



From the Seneschal

Hail and wellmet:

I'm sure you'll all heard the comment, "It's the seneschal's fault!" We've all had a good chuckle over it. In realty, however, chances are it's true. Since I expect to step down as seneschal sometime during this year I thought I'd give you a job description of what the office entails.

The easiest part is the reports, monthly and quarterly. They are mostly fill-in-the-blank. In addition the seneschal keeps copies of all reports done by all the

officers in the barony. (You need a file!)

The most important job within the SCA context is keeping the other office; and those who fill them going If an office is not being executed, the seneschal must fill that offices duties. This means that if a report does not get get filed the seneschal should file it. This is especially important as regards to the treasure's office. If the treasurer is not doing his/her job the seneschal must!

A seneschal also schedules group events and meetings and finds meeting places. This includes demos. My policy on doing demos is that we must have some tie-in with where we are doing the demo-a reaissance faire, a knights-in-armor theme or something similar. I have not done science fiction conventions, for example, even though invited, because I feel it takes away from our historical basis. Our research is based on fact, not fantasy.

The other important area the seneschal is in charge of is dealing with the non-SCA world. We must keep our image positive and on track. The seneschal signs all contracts-period. No one clse has the authority to do so If you sign a contract without authority you become personally responsible. (Ask Briallen.)

The other main responsibility is to disseminate information I get flyers on events from many other groups, including some from outside our kingdom. I can also give you intoout of the Mews on events you may want to attend.

Lastly, the seneschal keeps track of the number of memberships the Barony has. This information, with a phone list and, sometimes, an order of precedence from the herald, is printed in the census.

As you can see, the list is long, and even so I have not included many of the details! These are also many minor responsibilities I have included. (Like everything else!)

Personas

The development of a persona is one of the most difficult, challenging, important and rewarding things you can do in the SCA. A persona is the total of the creation you have made in a choosing a milieu and name, or complex enough to include several generations of ancestors, an entirely new system of morality and several decades of life-span. Of course, the more complex your persona is the more difficult it is to create; and the more rewarding it can be. Much of what I have learned about the middle-ages I have discovered as a result of researching my persona.

Some aspets of your persona are required by Kingdom or SCA law. Everyone should have a persona name and wear medieval clothing. Other aspects are dictated by peer (or Peer) presure with-in the SCA. Almost everyone will have a coat-of-arms, or 'device' registered by the herald's office if they are in the group long enough. Still others will tell you what your nationality or tribal identity is, and your choice of clothing style

will tend to select your era.

In real-life, few of us get the chance to select our names. Our parents do that for us, for good or ill. In the SCA, within a reasonalbe framework, you get to chose your own name. The rules are: you may not select a name which would infringe upon copy right laws (no Frodo son of Dragos or Conan the Barbarians) nor any names of actual historical people (no Richard the Lion-Hearteds or Francis Drakes). You may not chose a name of legendary or mythological heros (no Robin Hoods, or Thor Odinssons) nor any name that would imply devine or non-human origins (no Diana Seaspawn's or Mordcar the Elfs) and Jesus ben'Jehova is right out. Now that I've excluded every name you ever wanted to use, let me give you a few examples that work: Frodo the Pict, Conan MacNamara, Richard the Fleet-footed, John Drake the Seafarer, Francis Hood the Forester, Olaf Thorsmann, Diana the Cast-a-way or Mordear the Wise. Jesus (Hey-Zeuz) d Cordoba is OK, Jesus Christ is still right out. The name you chose should be in only one or two languages, three is allowed only if your persona's life history require it. Abdul Rozuli is great, Abdul Rozuli Smith is OK, Abdul Razuli Smith d'Burgoyne is barely acceptible, Abdul Razuli Smith d'Burgoyne der Flidermaus is not.

Your name should conform to the standard naming practices of the milieu you have chosen. Aelfric son of Fritharik was orginaly my choice of names, but that did't fit with the early Anglo-Saxon pattern, so I became Aelfric Frithariksson. Cire Greymoor el'Abrab, became Edward Cire of Greymoor, because, while Cire could be documented as a surname, French or Norman customdidn't allow for using a surname as a first name, as 19th & 20th cnetury English does (Jefferson Davis, Franklin

Rosevelt).

Chosing a name can be difficult, not from lack of choise, but because there is so much to chose from. The Corpora lists our limits as pre 17th Century Western Europe. If you REALLY want to be Ugh the rock-lord from Neander you can (expect all sorts of problems, though). Traditionally hte earliest to latest date limit is 650 A.D. to 1650 A.D. Thats a full millinium, a thousand years of choice, more over, only culture which maintianed contact, during that period, with Western Europe is allowable. You can be Arabic, Greek, Russian, Nubian, Mongol, even Japanese or Central American Indian.

With such a wide selection of names availble you might want to chose a miliue first. You probalby already have an interest in history or you wouldn't have joined the SCA. Pick a period of time or an event which you find interesting and build you persona around it.

As an archeology student, I was always fascinated by the question of Arthur: did he really exist, or was he just a legend When I began looking at the Aurthurian era with a view toward establishing my persona, I decided to be one of his adversaries (it's fun to watch peopled reation when you call Arthur a usurper or a cheat!). But Arthur was pre-650 A.D. OK so, Grandad Luideris fought against Arthur. When I joined the SCA I had no intention of fighting. How do you incorperate a pacifist and scholar into a warrior society? I made Aelfric a Christian and put him in the monastory at Yarrow. Just for fun I placed him there at a time hwen the Venerable Bede, historian, scholar and potential saint was teaching. To add a bit of drama I made my father, Fritharik, one of the hold-outs when Northumbria converted, he still believes in the old gods. When I began fighting I explained that I was asked to leave the monastary because I was fooling around with the abbot's daughter (celebacy for priests wasn't required until the mid 700's). By extrapolatium I can tell you many things about Aelfric. Because of his time at the monastary, he can read and write, a rare talent at that time, and he has garnered some knowledge of herbs from the fathers. All of which has made him valuable to his master, Aedward Cire, to whom he is indentured, to avoid going back into Fritharik's pagon household. And so on. You can see how it works, a basic framwork of facts can be built on to create a whole infrastructure of extrapolations nad infurences abbut your persona. In addition, if you allow, it will grow and change, even as your real personality does. Or if you wish you can freeze it in place at age 21; something you cannot do in this

To begin you pick a time, Aelfric's time-frame can be described thusly: Within the life-span of the Venerable Bede, while he was teaching and writing at Yarrow. Aelfric had to be born early enough, though, to be at least 10 years old when he went into the monastary, and at least 14-16 years old when he left, after all, he was fooling around with girls. So Aelfric was born 690 A.D. You can be more arbitrary if you wish.

Next, pick a place. Aelfric was an Anglo-Saxon, so he needed to be on Great Britain. people in the Dark Ages generally didn't travel much, so if, he joined hte monastary at Yarrow he had to be from Northumbria or Mercia. Mercia was in political decline and Northumbrian culture would peak at about 750 A.D., so I elected to be Northumbrian.

Now you need to decide upon your station in life. Aelfric is an Angle in a Kingdom conqured by Angles, so he's not likely to be a peasant, besides, in the SCA you're assumed to be at least gentility unless you wish other-wise. To avoid being tied to inherited responsibilties, Aelfric is the forth son of a successful warrior and thegn (a thegn corrispands roughly with the knight of later ages: a holder of a least five units of land, called a hide, and responsible to provide military service for that land). Remember that you must earn titles in the SCA, so you cannot say Dad was Count d'Monny and be the eldest son without providing an excuse for being disinherited.

If you've done all these things you now know the name, time, place, and social milieu of your persona. Research will show you your style of dress, likely associates, probale cultural biases, opportunities for trade, education, and travel and all the other factors which allow you to select the details of the new you. Just one more bit of advise before I set pen aside-in general, the earlier and more barbaric your persona, the less you can depend upon written history. Such persona depend upon archeology for hard facts with lots of imformation gaps that have to be filled in by suppossition, reason, and extrapolation. This can be fun; or it can be alot of work depending on your attitude. Good Luck!


