



Finally, Quarterly reports are due on January 15th.




FROM THE ARTS & SCIENCES MINISTER

OFFICERS' MEETING, OCT. 2023

OFFICERS' MEETING October 4, 2023 at University Congregational Church, Inc. 9209 East 29th St N, Wichita, KS 67226

17 members attended: 8 officers and deputies; 3 future officers; 6 members of the populace

The Kingdom calendar of events was covered. Coronation is October 7th. October 14th is Autumn Arrows with an arts and sciences theme of battle, Norman or Saxon. October 21st is Westumbria's Feed the Beast which several Vatavians are running activities for. In November is Kingdom Arts and Sciences on the 4th. The deadline for entering, judging and research papers is October 25th. Toys for Tots is November 18th. Toy collection has already started by Their Excellencies and some other members. December 2nd is Winter Crown Tournament and the 9th the Kris Kinder shopping opportunity. Theobald will have their Midwinter Knights Dream December 16th which Vatavians are also helping with.

Our local Champions' event will be on October 14th. The change in the requested presentations for Exploration Place was presented. Donations of yarn are requested for the fiber arts presentation. Wood for making shut the box has already been obtained.

Caltrop staff reported that the decisions for all the Vatavian proposals should be received in December and January. Effective January 1st ALL proposals must be on the new forms or they will be returned. The Chatelaine will have all the loaner garb available at the Champions' event. The monthly populace meeting will be court time and discussion on events and other activities for the Barony. Members are asked to come in garb. The Kingdom Chatelaine has a link on his Kingdom page for interested individuals to contact him and receive contacts for what they are interested in or like minded members.

The October's arts and sciences class will be making chain mail presented by Óttar Langfótr. November is tentatively scheduled on sewing by HE Heidi; December Ly. Alia doing Christmas ornaments. Preprints are being obtained and will be available Wednesdays for members to work on. The Chronicler sent thanks to those who turn items in to her in a timely manner. It was reminded that release forms are required for items that are not office letters.

The Property Master will be compiling a list of projects to be finished before he steps down. Anyone wishing to help with any of these projects can contact him. A Saturday and/or Sunday will be scheduled to reorganize the shed. More shelving has been obtained. The inventory is being update to reflect actual, current property. The group hosting War Maneuvers has been contacted several times to notify them that this event's rope is still here in Vatavia. There has been no response.

It was reported that the archery season ended October 1st. An alternative archery system that could be used at the Renaissance Festival was described. It is a possibility that will be looked into for future Festivals. Future long range plans for Exploration Place will have the location for indoor fighter practice no longer available after 2025.

His Excellency Robert started by thanking all who help with this year's Fall Festival, especially noting specific individuals and Francis. Their Excellencies are looking for someone to be responsible for arranging, collecting, and managing largess for the Barony and for presentation to Royalty.

Vatavia needs to have a second annual event to cover budget. North Keep has proposed a joint event. Their suggestion, Valor, was declined. The required rotation bid for Crown Tournament December 2024 is due December 1st 2023. The site will be visited before a bid is finalized. The tavern for that event will have the food donated and donations collected for meals. Proceeds will go to the Kingdom soup kitchen. It will be proposed that 50% of the profit of the event go to Kingdom. It was announced that a bid for Winter War Maneuvers has been turned in by this year's host. It was suggested that Vatavia could put in a bid as well for this event. HE Genèvieve would be someone to consult about making a bid for this event.

Valor will now have a committee, like Lilies, comprised of the members of the officers' corps. This committee will deal with finance planning for the event and locating the site. Event stewards are still needed. The theme has been selected, Landsknecht, and items are already being made. Valor usually has a budget between \$5000 to \$5500.

The Seneschal announced the in-coming officers: Chronicler - Corrigan, Exchequer - Alicia, Arts and Sciences – Astriòr B., Chatelaine and Caltrop - Aia, and Knight Marshal - Øyrikr. The new officers will step up at the local Champions' event. The warrants may be shortened to avoid having a large turn over of offices in the future. Seneschal, Tove, will be taking responsibility for the Seneschal deputy position of Social Media. Anyone interested in being responsible for one of our three platforms – Facebook, Instagram and the unofficial Discord- should contact her. The Archer Marshal office is open but there may be a member already to take the position.

The meeting adjourned.

OFFICERS' MEETING, NOV. 2023

OFFICERS' MEETING November 1,2023 at University Congregational Church, Inc. 9209 East 29th St N, Wichita, KS 67226

11 members attended: 7 officers and deputies; 4 members of the populace

The Kingdom Arts and Sciences competition is this November 4th. The Vatavian bid for Winter Crown is being revised to reflect the calendar schedule changes on dates for Crown and Coronation. If accepted it would be November 9, 2024 instead of December 9, 2024.

November 12th is a presentation at Exploration Place on Fiber Arts.

Three members volunteered to participate and bring their looms, projects, and items for display. November 19th the presentation will be on games with materials for guests to make their own Shut the Box game.

November 8th the arts and sciences class will cover operating a sewing machine and the sewing of T-tunics. November 29th a project research show and tell will give members a chance to share and show off. It is planned the remainder of this year to have pre-print painting days, possibly also with making largess, a day to write award recommendations, and early 2024 a fighter fashion show for fighters to show off their fighter kits. Nine Vatavian have proposals that have been decided or will be decided in the next three months. Decision results are expected each month through the end of the year.

The Web Minister is working with the Kingdom to have the Vatavian, Kingdom posted, website calendar be updated by our Seneschal for local activities and meetings.

The Exchequer reported a balance of \$21,424.35 which includes the gratuity from the Fall Renaissance Festival of \$809. The rental for Wednesday meetings for the remainder of 2023 will be done tonight. The Property Master will be unloading the Baronial property into the storage facility November 11th. It would be appreciated if any member who can would come and help with the unloading.

Both heavy combat and cut and thrust practices are continuing as weather permits. Archery season is over. The position of Archer Marshal is still open. However there may be a member able to fill this position.

The Seneschal repeated about the calendar changes. Crown Tournament is now reserved to be the second weekends in April and November and Coronation the second weekends in February and July. Currently there are no groups assigned to submit a required bid for the 2024 March Crown or 2024 April Coronation. It was proposed to submit bids for each of these. It was noted that a second Kingdom event would be advantageous for Vatavia. The WSU metroplex (Eugene M. Hughes Metropolitan Complex) was mentioned as a possible event site. The availability of the church will also be checked.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

FINANCE MEETING, NOV. 2023

A meeting of the financial committee was held at the University Congregational Church, Inc., 9209 East 29th St N, Wichita, KS 67226, October 18, 2023. Committee members present were Kevin Larsen/ Ld Úlfr Halfdane; Amy Groom Dyke/ HL Tove Brianesdohter; Heidi Botkin/ HE. Heidi Anne Draper; Mary J. Day/ HE Marie Chantal Delaire. Populace members Tanna Burchinal/ Ly Astriðr Birnudóttir; Caitlin Lee/ HL Eyfriðr Gold Bearer; Chris Moore/ Ld Malichi MacKenzie O'Corrigan; and Bridgette Russell/ Noble Valeriano di Rossi also attended.

The meeting was called to order by Kevin Larsen/ Lord Úlfr Halfdane to consider Robert and Heidi Botkin's/ Their Excellencies's request for the loan of the Baronial roasters and chafing dishes for use at their daughter's wedding. Amy Groom Dyke/ HL Tove Brianesdohter moved to approve the request; Tanna Burchinal/ Ly Astriðr Birnudóttir seconded

the motion. It passed. Any loss or damage to the loaned property is the responsibility of the individual requesting the loan.

The Vatavian bid for Fall Crown is due this December 3. Details of the proposed bid were presented. There were some changes that were noted. These will be made and the signatures done and sent to Kingdom. It was suggested to put in bids for the March 2024 Coronation and April 2024 Crown Tournament also. It was noted that the National pre-registration system is under change. It is not known what that will be or when it will be.

Several other items were discussed. Budget requests for 2024 need to be in by the November Officers' meeting. These can be sent via the officers' chat. The availability of the church for the local winter event will be checked. Efforts to arrange for the return of the War Maneuvers rope still have met with no response.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

OFFICERS' MEETING, DEC. 2023

OFFICERS' MEETING December 6, 2023 University Congregational Church, Inc. 9209 East 29th St N, Wichita, KS 67226

17 members participated: 11 Baronage/ officers/ deputies; 6 members of the populace (including the Kingdom Chatelaine)

Kris Kinder is this weekend December 9th. December 16th is Midwinter Merriment in Theobald. Several officers will be helping to run activities. Vatavians are encouraged to attend. Clothiers will be on January 27th at the Shire of Cum an lolar (Independence, MO)

The presentations at Exploration Place end this month. Due to some restructuring occurring there this site will not schedule indoor fighter practices at this time. New location possibilities were proposed and will be checked.

Classes were announced by the Arts and Sciences Minister. December Ly Alia will do bead ornament making. There will be a \$2 to \$3 charge for the supplies. December 27th HL Aia will do felt banner making. January 10th Ly. Deirdre will do a class on necklines. Bring an unfinished tunic for the class. January 31st will be the fighter fashion show. The Caltrop Pursuivant reported the recent registrations for Penelope Packard and Úlfr Halfdan. There will be other proposal results the next two months. The new chronicler will continue the 15th deadline the month of each quarter for letters and submissions. The 4th quarter Dragonflyre will be published the 25th of this month.

Facebook and Instagram are the current Barony social media platforms. The Chatelaine announced the first Knowne World Chatelaines' Symposium December 30th. This is a virtual Symposium with a maximum of 100 attendees. There will be 6 tracks of classes. Sign up information is on our Facebook page and the Calontir Kingdom website.

The Exchequer announced he will step down after finishing the Domesday Report for his office. After the checks for the storage facility and the church rental cleared the account balance is \$21,483.35. When the year began the balance was \$17.000. With the group's controlling costs and the Kingdom events this year it was a very good year. Next year there are some slight increases for the storage rental and the weekly church site. There will be a meeting of the finance committee after the Officers' meeting to do the 2024 budget. It was asked and explained that the budget does not project income other than that from events. It is advised to keep 2 years of operating expenses to cover expenses through situations like the shut down during COVID.

Future property needs are to be considered during the budget meeting. The property Master proposed making padded arrows, for which the materials already have been obtained, which can be shot at people. These could be used for archery at the annual Ren Festivals as an additional fund raiser.

The Cut and Thrust Marshal and Knight Marshal have had few fighter practices due to the weather. With the discussion on indoor fighter locations it was consider whether to change the practice to another time, possibly during a week day evening. It was asked about combining all activities to Wednesday night. It was noted that archery, even on private property is illegal in Sedgwick County. Archery on Wednesdays might not be possible. Possibilities can be considered once archery resumes in the Spring. Potential sites will be checked and visited. Fighters will be consulted as to their preferences before any new location is selected.

The Seneschal announced that the Vatavian bid for November Coronation 2024 has been accepted. There is a bid for hosting Queen's Prize here that is being finalized. FINANCE MEETING, DEC. 2023

A meeting of the financial committee was held at the University Congregational Church, 9209 East 29th St N, Wichita, KS 67226, December 6, 2023 Committee members present were Kevin Larsen/ Úlfr Halfdane Amy Dyke/ Ly Tove Brianesdohter; Robert Botkin/ HE. Robert the Scott; Mary J. Day/ HE Marie. Seneschal Deputy Joshua Thompson/ Ld Brynjólfr Fálkason and Deputy Exchequer Alicia Nielsen/ Ly Alicia Niel sat in. Three members of the populace joined the meeting: Caitlin Lee-Thompson/ HL Aia Gold Bearer, Tanna Burchinal/ Ly Astriðr Birnudóttir and Bridgett Russell/ Noble Valeriano di Rossi.

Two event bids were first presented before the budget was discussed. The January 6th local New Year winter event bid was presented. The site specifics were given and the total budget of \$375. It was moved by Joshua Thompson/Ld. Brynjólfr Fálkason and seconded by Amy Dyke/Ly Tove Brianesdohter to accept this event budget item. The motion passed. The second bid is for a Kingdom bid for Queen's Prize May 11, 2024. Several details were finalized. Amy Dyke/Ly Tove Brianesdohter moved to accept the bid with the advised changes. New Year event January 6th (instead of Midwinter Merriment) accepted bid \$375. Donation site fee.

Ren fairs \$200 (\$100 each) same.

Seneschal \$100 (includes insurance certificates not covered as part of an event - cost increase for these \$50 to \$75) same.

Exchequer \$50 same. Was noted not used in 2023. However checks will need to be ordered in the coming year.

Knight Marshal \$600 (purchase loaner helmets).

Cut and Thrust \$130 (loaner equipment) same.

Youth Combat -0- There are no participating youth at this point in time. Same.

Archer Marshal \$200 (arrow making materials, specifically to do padded arrows. Add \$30 for measuring wheel) same.

Heraldry -0- self sufficient from fees same.

Demonstrations -0- same.

Arts and Sciences \$100 same.

Castellan \$200 same (unused - previous year 2022 expense for business cards and brochures).

Web Minister -0- no budget expense. 2023 unknown what charges Kingdom sponsoring websites would be. Still don't know.

Minister of Youth -0- (office vacant).

Baronial property \$\$650 (\$100 brass cloths, \$225 for 3 tables, \$325 additional storage rack for property in storage).

Weekly meeting site \$1500 for 48 weeks (cancel for weeks of Lilies, Gulf Wars, Thanksgiving, Christmas) This is a \$300 increase resulting from an increase from \$25 to \$31.25 per week rental.






