A change to our previous announcement: there will be lunch and dinner, consisting of traditional Irish and Scots fare, supplied; therefore, the combined site and board fee is \$5.00. 
To reach Leavenworth from I-70: Exit at Bonner Springs (#224). Take 7 & 73 North for 14 miles through Lansing and Leavenworth (and numerous lights) until you must stop at the intersection with 92, which is in the lower right hand corner of the map. You may now turn left, continuing on 7 & 73, which is also Metropolitan Ave.

To reach Leavenworth from I-29: Exit at Platte City, MO. Take 92 west for 10 miles; when you cross the Missouri River, you will be entering the lower right hand corner of the map, and will be on 92 (and 7 & 73), which is also Metropolitan Ave.

From Metropolitan: You may turn north at the first light you encounter and enter the Main Gate on Grant Ave. If you do this, stay on Grant through three lights and a stop sign until it bends sharply west by Bidg. 463 (the Disciplinary Barracks - the large building in the upper right corner of the map). You are now on McPherson Ave., and can follow it until it ends. Take a right on Sheridan Drive, then a left on Wainwright Road, and follow it to the site.

Alternatively (and more simply), continue west on Hetropolitan; you will pass the Federal Penitentiary (and grazing buffalo) on your right. Follow 7 & 73 & 92 as they swing back north while crossing railroad tracks. Turn right into the Back Gate on Hancock Ave. Follow Hancock past the housing areas; turn left on 5th Artillery, then quickly right on Sheridan Drive. Take Sheridan to Wainwright Road to the site, as above.

Either way, watch for the SCA signs.


