

Good Gentles all,

The past few months have been very productive for Vatavia. I am proud to report that we have gained a promising new Voice Herald in Milord Nikolai, who graciously donated his time at our Spring Demo with the Great Plains Renaissance Festival. Not to mention we have a number of items in process at Kingdom level, and also at Laurel level; Lady Aelia and Lady Deidra's submissions are currently in process, and we should have notification on Milord Rodrigo's submissions at some point in the next few months.

As of this writing, this quarter I have not received any word of returns or conflicts, which is a good thing. In addition, we recently confirmed the approval of Milady Persephone's device:

Vert, three stoiles argent each conjoined to a mascle, issuant from base a demi-sun Or




Even more impressive, with the approval of the Badge for Vatavia's Cut & Thrust order: *Azure, a dragonfly between two dussacks in pile or, a bordure countercompony vert and or*, we have established the defining instance for dussacks as a charge- or more simply, we are the first people in the SCA to have the dussack, or practice blade, approved for use as a heraldic charge. Well done, Vatavia!

Don't forget that the office of the Caltrop Pursuivant is always at your disposal. If any of you have an idea for a personal device, or a name change, or anything to do with who you are in the Barony, now is a good time to get together with the Caltrop staff and do a consultation! Feel free to talk to myself, HE Marie Chantal, or Lord Karl if you have a question on a name or heraldic device, and we'll do what we can to point you in the right direction. For those of you wanting to take a crack at initial designs and possibly practice filling in forms prior to a consultation, there are submission forms at http://heraldry.calontir.org/ forms.htm available for download.

Keep an eye on the Kingdom calendar, for there will be events aplenty over the next coming months, and a good many of those will need Voice Heralds, Book Heralds to help at consult tables, or both.

# **Officer's Meeting—April**

An individual to organize the pop booth volunteers is still needed. Ld. Corrigan is organizing the presentation April 26<sup>th</sup> at Northeast High School's Shakespeare Day. The Exploration Place presentations for the summer have been scheduled. May 4<sup>th</sup> will be a presentation on 'Natural Dyes' by Ysmay. July 27<sup>th</sup> is games. As of yet no date is confirmed for September.

A 'Meet and Greet' for newcomers, including an Easter egg hunt and ice cream social, titles will be held in conjunction with the Champions' event April 27<sup>th</sup> at Camp Hawk. The pot luck formula will be posted once it is organized. Non-Vatavian green cord holders may compete for Champion. Kingdom calendar changes will require the Masters of the Duel event to be rescheduled.

Arts and sciences classes are scheduled out to September. Plans have been made for new Gold Key loaner garb. Notification on registrations are expected this month, May and August. The *Dragonflyre* will go to bi-monthly publication with the next issue coming out in May. The populace and officers need to plan accordingly for artwork, letters, fliers, and picture submissions to the *Dragonflyre*.

The Exchequer stated that office's report is ready and just awaiting the bank statement.

A invitation from Westumbria to attend a regional fighter practice to be held there the first weekend in May has been accepted.

The Seneschal reminded officers that reports are due for the first quarter. Copies should also be sent to his deputy, Ld. William. The Arts and Sciences Minister is looking for a deputy.

At the Kingdom Witan meeting it was stressed that announcements, calendar and event changes, cancellations, meetings, etc. must go through official channels and sites before unofficial publications and sites. The Calon Con has been re-established on the Kingdom calendar for the third weekend in July. That is July 27<sup>th</sup> this year. All local officers and regional deputies are required to attend. The site is still to be determined.

It was announced that several new members attended the regional fighter practice in Westumbria. One new member did very well in his first heavy weapons practice. Regular Sunday practice is at the outdoor location, South Linwood Park from 11 am to 2 pm.

The Seneschal noted that the busy spring, summer season has begun. Melees and Mayhem and the Ansteorran Castellan event are May 17<sup>th</sup>; Horse and Falcon May 24<sup>th</sup>. Then it will be June and Lilies. July has Coronation and the following weekend Calon Con. Officers were reminded that Calon Con attendance is required.
