


From the Deneschal

On a seperate note, I am forming a Chain mail Guild in the Barony. Fee-mails are still my favorite though.... Talk to me or read more about it next month.



Greetings to you all.

Now is the time to start thinking back and planning ahead. I want you to think back for a few minutes to where you were at the first of this year.

Vere you in the SCA then? What were you doing then? What have you done within the SCA since? Have you learned anything? What have you learned new, or what have you learned more of, or learned better?

When you answer these questions for yourself, tell me. Some of those answers pertain to V'tavia's arts and sciences. This receipe is adapted from Thomas Austin (Ed.), Two Fifteenth Century Cookery Books, London, 1888; specifically, the ms Harleian 279.11.4.

Take a quart of hony, & sethe it, & skeme it clean; take safroun pouder, pouder Pepir, & prow per=on; take grated brede, & make it chargeant pat it wol be y=lechyed; pen take pouder Canelle, & straw per=on y=now; pen make yit square as pou wolt leche yt; take when pou lechyst hyt a caste Box lebes a=bouen, y=styked per=on clowys. An zif you wolt have it Red, coloure it with Saunderys y=now.

Gyngere Brede

My receipe is taken directly from "Pleyn Delite" with only suggestions about the bread crumbs and additional items which may be added to the Brede. I would encourange anyone to try it. The receipe is wonderfully simple and the results appear to be enjoyable.

1/2 cup clear honey
Fine crumbs from one loaf bread (I usually use a bit less than one loaf, but
it depends on bread size and dryness). I also use only whole wheat or
combination grain breads. I think it tastés better and should be more period.
Air dry bread, toasting produces a slightly burnt flavor
1 tsp ginger, 1 tsp cinnamon
1/8th ground white pepper

Bring honey to a boil and skim, if required. Keeping honey on warm, stir in seasonings and then crumbs until mixture is a gummy, near-solid mass. Refrigerate overnight and then cut or tear into small pieces. I have added dried and candied fruit to mine and like both. I think you could also add nuts or a combination of two or more.

I have kept it in the refrigerator for approximately one week, in plastic, with no adverse effects. I haven't checked the effects of freezing. I like to serve the Brede cool (a few minutes out of the refrigerator). As it warms the Brede becomes somewhat gooey and messy to handle.

November 5th, A.S. XXIII Barony of Three Rivers (St. Louis, MO)

The Barony of Three Rivers is honored to host the eleventh Calontir Crown Tournament.

The Day Site is Grant Pavilion in Jefferson Barracks County Park. All of the day activities shall take place in and around the pavilion. This is a DRY site. For those individuals who wish, lunch may be obtained at numerous fast-food establishments close by.

Merchants: All SCA merchants are welcome at the day site. However, if the weather requires the tournament to be held indoors, the space for merchants will be limited to a maximum of 10 jointly-shared tables for all merchants. All merchants must register in advance with the Autocrat, Lady Elin Redlock.

Child Care: A supervised Children's Activity area will be provided for \$2.00 per child, which includes a lunch for the child. This area will open at 10:30 a.m., and close at 4 p.m. There will be no child care or separate area available at the feast site.

Other Daytime Activities:

Gaming—Various game boards will be available for general use.

Dancing—if the tournament is held outdoors.

Archery—A nearby walk-thru range is available for those who wish, but there is no scheduled competition.

The Feast Site is Bonhomme Presbyterian Church. There will be a feast of four removes for a maximum of 200 people. In addition, there is space for off-board dining. This is a DRY site, and smoking is prohibited within the building. Post-revels will be announced. Court will be held on-site. We must clear the feast site by 11:30 p.m.

Crash Space: Crash space is by private arrangement only. A listing of area motels is in the Seneschals' Flyer. Individuals wishing copies of that flyer, please send a S.A.S.E. to our Seneschal, Viscount Master Master Brummbär von Schwarzberg.





The following poem is written in English as a Trecento (14th century) Italian Sonnet, using the sonnets of Folgore Da San Gemignano as a model. Folgore's sonnets were 14 lines long, each line of 10 to 11 syllables. Rhyming was in an A,B,B,A; A,B,B,A; C,D,C; D,C,D format. Translated copies of Forgore's work can be found in J.A. Symonds "Renaissance in Italy: Italian Literature" (Charles Scribner's Sons: New York, 1907).


