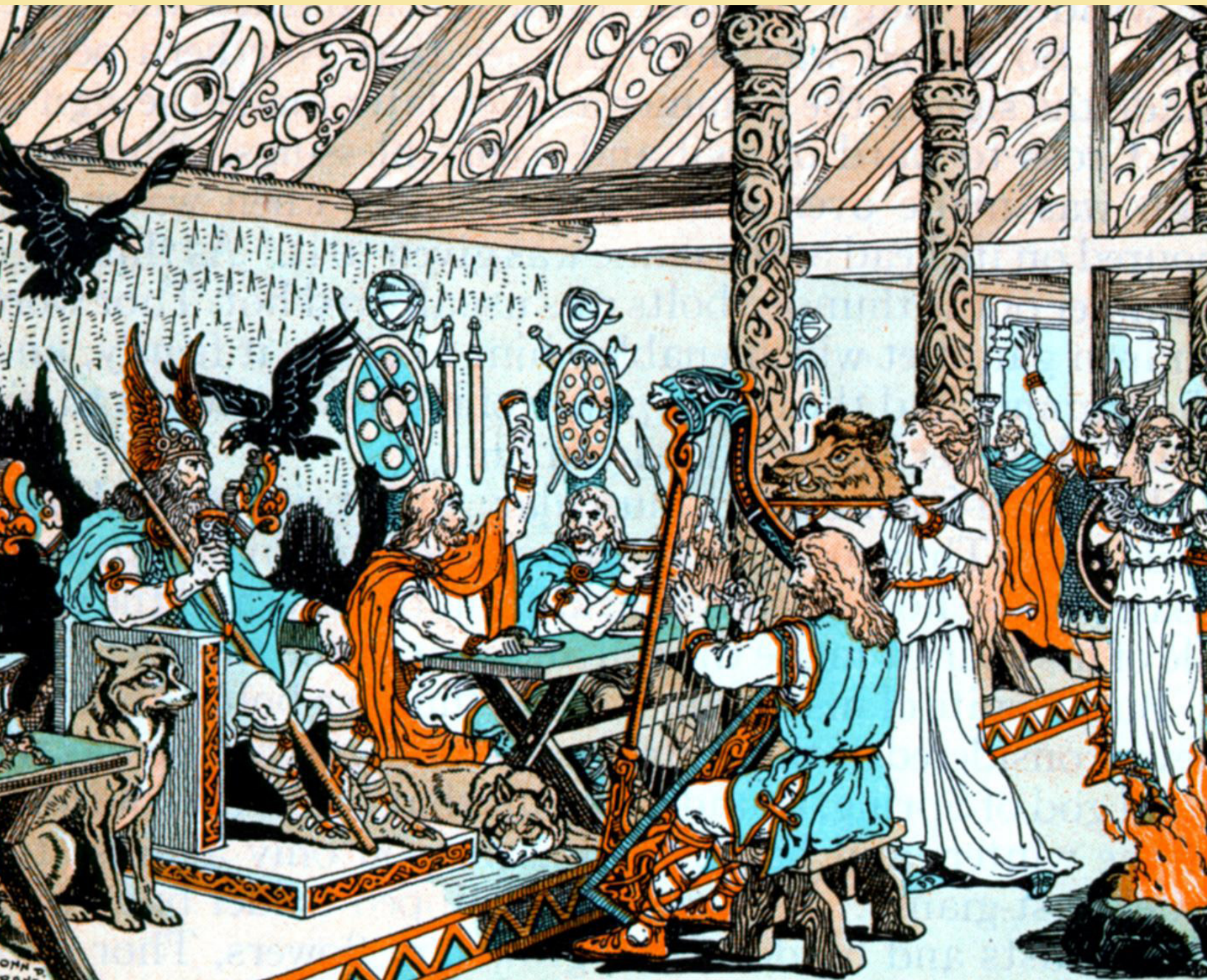

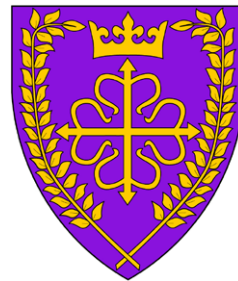
Unto Our dearest populace,

Greetings Calontir

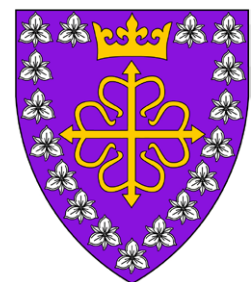
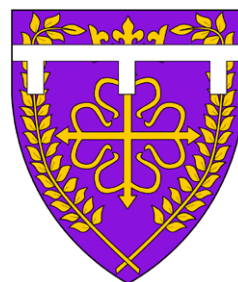

OFFICERS' MEETING, APRIL 2024

OFFICERS' MEETING April 3, 2024 at University Congregational Church, Inc. 9209 East 29th St N, Wichita, KS 67226

19 members were present: 11 Baronage/officers/deputies/event stewards; 8 members of the populace

The Spring calendar has several Kingdom events. Queen's Prize is April 6th . April 13th is Crown Tournament. His Excellency Robert has room for two passengers. April 20th is a work day at the Lilies site. That is followed the 27th by Unslung Heroes. May has lowa events: the RUSH session on camping the first weekend 3rd-4th and Cook and Combat Mayhem the third weekend 18th-19th. Between is St George and the Dragon in Springfield Missouri May 10th and 11th . Valor is here the end of May. Lilies War starts June 7th. Vatavia is doing gate on Sunday and a Baronial sponsored luncheon at the arts and sciences area during the event. Calon Con is online June 29th. Kingdom officers will inform local officers on their meeting schedules.

The Great Plains Renaissance Festival is April 20th-21st. Set up will be done that Friday the 19th. HE Robert will be at the Lilies site work day but back that Sunday. HE Heidi will provide members with lunch. There is a possibility of a demo presentation in Anthony Kansas mid-May. Nothing is confirmed at this time nor details available. Valor is May 24th-27th.

Pre-registration is being set up for the event. The schedule of events is being compiled. The Facebook page is being created.

Crown is here in November.

The Knight Marshal is doing monthly posts an activities. Ld Torin will be handling fighter practice in April. There have been rule changes on martial activities. Fighters are expected to be familiar with the changes. The new Earl Marshal intends to make assessments with fighters on those changes. Practices are at OJ Watson Park with Make ICT as an alternative.

Archery has not resumed. His Excellency Robert has been navigating the city departments to get started on an archery permit.

The Dragonflyre has been posted and is available on both the Baronial Facebook page and website. Registration decisions for Vatavian proposals in process are expected in May and July. There is one Vatavian item on the current internal letter. Arts and sciences

has largess making sessions planned; the first is April 10th. Fighter repair kits and messenger bags are two items to be made. HL Corrigan will do a class on Landsknecht April 24th. May 8th HL Aia will do a class on sideless surcoats.

The new Exchequer, Ly Alicia has her warrant. The bank card will be updated and checks ordered, probably by next week. At Coronation there was an Exchequers meeting. The Kingdom financial policy is being updated. After that is completed the finance committee will be updating the local policy as well. Needed documentation has not been received regarding the temporary account transfer from Theobald. There are issues with the bank where the account was closed. It was suggested to get the Kingdom Exchequer to get involved and contact the bank in question.

The Society Board of Directors February 15th increased membership fees and other financial charges. There will be a finance meeting to discuss the impact and changes necessary for already scheduled events of Valor and November Crown.

HE Robert will be getting with the Property Master to compile a list of property projects.

The Seneschal reported on a proposed contract received from Make ICT for the use of their facility. Until a final contract is completed Vatavia can use the facility without charge on Wednesday evenings from 6 pm – 9 pm and Sundays from 10 am – 2 pm. Specifics on fees and required officers at all meetings need to be agreed upon.

The Cut and Thrust Marshal office needs to be filled as soon as possible. The previous officer stepped into a Kingdom position. The Web Minister has been several years in the position and is required to step down. This needs to be filled so information to members can be current and up to date. The web site uses Word Press.

Their Excellencies strongly encourage members to get award recommendations in. It was emphasized that one does not need to be a recipient of the award to recommend someone. There is a working link on the local website. However it does not forward a copy to their Excellencies. They ask you contact them directly with a copy that They can advised the Crown if asked. HL Aia will do a class on using the online award recommendation form at arts and sciences.

The meeting adjourned.

FINANCE MEETING, APRIL 2024

A meeting of the finance committee was held , 2024 after the monthly Officers' meeting. Committee members present were Amy Groom-Dyke/HL Tove Briansdohter, Robert Botkin/HE Robert Steven Mac Laren, Alicia Nielsen/Ly Alicia Niel, Kevin Larsen/Ld Úlfr Halfdan, and Mary J. Day/HE Marie Chantal Delaire. Populace in attendance were Nicholas Green/HL Øyrikr Raðúlfsson, Chris Moore/HL Malichi Mac Kenzie O Corrigan, and Bridgett Russell/Noble Valeriano di Rossi.

Effective February 15th the Board of Directors of the SCA Inc. increased membership fees by \$10 for members and \$5 per person on family memberships. Then on April 1st the non-member event charge was increased from \$5 to \$10. Both Valor and Crown bids were based on finance policy prior to these changes by the BoD. After discussion Amy Groom-Dyke/ HL Tove Briansdohter moved to increase Crown fees by \$5 due to the recent Board increases. Robert Botkin/ HE Robert Steven Mac Laren seconded the motion. It was approved. Kevin Larsen/ Ld Úlfr Halfdan moved to increase Valor fees by \$5 for the same reason; Amy Groom-Dyke/ HL Tove Briansdohter seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Exchequer Alicia Nielsen/ Ly Alicia Niel requested verification of the finance committee's approval to use Pay Pal for Valor fee payments, a policy for refunds on event payments, and payment methods accepted the day of the event at the gate. This verification is required on the form to set up Pay Pal for the event. There is an existing refund policy based on notification the Friday of an event in the local financial policy. Traditionally due to unavailability, or poor and intermittent quality of access at sites, cash or checks are the on site payment options. The committee verified these.

Both consideration of the Make ICT contract, which still needed to be finalized, and rental of a U Haul trailer for Ren Festival were tabled until the next meeting.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

OFFICERS' MEETING, MAY 2024

OFFICERS' MEETING May 1, 2024 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon, Wichita, KS 67226

15 members attended: 13 Baronage/officers/deputies/event stewards;
3 members of the populace

The event stewards reported on the progress on Valor plans for this year. The website and event site will be updated. The tavern menu and pricing is available on the e-page. The schedule is still being finalized. Set up will start Thursday night. A week after Valor is the start of Lilies. Calon Con is the end of June, the 29th. Outland's Battlemoor starts July 3rd.

Caltrop staff reported that the majority of Vataavian proposals will be decided this month; notification expected July.

The Dragonflyre for the first quarter is posted online. The deadline for letters and submissions for the second quarter publication is June 10th. New fighters who saw us at the Renaissance Festival have been at fighter practice. Also a new family has started attending Wednesdays.

The Exchequer reported a balance of \$21,006.27. A gratuity has been deposited from Eagles Realm for helping with the pop concession: \$500 for the Spring Festival and \$168 for the extra percentage from the 2023 Fall Festival. Kingdom requirements to get pre-registration started for Valor should be finalized this weekend. The Board fee changes in February 15th and April 1st required changes to be made to the online postings. The Vataavian check order has been received and reimbursements can be made.

The Property Master needs the walkie talkies used at the Renaissance Festival need to be turned in. The Knight Marshal also needs loaner armor returned.

Fighter practice is being held at Make ICT now. Concern was expressed about the possibility of hitting the lights when practice is done inside. Modifications for practice indoors were suggested. It was noted that Make ICT has plans to change the hanging light system in the room. His Excellency is navigating the conflicting information from different city and county agencies in his continuing efforts to get an archery permit for practices.

The cut and thrust marshal position is open and needs to be filled as soon as possible. Ld. Brinky will be stepping into the Web Minister office. Those who would be interested in becoming staff to help keep the site updated should contact him. The Seneschal announced that she will be stepping down sometime after Lilies. His Excellency plans to see the new owners of Whispering Winds camp.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

FINANCE MEETING, MAY 2024

Calon Con is June 29th, Kingdom officers will be sending the information for their virtual meetings. Battlemoor starts July 3 in the Outlands (Aguilar, CO). Those going were reminded about altitude sickness. Coronation is July 13th Barony of Mag Mor (Roca, NE) It was noted some Vativians are required to attend and may have car pool space. July 30th Masters of the Duel will be at the lands of the Barony of Three Rivers (Bridgeton, MO). The end of July is Feast of Eagles in Cúm an Iolair (Overland Park, Kansas).

Due to Lilies, the local populace meeting is rescheduled to June 26th. There will be a local court held at this time also. Two officers will be stepping down and one taking the local Seneschal position.

The Dragonflyre for this quarter will be published June 25th. The incoming Seneschal was advised to contact the Kingdom Web Minister to get access to update information on the Vativian web site.

HE Robert and Property Master Ld. Úlfr will be inventorying the current Baronial property. It was reported that the loaner cut and thrust equipment has been returned. Some individuals' personal items still need to be returned.

Fighter practice is now being scheduled two times a week, Wednesdays and Sundays. Meister Joachim will take over as interim Cut and Trust Marshal.

The Chatelaine office was recently elevated to great office status by the Board of Directors. Officers can only hold one great office. Therefore HL Aia will be stepping down immediately from the position of Caltrop Herald but remaining in the Chatelaine position. It was noted that those interested in the herald's office would have an existing staff. It was also announced that the Web Minister position is open. Like Kingdom this can be a team of individuals to fill this office.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

FINANCE MEETING, JUNE 2024

A meeting of the finance committee was held June 20, 2024 after the monthly Officers' meeting. Committee members present were Joshua Thompson/Ld Brinky Fálkason, Robert Botkin/HE Robert Steven Mac Laren, Heidi Botkin/HE Heidi Anne Draper, Alicia Nielsen/Ly Alicia Niel, Kevin Larsen/Ld Úlfr Halfdan, and Mary J. Day/HE Marie Chantal Delaire. Populace in attendance were Nicholas Green/HL Øyrikr Raðúlfs-son, Adrian Woodworth/HL Chagadai Shira, and Bridgett Russell/Noble Valeriano di Rossi.

After discussion regarding the annual donation/tithe to regional/Kingdom it was moved by Joshua Thompson/Ld Brinky Fálkason to increase the amount to \$1500, \$1000 over the budgeted \$500 to pass on the unexpected profits from the Memorial weekend event, Valor. Heidi Botkin/HE Heidi Anne Draper seconded the motion. It was approved. It was recommended to send a letter with the payment to explain the larger amount sent.

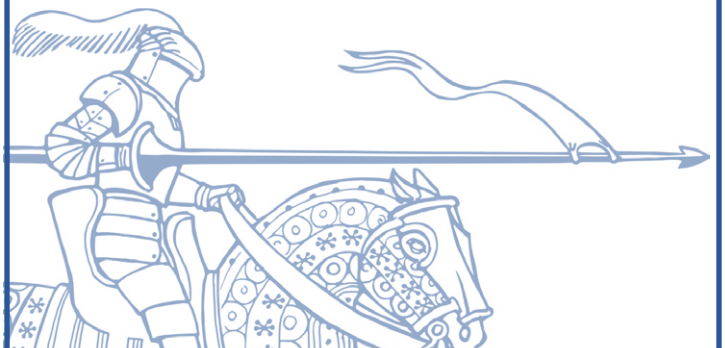

Robert Botkin and Jayme Jones will be removed; Joshua Thompson, Alicia Nielson and the regional Treasurer/Exchequer will be added.
