


This is a dry site with plenty of parking available and several fastfood places nearby. Maps will be available at the event.



Once again the Knowne World gethers for the grand conflagration of the ESTRELLA WAR. As this is the third year of the conflict we are calling it "Estralla Var III, the Return of the Caidii Apologies extended to Messr. Lucas.

The site will be the usual one, Estrella Mountain Park, and the time will be as always, Presidents' Westend of February, 1987. Feb. 13-16

The park is located approximately twenty-five miles west of the hamlet of Phoenix, Arizona. There is running water and fixed shade pavillions. There will be priveys of both the conventional and portable type. Fires are allowed only in stone firepits and hibechis/campstoves. Ground fires are strictly forbidden. There will be no organized feast, but surely each encampment, be it Shire or Kingdom, will want to organize their own.

Toll for the weekend will be \$5 00 per person, including smalls. A receipt will be issued at the gate for each entry. Also at the gate will be the site waiver for signature and a map of the area. Locations (by Kingdom) of encampments will be posted on the map as they become available. Your site fee includes entrance to the park and the charge for pavillions extracted by the Park Service.

There will be a tavern, operated within the sundane legal limits of the State of Arizona, run by the Corsairs. Also featured will be Merchants' Row. The Park Service requires a \$15.00 tax for each booth. This may be paid in advance to the Merchants' Autocrat or transacted at the gate A separate receipt will be issued Tradespersons and must be kept at their booth.

Events planned include the usual maybem of broken field battles, mixed sides battles, resurrection battles, bridge battles, battles everywhere for any reason or none at all. After all, it's a bar, right. Also planned for the 13th is a horse event. There will be the ubiquitous Inter-zirgdom Arts Tourney, plus many other frivolities and activities for fighters and noncombatants alike.

The site will open Friday morning for entry and set-up. This year we hope to be able to close the park to all non-SCA activities, so there will be opportunity to leave the mundame world behind and more fully enjoy the Current Middle Ages.

A few random notes: All animals of the four-footed varities must be kept leashed. Waspon and Armor standards will be those in effect by the date of the event as are ordered by the Marchall of the Society


