From the Minister of Arts

Hola! that is Spanish for Hi! My persona is that of a poor relation/lady in waiting whose father was Welsh and mother is Spanish. I was raised in Spain, due to my father's early death, so I am much more Spanish than Welsh. But enough of me.

Coming up in September (the first weekend, in fact) is V'tavia's Tournament of Valor. We will be having quite an impressive arts and sciences competition, and I am hoping everybody in V'tavia will try to have something to enter. I know I'm planning on it. If you have any questions concerning the event, please call Duke William or Duchess Mammara. If you want to volunteer for anything, again please call the autocrats. They will really appreciate it. I know: I've been there.

Mentioning Mammara brings my mind to dance. Two of the most common types of dance in the S.C.A. are Medieval dance and Middle Eastern dance. We are very fortunate to have the first Laurel in Middle Eastern dance in our barony.

Middle Eastern dance, within period, was used for ceremonies, and performed by professionals. There are several different types of Middle Eastern dance, many times categorized by the area or country where that type developed. As an example, Mammara is a 10th century gawahzee dancer -- gawahzee being a specific Egyptian dance.

Medieval dances are a little different. Anyone could dance them. Peasants created what we call country dances, some of which are done today in several different cultures. Round dances in the S.C.A. are very similar to square dances, down to the same steps with different names.

But in the fifteenth century, high fashion changed and made it very hard for a woman (and some of the men) to dance those sometime boisterous country dances. Bass dances (pronounce it "boss") from France became among the first of what we now call "court" dances.

Fortunately, in the S.C.A., we are not limited to any one kind of dance, whether we be peasants or nobility, amateurs or professionals. Your only limits in dance are time, willingness to learn, and coordination.

BARONIAL SERVICE AWARDS

SERVICE AWARDS MAY BE GIVEN AT SEVERAL TIMES IN THE SCA. THIS NOTE WILL ONLY DESCRIBE THE LOCAL (BARONIAL) LEVEL AWARDS. BARONIAL SERVICE AWARDS ARE OF THREE (FORMAL) TYPES. THESE ARE LISTED FROM THE MOST COMMON AND LEAST DEMANDING TO THE LEAST COMMON AND MOST DEMANDING.

1. ACTS OF DEDICATION: BASICALLY THIS AWARD IS GIVEN (WITHOUT LIMIT AS TO THE NUMBER OF TIMES) FOR EACH ACT WHICH HELPS THE BARONY. THIS HELP MAY BE IN THE FORM OF SPENDING TIME ON A BARONIAL PROJECT (REN FAIRE, CHANNEL 8 TELETHON, ETC...), MAY INVOLVE HELPING TO MAKE THINGS WHICH THE BARONY NEEDS OR WHICH THE BARONY WILL SELL OR IT MAY INVOLVE DOING SOMETHING WHICH IMPROVES THE IMAGE OF THE SCA/BARONY IN THE EYES OF THE PUBLIC. IT MAY ALSO INVOLVE THE VARIOUS ACTIVITIES REQUIRED TO MAKE AN EVENT SUCCESSFUL (E.G., COOKING, SERVING, CLEANING UP, WASHING DISHES, TROLLING).

AN INITIAL ACT OF DEDICATION RESULTS IN A WHITE CORD. FURTHER ACTS OF DEDICATION RESULT IN GOLD LEAVES TO ATTACH TO THE CORD.

2. GOLDEN HEART: THIS SECOND LEVEL ORDER INVOLVES MORE THAN A SINGLE ACT. IT REPRESENTS CONTINUED SERVICE TO THE BARONY AND ALMOST INVARIABLY INVOLVES RESPONSIBILITY FOR SOME MAJOR ACTIVITY OF THE BARONY. THIS ORDER IS GIVEN ONCE AND IS IN THE FORM OF A GOLDEN HEART.
3. STAR OF V'TAVIA: THIS ULTIMATE BARONIAL LEVEL ORDER FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE DEVOTED A VERY SIGNIFICANT PORTION OF THEIR TIME AND ENERGY OVER A VERY SUBSTANTIAL PERIOD OF TIME FOR THE BETTERMENT OF THE BARONY. THIS INDIVIDUAL USALLY HAS BEEN RESPONSIBLE FOR SEVERAL MAJOR ACTIVITIES. THIS ORDER IS GIVEN ONCE AND IS USALLY AFTER THE CONSULTATION OF THOSE IN ORDER. THIS ORDER IS IN THE FORM OF A BADGE.
4. OCCASIONALLY THE BARON/BARONESS WILL DETERMINE THAT AN INDIVIDUAL IS DESERVING OF A SERVICE AWARD, BUT FIND THE INDIVIDUAL HAS ALREADY RECEIVED THAT AWARD. TO SOLVE THIS PROBLEM, THEY HAVE SET UP THE BARONIAL TREASURE CHEST TO PROVIDE AN OPPORTUNITY TO ACKNOWLEDGE SUCH INDIVIDUALS AND TO PROVIDE THEM WITH A SMALL TOKEN OF THE BARONY'S APPRECIATION.

IN EACH AND EVERY CASE IN WHICH A MEMBER OF THE POPULACE HAS OBSERVED ANOTHER ENGAGE IN SOME SERVICE FOR THE BARONY, THE BARON AND BARONESS SHOULD BE NOTIFIED. THEIR EXCELLENCIES HAVE SUGGESTED THAT THIS NOTIFICATION BE IN WRITING TO ASSURE THAT NO MESSAGE IS FORGOTTEN.

NOTIFICATION FOR AN ACT OF DEDICATION WILL USALLY BE QUITE SIMPLE. IT WILL IDENTIFY THE PERSON WHO DID IT, THE PERSON REPORTING IT AND THE ACT ITSELF. SOMETIMES IT MAY BE USEFUL TO NOTE THE DATE WHEN IT OCCURED. PROVIDING INFORMATION REGARDING " HIGHER LEVEL" SERVICES USALLY OCCURES AS A FUNCTION OF MANY REPORTS AND OFTEN DESCRIBES SERVICES IN SOMEWHAT GREATER DETAIL, BUT NO SPECIFIC FORMAT CURRENTLY EXISTS.

REMINDER: THIS BARONY EXISTS BECAUSE OF THE SERVICES EACH OF US PERFORMS WITH AND FOR EACH OTHER. TO BE ACKNOWLEDGED BY YOUR FRIENDS OFTEN MEANS MORE THAN ANY OTHER FORM OF REWARD. TO ACKNOWLEDGE THE SERVICE OF YOUR FRIENDS IS TO GIVE THEM THAT VERY IMPORTANT REWARD.

Wyvernwehr

Once upon a time, there was a man called Humpk who had come from a land far to the west to establish a shire and a household. The land would be known as V'tavia, and the household, Wyvernwehr.

The household was originally established as a cadet branch of House Locksley, a household in Atevelt Humpk was in. The first members of Wyvernwehr are also the first in the shire of V'tavia: Humpk, Mammara, Belpheobe, Nitram, and a short time later, Cite and Aeltric. Since that time, Wyvernwehr has dropped the connection with House Locksley (since Locksley lost touch with Humpk and its cadet household), and has grown and changed quite a lot in the last 10 years.

Wyvernwehr is the oldest household in V'tavia, and therein lies one of its most unique features. It holds also two of the three pairs of royal peers in V'tavia, and both members of the Order of the Laurel. Its leaders, Duke Sir William V'tavia (once Humpk of Bohun) and Duchess Mammara Leona, and their quality of leadership has contributed also greatly to the type of household Wyvernwehr is.

And just what is Wyvernwehr? It is a household that has been comparatively inactive during much of its life, due to its leaders being reigning monarchs rather often, yet has managed to increase its membership slowly despite that. In its earlier days, most of the members travelled everywhere together, camped together, and partied together. Today, that is not so consistent, but the members of this group are still tightly-knit. The ducal manor is nearly always open to any member of the household at nearly any time for almost any reason a member may have, a family home where one may be sure of support, help, or just answers to questions.

Membership in Wyvernwehr currently numbers between 8 and 15, depending on who you count (one or two are considered kind of iffy in that respect). Though somewhat inactive for several years, the household is re-emerging as a strong, close-knit group under the easy-going but determined leadership of Calontir's only Duke and Duchess.

The only person in Wyvernwehr who has lost anything by being in the household is William, who said he had lost "most of my hair!" Every other person in Wyvernwehr has only gained by being a part of the oldest household in V'tavia.

TAKING THE HIGH GROUND: Word-Fighting for the SCA

SCA people think and write a lot about fighting with swords, and their advice often works well with rattan weapons. Some would even help with live steel. However, we don't fight with swords in the SCA, we play with them. When we fight in earnest, we use words - and most of our word-fighting technology is pretty pitiful.

Our typical verbal warrior acts like a berserker. Metaphorically, he foams at the mouth, casts off his clothes, and charges in with whatever comes to hand. He can do a lot of damage, but he can also get terribly hurt. Though he rarely gains his objective, he never changes his tactics - he finds it cowardly to don armor and wrongheaded to pick and choose among his weapons. He believes he must make a direct attack, mixing loaded arguments with insults and accusations, because nothing else feels like combat at all. However, a word-fighter who does choose his approach and weapons can reach his goals without taking a bruise. Here are the basics of skilled word-fighting:

1. Take the high ground. A swordsman wants the best footing and the angle that adds most to his defense and attack. Word-fighting is the same, save that the "ground" you want to seize is in the mind of your opponent, and of any outsider whose opinion may affect the outcome. Every word you deploy needs to help establish you as wise and thoughtful. Never show anger. Never react when your opponent seems to do something irrational. If you keep working calmly toward the results you want, you're likely to get them - either by wearing your opponent down, or by persuading an arbitrator that yours is the better case.
2. Choose your target. A swordsman who pounds on his opponent's shield wastes his strength, and lets his opponent attack without worrying about self-defense. Likewise, a verbal warrior wastes his strength if he demands something his opponent can't do. Before you strike, be sure no human or natural laws preclude the results you want.
3. Co-opt the truth. The rules of swordplay forbid it, but someone in a real fight is free to take his opponent's weapon away and use it. A word-fighter must be alert for such chances, too. When your opponent proves you wrong on anything, adopt a correction fast, in terms that make it clear the new course is your free choice. Defending an obvious error can lose you the high ground forever.
4. Keep to the main goal. Beware the lure of simple carnage! Word-fighting is meant to change your opponent's behavior. Hurt him too much, and you stiffen his resistance. Besides, if you choose your tactics purely for their hurtful effect, you're not fighting - you're practicing sadism.
5. Make your opponent fight for you. Even swordsmen look for ways to take advantage of opposing strength. There are other martial arts based much more heavily on that premise, and word-fighting is one of them. The trick is to tie your opponent's desires to your own, so he gets at least some of what he wants when you get what you want. Plays like this grow naturally in the SCA, because we have so much in common with each other, and because we face so few either-or choices. It's usually possible to find room for the whole range of interests on any question.

The peculiar side-effect of this style of combat is that if both sides use it equally well, they wind up sharing the high ground. The worst that can happen to either is that both win. However, if one drops into berserker-gang, the damage he does recruits support for his opponent, and he may well come out with nothing. Physical violence is out, so a failed berserker has no options but eating his words or leaving the field - that is, the SCA - entirely. Fight sane, and win!

The Seventeenth Pennsic War will be held during the week of August 15th. thru the 22nd. The site will open to those gentles who wish to arrive early before this date. However, no camp site may be roped off until August 8th.

The site is Cooper's Lake Campground. To get to Cooper's lake take the following directions. Find your best route to (I-79.) in Pennsylvania near Pittsburg. Travel north to Exit 29, [Pa. 422] located at mile marker 99 on (I-79). At the bottom of the ramp make a left turn onto [Pa. 422 west] go one mile towards the town of New Castle, look for Pennsic War signs on your right. Travel down this road over a small bridge. The Campground will be on your right.

GENERAL CAMPING RULES.

This event is a non-reservation event. Camps may be established on or after August 8th. This is when the Autocrat will be on site. Once the autocrat is on site, gentles who wish to hold a large area of ground must observe the following regulations:

1. On a 8 1/2 by 11 inch sheet of paper, clearly written place the following information; Mundane name, SCA name, group name, number and size of tents.
2. Make several copies of this information sheet.
3. Give one Copy to the Autocrat. I will be at autocrat's point or the Security tent as of August 8th.
4. The second copy should be posted clearly at your encampment. This copy should be protected from the elements.
5. Rope off your area and set up your camp. An area for fire pits and a cout should be taken into account when setting up your encampment.

These lists serve several purposes. The sheet shows the group's need for hold a large area. If someone complains about the size of a group's encampment, I can justify the use of that land. This should prevent the misuse of land by groups who take to much land. The area you have roped off will be recorded on a master mapkept by the autocrat. The list will also make it easier to find you incase of an emergency. This list is the final word on land disubutes. Land will be recorded on a first come first serve basis on and after August 8th. The time before this will not be considered to be an SCA event. No group should send or mail any list to the autocrat before they arive on site. These lists are not reservations. They simply show where your camp is located.

Ghost encampments will not be allowed. There must be at least one person camping within a roped off area. All encampments should have a fire extinguisher. The extinguisher should be rate for chemical, liquid fires, nylon and etc. Gentles should bring there own picnic tables, as there is never enough of them to go around. An area will be held for those gentles who are not camping with any of the large groups. Those gentles who have only one or two tent and no one to stay with on the site.

Minors attending the war, must be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian. A letter appointing a temporary guardian is not a satisfactory substitute. No minor is allowed to participate in combat at the war. Pets are not permitted to attend the war. They will not be allowed onto the site.

This year we are maintaining a twenty four hour security point, located at the circle by the barn. This will also be the site of the Lost and Found.

Those gentles who wish to merchant at the war should contact the Cooper's Merchant Organizer, Gail Lefkowitz, 2488 My Royal Road, Pittsburg, Pa., 15217.

There will be activities taking place during the week of the 15th of August. There will be different tournaments taking place during the week. the major war points will be fought on Friday through Sunday. Classes will begin on Monday morning and run through the week. A Page's School will be open to children five years of age and older. Archery will take place throughout the entire week. On Thursday night there shall be a masked ball in the barn. The theme of the dance will be "Fire and Ice". If you are interested in participating on more than a casual level, ie. you want to teach or perform, please contact the aproprate sub-autocrat listed below.

There is always need for volunteers to help the war effort. We are looking for gentles to help in several areas of the war. The Troll booth is always in need of groups to work on the off hours. Security will be organizing a neighborhood watch. Musicians are needed for the masked ball on Thursday night.

Those gentles who require medical or special needs should contact the autocrat in writing as soon as possible. I will make as many reasonable arrangements for you and your household as we can. If you do not contact me before you arrive at the war, I may not be able to help you. Time is an important factor. Please place all request and comments in writing.
