested both heavy and cut and thrust tournaments be held at Coronation this weekend

The Barony has 6 archery marshals, three of which have been handling the recent archery activities. The marshals will figure a schedule for a marshal to be available for the resumption of archery practice at OJ Watson Park. Help can be provided to fix arrows, a source for bow string but fixing actual bows is not possible.

Their Excellencies thanked the members for their efforts so far and in the future for all of the Vatavian Spring events. It was repeated about needing to decide on an activity for the Barony to host at the Lilies War to get on the schedule. Vatavia has its traditional Sunday 8am-8pm shift to run gate at the event. Three volunteers are needed on each shift, one of which must be a national member.

The Seneschal reminded all officers that quarterly reports are due in ten days, April 15<sup>th</sup>. Four have been received already.

#### FINANCE MEETING— April 5, 2023

A special meeting of the financial committee was held at the University Congregational Church, 9209 East 29th St N, Wichita, KS 67226, April 5, 2023. Committee members present were Kris Griffith-Bumgardner/ HE Genèvieve de Chambéry; Larry Bumgardner/ HE Lawrence Taillefer the Leech, Kevin Larsen/ Ld. Úlfr Halfdane Amy Dyke/ Ly Tove Brianesdohter; Robert Botkin/ Ld. Robert Steven MacLaren the Scott, Mary J. Day/ HE Marie. Jayme Jones/ LY Margaret MacKenzie attended as feast steward for the upcoming event.

The meeting was requested to inform the finance committee of the change of venue for the May Master's of the Duel event. This change resulted due to last minute rental requirements by OJ Watson Park to allow the collection of the site fee. The new location will be the Studio School at 751 George Washington Blvd, Wichita, KS 67211. This is the same location where Wednesday meetings were before our current location. No budget changes were required. The new site rental is half the approved budget amount for the event.

The feast steward for the April 8<sup>th</sup> Coronation was advised to contact the stewards for that event to verify the approved budget amount for the evening meal. There being no other business it was moved by Robert and seconded by Lawrence to adjourned. The meeting

8 members attended: 8 Baronage/ officers/ deputies

Final plans for Masters of the Duel May 6<sup>th</sup> are done. The Baronial banner will be on the fence outside the building. Work on the Valor site will be ongoing all month. Any help will be appreciated. Valor is May 26<sup>th</sup> -29<sup>th</sup>. A Baronial campsite is planned for Lilies. The week after Lilies is Battlemoor in the Outlands. Their Excellencies plan to attend and request to hear from other Vatavians intending to go.

Presentations at Exploration Place this month will be May 7<sup>th</sup> on music and May 21<sup>st</sup> on games. The rest of the summer it will continue featuring a game or type of game to coincide with the new traveling exhibit on the circus.

Next weeks class subject needs to be finalized with the instructor. A garb swap/ exchange in the near future has been proposed by the Hospitaller after several donations at the Renaissance Festival by a former member. Several members' heraldic proposals consulted on at Coronation are expected on the next Internal Letter. The expected notification for items at national was announced. The Web Minister has a few more things to finish before his tenure ends. The deadline for letters and submissions for the *Dragonflyre* is June 21st after Lilies at the latest.

The Web Minister announced that the Society has changed the guidelines on release forms. Options are being looked at for use by Kingdom. The Social Media Minister and Property Master had nothing to report. The Exchequer reported a balance before the Renaissance Festival and Coronation of \$18,444.17. There is a \$500 gratuity from the Festival for our work in the pop concession.

There was a profit after the expenses of Coronation of \$4,129.59 which 50% will go to Kingdom leaving \$2,065.30 for Vatavia. The Knight Marshal announced that there will be some loaner equipment that is needed. As long as it is covered by that office's budget the receipt just needs to be turned in. It was recommended to contact Valens who is now making armor at reasonable rates.

Fighter practice continues to be at OJ Watson Park. There have been a couple new fighters that had come to the Renaissance Festival. The new Cut and Thrust Marshal reported on the participation at the Festival. The Seneschal noted that the fighters of HEMA constituted a quarter of the 50-60 volunteers for the SCA and Dell area.

Archery practice is scheduled for May 1th and 14<sup>th</sup> with Heidi in charge. May 21<sup>st</sup> HE Genèvieve will be in charge and plans to do the last Spring Seasonal Challenge tic-tack-toe shoot. With Lilies and Battlemoor there will be no official practice in June. Her Excellency also presented the catalog which they have used for orders which has reasonable pricing. It is the one recommended by national.

The Seneschal had little to report. She has received the land contract for Valor. The company for the tent rental needs to complete the form to finalize that aspect.

Her Excellency Genèvieve started the discussion of Valor the end of May. The Valor Tournament type is Their Excellencies discretion. Traditionally it has been two-handed swords, double elimination. It was stressed that the Valor Tournament and Guardian of Valor Tournament are two different, distinct competition. The website and flier need to be done and available

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

#### FINANCE MEETING—May 31, 2023

A special meeting of the financial committee was held at the University Congregational Church, 9209 East 29th St N, Wichita, KS 67226, May 31, 2023. Committee members present were Kevin Larsen/ Ld. Úlfr Halfdane, Amy Dyke/ Ly Tove Brianesdohter, Robert Botkin/ HL Robert Steven MacLaren the Scott, Equis Uldin de Vatavia/ Damien Woodworth and Mary J. Day/ HE Marie. Members of the populace attending were Heidi Botkin/ Ly. Heidi Anne Draper, Caitlin Lee Thomas/HL Eyfridr Goldbearer and Joshua Thomas/Ld. Brynjólfr Fálkason.

The location for storage of the Baronial property needs to be changed. At this time a commercial storage facility will be needed. It would also mean obtaining shelving to use in the storage unit. Rental option locations, pricing, availability, ratings, payment methods and security were discussed and checked. Damien Woodworth/ Equis Uldin moved to take a 10X20 unit at AAA, in Wichita, for three months; Robert Botkin/HL seconded. The motion was approved. A discussion on the type of shelving, all metal or wire shelving, considered size, load capacity, durability, and cost. Damien Woodworth/ Equis Uldin moved that \$500 be approved for shelving either metal or wire; Heidi Botkin/ Ly Heidi Anne Draper seconded. The motion carried

It was noted that there is no provision or wording in the financial policy for a Vicar on the committee. This will need to be revised. This is a rare occurrence but should be provided for. There being no other business, the meeting adjourned.


