SATURDAY:

New Fighter Tournament: Open to all unranked fighters that have never won a tournament Hunt in the Woods: A traditional hunt for beasts in the woods.

SUNDAY:

Tournament of Valor: Hand-and-a-Half Sword, no thrusting permitted.

Guardian of Valor Tournament: Open to all past winners of the Tournament of Valor, or their Champions. Any weapons used in past Valor Tournaments, Hand-and-a-Half Sword or Great Sword, thrusting allowed.

Calon Steel

Valor Tournament: Two-Handed Sword of any type.

Grab-Bag Torchlight Tournament: Random weapon systems decided by drawing a token.

German Rapier Tournament: Single Sword only. Opponents stand with one foot in a circle. One foot must stay in the circle at all times.

Archery: Sponsored shoots held all weekend.

Bardic Competition: Valor and/or Chivalry in any medium.

Arts and Sciences

Competition #1: Heraldic display with Banners. Competition #2: Brewing, open entry.

Classes held throughout the weekend.

Tavern: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner available both Saturday and Sunday

Site Fee: \$15.00 for adults, \$5.00 for ages 6-17, children under 5 and under get in free. There is an additional \$5.00 surcharge for each adult non-member. Family Cap is \$45.00 (not including NMS). Make checks payable to "SCA Inc., Barony of Vatavia."

Merchants are most welcome! There is no additional merchanting fee.

Site Information: The site includes a full hall, plenty of camping space, a nature trail, play ground, showers, indoor restrooms, and fire pits. No ground fires are allowed! Dogs are allowed if on leash or in a run. Please clean up after your pets. The swimming pool at the event site will NOT be available for our use this year. It is in need of major repairs and will not be open at all this summer. Site is wet.

Directions: Take your best route to I-135 in Wichita, KS. Follow I-135 to the north edge of Wichita, to K-96 West. Continue on K-96 to Ridge Road. Take Ridge Road north to 73rd St. North. Turn left on 73rd St., and continue for several miles. The road leads to and ends

at the Whispering Winds Camp. Look for SCA signs.

Please be sure to observe posted speed limits once you turn onto 73rd Street, as this is a residential and farm area.
