Welcome to the latest in a series of "Book Reviews" done by members of the populace. In this set, I have declared "Chronicler's Choice" and will review three of my favorite books this season. Without further ado.....

> The Bishop's Heir: by Katherine Kurtz.. Del Rey Books, 1985.

In this, her first novel in the "Chronicles of King Kelson" series, Ms. Kurtz takes up where her previous "Deryni" trilogy leaves off. In this series, King Kelson is faced with religious unrest at home, and war abroad. With his faithful minions, Alaric Morgan and Duncan McLain, he faces these problems with a mixture of martial skill, & necromantic ability. Although these books are fiction, the author has gone to great lenghts to create a true medieval atmosphere. If you like adventure, magic, and a little romance, this just may be the book for you.

Challange of the Clans by Kenneth C. Flint. Bantam Books, Inc. 1984.

In this book, the author recounts the story of the Irish hero Finn the Fair. It tells of his youth as the hunted son of a murdered Fianna Chieftan. With only his wits to guide him. Finn seeks the arts of the Fianna Chieftans, and pursues his destiny across the Irish countryside. It is a well written book: full of interesting characters, action, adventure, and more than a little "Celtic Magic." If this is your "era", then these are the books for you.


