IN SERVICE TO THE SOCIETY --

February is traditionally the month of love. On a kingdom level, a Royal Court of Love will be held this month under our Princess. Since this is a relatively uncommon practice some background on the uses and jurisdiction of such tribunals may be useful.

There is much confusion about what a Court of Love is and what it does. There is a relative void of researchable information on the actual middle ages courts, with the one notable exception of a series of works started in the late 12th century by Andrew the Chaplain and continued through the early 17th century till completed by Martial d'Auvengne in around 1629. Most of the work is privately owned, but a handful of authors have had access to parts of it and published enough to work from.

According to these works, a Court of Love was a council composed of ladies of success, status, and beauty. Though not a rule, the wast majority were married or widowed, for when decisions were to be made, it was important that these ladies had experienced what they talked about. It was an open forum, wherein one could find solutions to disputes arising from the finer and more subtle points of love.

One traditional and published example had to do with a young woman's trouble with her lover. The lady complained that where once her lover had been lively and joyful and vital, he had become pensive and depressed. He saw no beauty in the world around him,, and even the minstrels songs made him bitter.

His response was to urge the understanding that in the service of love, pain and sorrow were necessary, and that there was no joy which was not purchased at the expense of a hundred sorrows. The loyal lover, he said, was bound to be the most sorrowful man in the world. He begged the court to be allowed to depart from the service of love in general.

His lady, however, stated that no such permission should be granted, and that started the accusations flying. By the end of the day, the court had reached it's decision. The gentleman was to be exiled into the country and held prisoner in a beautiful garden for the period of one month, so as to regain his sense of proportion and balance of thought. Furthermore, the young lady was to accompany him and remain there for the month or more, until he was quite cured.

The judgments of these courts a constituted, of the second of the second of weight. A gentleman was required to act on any fair request, and since love is the province of emotion, and emotion was (and is) the specialty of ladies, their opinions were to be respected. To do otherwise was to risk public scorn. Also, in the formative years of the tribunals, the founders spread tales of the finding of scrolls listing the precepts of the courts. There scrolls were supposedly found chained to the necks of dragons or the talons of falcons, and gaurded by the same sorcery and enchantment which created them. This mystical aspect lent some power and credibility to the tribunals themselves, and by the 13th century, there had been adopted a standard list of court precepts. Here is that list:

- 1 Marriage cannot be pleaded as an excuse for refusing to love.
- 2 A person who cannot keep a secret can never be a lover.
- 3 No one can truly love two people at the same time.
- 4 Love never stands still, it either grows, or dies.
- 5 Favours which are yielded unwillingly are tasteless.
- 6 A person of the male sex cannot be considered a lover until he has passed boyhood.
- 7 If one of two lovers dies, love must be forsworn at lease two years in advance.
- 8 No one, when once a lover, can be deprived of his title without good reason indeed.
- 9 No one can love, unless the soft persuasion of love itself compels him.
- 10 Love is always an exile where avarice holds it's dwelling
- 11 It is not becomming to love those ladies who love only with an eye to marriage.

12 A true lover never desires the favours of any but his own lady-love, out of true affection.

- 13 A love that has once been rendered common and commonplace as a rule never endures very long.
- 14 Too easy possession renders love contemptable. Possesion with difficulty makes love a prize.
- 15 Every lover is accustomed to grow pale at the sight of his lady-love.
- 16 At the sudden and unexpected prospect of his lady, the heart of the true lover invariably palpitates.
- 17 A new love affair banishes the old entirely.
- 18 It is only worth and excellence that make a man worthy to be loved by a lady.
- 19 If love once begins to diminish, it quickly fades away as a rule, and rarely recovers.
- 20 A real lover is always the prey and anxiety of malaise
- 21 The affection of love invariably increases under the influence of jealousy.
- 22 When one of the lovers begins to entertain suspicion of the other, jealousy and love grow at once.
- 23 A person who is the prey of love eats little and sleeps less.
- 24 Every action of a lover terminates with the thought of the loved one.
- 25 A true lover thinks there is no happiness except in the pleasing of his beloved.

26 Love can deny nothing to love.


- 27 & lover can never be surfeited with the consolation his beloved might offer him.
- 28 A moderate presumption is sufficient to justify one lover in entertaining grave suspicions of the other.
- 29 Too great prodigality of favours is not advisable, for a lover who is wearied with a superabundance of pleasure is as a rule disinclined to love.
- 30 A true lover is enthralled with the perpetual image of his lady, which never leaves his mind.
- 31 Nothing prevents one lady or gentleman from being loved by more than one.

As you can see, the precepts in this list have stayed with us until today. Are they of enchanted origin? Probably not. One thing is for certain, however. In such a time as this, it is pleasing to begin the reinstatement of such a noble activity, and to all of us in Calontir the results should prove immensiey profitable and enjoyable.


