January 8, 2014 - Martinson Avenue Christian Church, Wichita, KS

12 members attended: 11 Baronage/officers/deputies/champions; 1 member of the populace

Planning for the Kingdom Arts and Sciences event to be held in Vatavia continues. Details on scheduling are being made. The closing site time was determined. Questions regarding the competitions and responsibilities of the Kingdom Arts and Sciences Champion were discussed.

January 26th there will be a presentation on the Bardic Arts at Exploration Place.

There will be no BUSH class the month of March due to Gulf Wars. Classes are scheduled currently through July. Michael Sean MacGee's name and device and the Baronial Order of Saint Hilarius and its badge have been registered.

With the change of Seneschal the bank signature card will need to be updated. Budget for this year will be done next month. Members need to get requests turned in to aid in that planning. Expenditures were mentioned for shade flies and storage for the new rolls of arms.

Fighter practice continues at Exploration Place, weather conditions and road conditions permitting. Several new fighters continue to attend. Loaner armor repair continues. Cut and Trust practice is officially the third Sunday of the month. Unofficial practice will be held if interested fighters attend the other Sundays.

Archery Practice indoors is scheduled for the first Sunday of the month. Other Sundays will schedule get-togethers to work on archery projects.

Officers' quarterly reports are due next Wednesday. It was reported that the Exchequer's report has been changed to a cumulative format. The fourth quarter for that office will now also be that office's Domesday report. It was clarified that the required officers for local group status are Seneschal, Exchequer, Chronicle & Knight Marshal.

Currently the office of Chronicler is temporarily being filled by the Knight Marshal and Arts and Sciences Minister. Interested members are encouraged to apply. The office requires 3-4 hours once a month only producing the Dragonflyre-. The publications are the quarterly reports. It was suggested that possibly publication could be changed to quarterly only.

The Chatelaine is a deputy position of the Seneschal. The current officer would like to step down. Interested members should turn letters in to Their Excellencies, the Seneschal and Lady Lucia.

Bids for the Spring Renaissance Festival April 12th- 13th are requested. Members interested in being event steward for our Kingdom event Valor, Labor Day weekend, need to get bids in. At this time only general plans, no details are needed. This is in order to handle securing contracts in a timely fashion.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.
