
April 20th is Lilies Workday. Though there will not be a court at this event, We'd ask

The Caltrop Pursuivant is pleased to announced the registration of the recent Vatavian proposals.



shield Per saltire sable and purpure, in pale a wolf rampant and a hand argent.




Úlfkell hrafnhauss:

OFFICERS' MEETING, JAN. 2024

OFFICERS' MEETING January 3, 2024 at University Congregational Church, Inc. 9209 East 29th St N, Wichita, KS 67226

12 members attended: 9 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ event stewards; 3 members of the populace

January 27th is the Kingdom's annual Clothiers event in Independence Missouri. Three members announced that they had car space available to car pool to this event. His Excellency will be attending the War of the Phoenix starting February 5th. Those planning to attend Gulf Wars, March 9th — March 17th , should attend winter War Maneuvers February 17th in Columbia Missouri. Chieftains is the following weekend. After Gulf Wars is Coronation March 23rd. April 13th is Crown Tournament.

January 4th is Vatavia's New Year event in Kechi. The Arts and Sciences competition will be populace vote. The theme is 'What I Learned Last Year.' The weekend after Coronation is the local Spring Renaissance Festival April 20th- 21st. It was announced that His Excellency will be gone at that time for the Lilies site work weekend.

Members presenting classes the last month were thanked by the Arts and Sciences Minister. January 10th there will be a class on doing necklines for T-tunics and January 31st a fighters' fashion show. The next show and tell session will be in March. Those interested in teaching or class suggestions should contact the Arts and Sciences Minister. The Chatelaine and several other members attended the online Knowne World Chatelaines' Symposium the end of December. Members are encouraged to go to the Calontir Wiki site and update their personal page information or to provide information on their friends.

The Chronicler posted the Dragonflyre on the Baronial Facebook page December 25th. Their Excellencies thaanked him for the issue noting the quality of the publication. March 15th is the deadline for all letters and other submissions for the next issue. It was reminded that all posting for the web site need to go through the Web Ministers email. Officers should be using their web email so there will be an archive of correspondence for future office holders. There was no news to report from the Social Media officer. The status of current heraldic proposals in process was announced. Work continues to re-establish a digital Order of Precedence for the Barony.

The Exchequer reported that first quarter payments for the storage shed and the Kechi rental had been made. Tit was explained that Theobald College had lost their bank. Until a new bank is located by

that group their funds and transactions will be handled through our account. Those funds have been transferred in and separate 'books' kept for those transactions. The current balance is \$22,724.35. \$21,563.35 of that amount is Vatavia's current balance.

The Property Master had nothing to report. Inventory will have been update when this office turns over early this year.

The Knight Marshal and Cut and Thrust Marshal both reported that due to the weather there had been no practices. Both are working on obtaining budgeted items for their activities. Potential new indoor fighter practice sites are being considered. There is currently no Archer Marshal; but, there are plans to set a workday for repairing Baronial arrows. There are also a nerf style arrow that could be used to once again have archery for guests during the local Renaissance Festivals.

Their Excellencies went over the Kingdom calendar and local upcoming events through Spring. A bid is needed for this year's Valor. It can be done as a team. It was noted that the different officers handle their areas; event stewards handle the theme related parts of the event. The Officer Corps is responsible for finding a site for the event. Their Excellencies announced that the original Holy Hand Grenades of Vatavia would be displayed at the upcoming New Year's event by the guardians of these relics. Krampus is also rumored to be attending.

The Seneschal reported on the search for potential Valor sites: Harvey County West Park in Burrton and Camp Hawk in Newton. A bid is needed for this event. It can be done as a team. It was noted that the different officers handle their areas; event stewards handle the theme related parts of the event.

There was a discussion about the resuming indoor fighter practice at Make ICT at 5920 E. Mt Vernon. There is a 'Brunch with the Board' January 13th and their monthly Board meeting January 18th which officers are encouraged to attend. It is possible this location could also be available for Wednesday meetings which could also include an additional fighter practice at that time. Possible cost is not known at this time. But it was noted that individual membership is \$300/year and the current Church rental is \$125/month. At this time is was also noted that insurance for archery at OJ Watson Park would be \$75. Plus OJ Watson Park has just instituted a new more extensive application form that may have complications for that activity.

The Web Minister will need to step down in a couple months. Applications for this office are needed.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

FINANCE MEETING, JAN. 2024

A meeting of the financial committee was held at the University Congregational Church, 9209 East 29th St N, Wichita, KS 67226, January 31, 2024 Committee members present were Kevin Larsen/Úlfr Halfdane Amy Dyke/H Ly Tove Brianesdohter; Robert Botkin/ HE. Robert the Scott; Mary J. Day/ HE Marie. Seneschal Deputy Joshua Thompson/ Ld Brynjólfr Fálkason and Two members of the populace joined the meeting: Tanna Burchinal/ Ly Astriðr Birnudóttir and Sarah Penick/ Ly Sarah O'Raghailligh.

There was a request to take two scutari and a Gott container cover to War of the Phoenix. Kevin Larsen/ Úlfr Halfdan moved to approve the request; Tanna Burchinal/ Ly Astriðr Birnudóttir seconded. The motion was approved. It was announced that four donated shelving units for the storage shed will be picked up this evening. Two benches have been offered to the Barony. It was moved by Kevin Larsen/ Úlfr Halfdan and seconded by Sarah Penick/ Ly Sarah O'Raghailligh to accept the donation. The motion was approved.

A site has been found for Valor 2024 at El Dorado State Lake, at the Box Turtle camping area. The camping area has 41 camping sites which can be reserved. Each site can have a maximum of 3 tents. Cost is \$10/day/tent. Since it is the holiday weekend, rental must be for all 4 days for a cost of \$40/ tent. Sites reservations can be canceled prior to the event with a transaction fee assessed for the cancellation. Site cost would be a minimum of \$1640; a maximum of \$4920. Shade flies do not count as tents. Members will be encouraged to bring pop-ups for use for activities.

Additional event costs are \$2250.50: \$55 printing, \$37 water bearing, \$75 propane, \$400 port-a-john rental, \$50 additional table rentals, \$25 toilet paper, \$25.50 additional trash dumpster; \$300 prizes, and tavern food. With maximum tenting this would total a projected maximum budget of. \$7175. This would exceed the 2024 Valor budget of \$5700. It was noted that in the past tavern has had a profit that has offset some increased expenses.

A discussion on the event fee began. It was noted that the attendees would also have a additional \$5/day vehicle fee. Car pooling should be encouraged. Pre-registration will be encouraged in addition to a pre-registration discount. Pre-registration will be \$30; at the gate \$35 with children free. An attendance of 180 at the \$30 pre-registration would result in \$5400.

After this discussion of attendance history and the proposed attendance fee it was moved by Robert Botkin/ HE. Robert the Scott and seconded by Tanna Burchinal/ Ly Astriðr Birnudóttir to adjust the 2024 Valor budget authority to the \$7175 amount. The motion was approved.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

OFFICERS' MEETING, MAR. 2024

OFFICERS' MEETING March 6, 2024 at University Congregational Church, Inc. 9209 East 29th St N, Wichita, KS 67226

11 members attended: 8 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ event stewards; 3 members of the populace

Queen's Prize is April 6th. GoA level arts and sciences recipients are available locally to sponsor those wishing to enter. The Valor theme will be Landsknecht this year. Planning and preparation for this event will start immediately after Gulf Wars ends.

There will be a class on side-less surcoats April 10th. The next 'show and tell' is tentatively scheduled for May 8th. A 'down and dirty' class on Landsknecht will be scheduled before the Valor event. Largess is needed. Some simple items such as kumihimo discs and mug covers can be made easily. Nights will be scheduled to work on items for largess. There are eight Vatavians with proposals at national for registration. Decision results are expected in May and July. The Gold Key loaner garb has been sorted and reduced. A tote has been set aside to present to the newest group, Shire of Coney March.

The Exchequer reported a balance of \$21,006 after payment of the non-member surcharge for Theobald and the Valor site fee. Checks need to be ordered and the bank signature card also needs to be updated. That will be dealt with in the financial meeting following this Officers' meeting.

The Knight Marshal has been holding fighter practice when the weather allows. There has been nothing finalized yet with Make ICT on moving Wednesday and Sunday activities to that facility. There is a Make ICT Board meeting this 21st. The Seneschal has been in communication with their officers. After discussion it was decided to request to have something by the 21st; the end of the month at the latest. Activities would then start in April. That would be pending any insurance issues. A new Archery Marshal has not been confirmed at this time.

The Seneschal announced that the Cut and Thrust Marshal has stepped down to take a Kingdom position. This office will need to be filled immediately. The Web Minister has been in that position for several years and need to be stepping down. Interest members need to apply. It was also noted that the site needs to be updated. The Social Media Officer may also be stepping down in the near future. The Sen-

eschal requested the dates certain officers started their tenure. That information will be sent to her this evening.

Valor preparations continue. It is still unconfirmed what Royalty and visiting Royalty will be in attendance. HL Corrigan offered and was accepted to organize the scrolls needed for the event. It was asked if a couple of the roll of arms would be displayed. Since there is no idea of display possibilities are, probably not. However there are 54 Valor winner pennants and five more to be made that will be on display.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

Mac Kenzie O Corrigan, Jay Reynolds/ Master Jóhann Steinarsson, and Tanna Burchinal/ Ly Astriðr Birnudóttir.

A request was presented to take two Baronial scutari to gulf Wars. Amy Groom-Dyke/ HL Tove Brianesdohter moved to approved this request; Tanna Burchinal/ Ly Astriðr Birnudóttir. seconded the motion. It was approved. A discussion was held on changes needed to the bank signature card. It was recommended to have Alicia Nielsen/ Ly Alicia Niel, the local Exchequer; Mistress Meadhbh inghean uí Shuibhne, the Kingdom/ Regional Exchequer; Kevin Larsen/ Ld Úlfr Halfdan, local property master, Faye-Marie Mills/ HL Catlin Marie de Moretaine and Mary J. Day/ HE Marie Chantal Delaire, local members usually available at group meetings to deal with financial transactions. Alicia Nielsen/ Ly Alicia Niel moved to accept the proposed signatories. It was seconded by Tanna Burchinal/ Ly Astriðr Birnudóttir. The motion was approved.

— Story of the Snizzles —

During the reign of Baron Thomas and Baroness Cerridwen, His Excellency of the Barony of Shattered Crystal, Saint Louis Metro-East, and his wife would visit whenever in Vatavia for his modern job. One of those visits the weather prediction was for snizzle. His Excellency Shattered Crystal asked just what was that? Snow and drizzle. His Excellency Thomas asked the heralds what the heraldry would be for that; and, charged them to research and to present that information at a future date.

A month later that report was done, complete with examples. The next visit of Their Cousins Shattered Crystal it was presented to both Their Excellencies Vatavia and Shattered Crystal. There was a special bound manuscript volume for Their Excellencies Shattered Crystal to take to document this heraldic research.


A snizzle is a snowflake representation, the escarbuncle, done usually in azure. There is a goutte d'eau,

a white droplet, at the center. This is the basic snizzle. Since it represents weather, it is a field treatment. So the shield would be a background with semy of snizzles all over. Of course in these the 'lands that burn' we sometimes have the very rare snizzle enraged, with lightning bolts.

Since it represents weather there are some standard designs corresponding to conditions. Light snizzle is just semy on the shield. Moderate snizzle predictions are foul/fowl weather so fowl with the snizzle treatment. Heavy snizzle things are just going down the drain. So it uses a gurge.

There is one regional variant that is very different, the weiner snizzle. Of course Americans who want their own heraldry have not had the historical experience or background. The American interpretation of the wiener snizzle is a distinctly, uniquely modern interpretation.
