Then to round out the day, We'll unleash the "Hounds-of-War" to hunt down those nasty monsters. During the day we will also have real weapons and archery contests.

The Arts: The Arts contests will have two divisions (less than 3 years in the SCA or 3 years +) and will include: period signature: costume (period dress incorporating kingdom,shire, or household device): metal working (armour/non-armour): leather working: poetry: illumination: weaving: period wine or liqueur: Bardic Battles (short story or poem, and two live performances). KANSAS CITY RENAISSANCE FESTIVAL

Once again, the Barony of Forgotten Sea will be providing SCA involvement at the KC Renaissance Festival. The weekends this year are: September 3-5, 10-11, 17-18, 24-24, October 1-2, 3-9 and 15-16. As a special added bonus, the Barony's annual Michaelmas Feast will be held on the Festival site the evening of Spetember 24.

The autocrats for this year's Fest are Lord Tobias der Krieger and Lady Aidan Cocrinn. The autocrat for the Michaelmas event is Baroness Susannah (816 561-4083) and advance registration will be required to attend this.

Passes: Only 100 passes will be available to SCA this year. so a few changes have been made to the way things run. Anyone wishing to participate in any fashion at Fest this year MUST contact Ly. Aidan in advance to schedule to work/fight/demo so that a pass may be reserved in their name. Passes will be held at the Participant's Sate only, and only until noon the day you're scheduled. After that, trey'll be given out as needed, no guarantees. Also, when you arrive to work, your hand will be stamped with an SCA pass. Due to tighter PenFest security, we cannot allow our people to shear. in as in years past. Anyone claiming to be SCA must albe schedules to work, b) check in at the participant's sate and chave the hand stamp or we won't claim them. Also, anyone entering Renaissance Festival on a SCA pass is expected to participate in the SCA activities for half the time they're on 31 14.

Garci Renaissance Fuetival has complained that, since we do this year-round, will don't we display better costumes at Fest" Well, the re right. This year, you MUST be in a reasonable attempt at period garb (just like any other event, folis') to participate in the SCA dell. This will be strictly enforced int jeans and sneakers!). Also, blatantly mendant items, tall and smoking should be reserved for areas out of the public eye (ie: behind the wall).

Demos: Any and all demos are welcome. The only restrictions are that items displayed and demonstrated be QUALITY. AUTHENTIC, PERIOD, HAND-MADE works of those showing them. Groups within the SCA may sell merchandise for the benefit of the SCA only (contact an autocrat in advance). All others may display works, no price tags, and take commissions or sales off site.

Also, we would like to schedule some demos in-between fronts (like dancing, costume show, singing, etc.). Please contact Lady Aidan ASAF if you wish to do anything like this. KenFest, Inc. will publish us in the daily schedule handed out to quests, too!

Camping: Camping in the RenFest campground will be arranged if requests are given to the autocrat at least 1 week in advance (Campground access is by pass only). Also, we are allowed 6 responsible adults in the Dell to guard the stuff and provide security at night. Contact the autocrat if you think you qualify. Crash space in town during Fest is available, but arrangements must be arranged privately.

The emphasis this year at Fest is on following Fest Inc.'s rules, participating in Festival (not just in SCA area) and on being as period as possible. Once again, space is limited, so it is imperative that you call in advance to reserve your pass. Lady Aidan will have a phone genie to assist her in this endeavor, so please leave coherent messages. Also, hers is a mostly-mundane household, so please act accordingly and no calls after 10:30 pm CST.



Pets, fireworks, and ground fires are not allowed. Raised fires, alcohol, and merchants are allowed. Swimming will be allowed if sufficient W.S.I.'s volunteer for guard duty.

The Guardian Tourney will determine our new Guardian and Queen of Grace and Wisdom. In addition there will be a Newby Tourney for those who have fought for 1 year/3 tourneys or less. Other fighting activities planned are: a Guardians vs. the World Melee, a Woods Battle, and any other scenarios that time permits and the fighters are willing to try.




