Their Majesties' Court was opened by Lady Searlaith nic Uilliam O'Ceallaigh ten minutes about before eight. HRM Gabriel greeted the populace assembled. Two Knights, Baron Sir Tedrick von Wolfschatten and Sir Stephen du Norfolk, responded the a call for the Knights present and swore their fealty to the Crown.

HRM Gabriel then explained that as this event was not considered a Kingdom level event, the dates of the awards were those of the next Royal Court at a Kingdom event, i.e., the Costuming Seminar at Forgotten Sea, February second.

With the gracious permission of Their Majesties, Lady Cairiona de Brynton opened a Court of the Barony of Vatavia. His Excellency, Baron Gawayne, announced his appeal to the other Barons of Calontir for aid in the coming war with Tritatia and informed the populace that there is a Tritatian spy among us. Baron Sir Tedrick and Lord Magnus O'Carr were summoned and the Badges of the Golden Heart which they had given to new members of the Order were replaced. Members of the Order of the Golden Heart who had received tokens in place of badges were summoned. Ladies Marie Chantal and Eleanor ap Rhywallon and Lords Leonardo and James of Vatavia were presented with Badges in exchange for their tokens.

Citizenship cords, in recognition of their membership in the Society, were presented to Seana McLeod, Big Bear of Hammerstorm and Pairoc the Archer. Several announcements were made before Lady Searlaith closed these Courts at about thirty minutes after the hour of eight.

Unto the Archery Officers of the SCA, and other interested archers
of the Known World

From Sir Jon Fitz-Rauf, Keeper of the IKAC & IKCAC

Greetings:

This year's competition is now over and participation and average scores are higher than ever: a good sign that archery continues to thrive in most kingdoms.

I hope that all Kingdoms will acknowledge the efforts of their top three archers in each division. Even if they did not win first place, for they made an effort, both to show their own skill and for the glory of their Kingdom. Perhaps some ceremony could be done at Twelfth Night, which would acknowledge them and also encourage other archers to put forth their best efforts next year.

Next year SCA archers will have a chance to meet and compete at TFYC. Since the event begins before the new starting date for the IK's, (April 1 st.), I am allowing scores shot at TFYC to be counted as official.

Changes to the rules for both competitions will take effect as of TFYC. I present them for your information and for comments, if any:

- 1) Both competitions will begin April 1, in the Northern hemisphere. The closing date remains unchanged. The dates for the Southern Hemisphere are now Dec. 1 to July 1.
- 2) Archers may shoot for official score in each division, each day of any two or more day event.
- 3) Major events, such as Estrella War, or Kingdom level events, that are held before April 1, may be granted official scoring if requested well in advance.
- 4) Scores must be postmarked within thirty days of being shot to be counted as official.
- 5) The scores must include full information. Kingdom, date, event, Archer in charge's name, address and phone number: complete scores by end, and total score. Please include what division each archer is shooting: Open, TLB, Etc., (not Bowman, Master Bowman, etc.). Where division is not listed, scores will be posted as Open. Please print clearly- I type it as I see it.
- 6) Please send me a copy of your score sheet, not just a listing of total scores. Send a copy to your Kingdom Archery officer, and keep a copy for your own files as well.
- 7) Each longbow score may be entered in only one division. If you shoot a longbow, you must shoot separately in Open or TLB to enter a score for both divisions.
- 8) You are permitted the use of a tape recorder with a recording of the thirty second count-down for timing speed rounds.
- 9) Any archer using techniques which could be a safety hazard to their self or to others, such as shooting two or more arrows at once, must prove to the satisfaction of the archer in charge their ability to use the technique safely.

10) In shooting a speed round, you MUST draw your own arrows, NO ONE may hand them to you!

11) No archer may use any post 1600 material or that gives an unfair advantage to the archer using it. These include but are not limited to: Bow sights other than simple limb marks, stabilizers or balance bars, Berger buttons, other than simple one piece arrow rests, kisser buttons, non-period string releases, bow quivers, string walking, etc.

Please let me know if you change your address or if there is a change of Kingdom archery officer in your Kingdom. This is so that I can keep all Kingdom archery officers informed of IK standings and information. Could you also inform me if there is a change in your kingdom chronicler or their address.

Has your Kingdom newsletter been printing all of my monthly IK announcements? If they have not, is there some other way to get the information to the archers in your kingdom or to encourage the chronicler to print them?

Just a note on the scores in the IKCAC. The higher scores have been shot with either Saunders or HTM style arrows, followed by Markland style and then Golf Tube. I hope to see more scores next year shot with the Marklands and Golf Tubes so that a better comparison of their accuracy can be made. Do any of you have statistics on their range and accuracy?

Does anyone know if a change has been made to the SCA light combat rules regarding maximum bow weight? The most current information I have still sets a thirty pound limit, which would not allow the use of Golf Tubes with the heavier bows needed to shoot them a reasonable distance. I need to see a copy of the rule change or I need to change the limit on bow weight for Golf Tubes for the IKCAC down to thirty pounds.

Does anyone have information on the combat archery class and other combat events that were held at Pennsic? What are the chances of a IKCAC being shot at Pennsic?

Is anyone planning to set up and run a SCA wide Winter Archery competition next year, as was done on a limited scale before? I would like to see one, but have no desire to run it.

Do any of you have information on improved combat javelin construction and tactics or competitions?

By next season I may be set up to receive scores by E-mail, but I am not sure yet. I would appreciate any information on this topic, for I am quite a novice at it.

Please pass this information on to any interested archers in your area so that they will be informed in advance.

Well, that is about it. Seasons Best to all of you and yours. Please write if you have any questions or comments on the changes.

The Calontir Cookery Guild is proud to be invited to help their highness with a project for TFYC. Their highness have requested that the Guild prepare plates of period "nibbles" to be presented to by the crown to the Nobility at TFYC. The Calontir Cookery Guild is trying to organize the cooks of Calontir. I would greatly appreciate your assistance by announcing this project to the members of your group. It may even be possible for the members of your group to work together to produce a donation to the project.

All Cooks in Calontir are invited to participate in this project. The contributions will be presented formally at Coronation. All contributions must conform to the following criteria.

1. **PLEASE NOTE!!!!!!** Contact Ld. Demetrius II Condottierro (address and phone in the back of R.S.) **before** you start cooking! Ld. Demetrius is organizing the contributions to ensure that there isn't an overabundance of any particular item. Please make sure to contact Ld. Demetrius by Feb. 25.

2. The items will need to remain fresh for the ~~two~~ weeks between Coronation and TFYC. They will also need to withstand a variety of environmental conditions especially the heat at TFYC. The Crown should not be burdened by the need to provide special conditions and environments for the contributed goods. Some freezing and outdoor refrigeration may be available while the items are in Calontir.

3. Donated items should come in units of 24 or be divisible by 24. There will be 24 plates of delicacies, one for each person on the Crowns list. Two items per plate (or 48 servings) is preferable.

4. If possible we would appreciate a donation of a decorative serving container for your contribution (i.e. decorative tins). We will not be able to return the containers. If this is a problem please contact Ld. Demetrius.

5. The recipe and name of the recipe should be included with/attached to the donated item.

6. Lastly, this doesn't need to be said but I'll mention it just in case. Since this is a Guild sponsored activity we would like all donations to be as period as possible.

7. We would like the contact people to please help organize the Guild members in their area and to help arrange the transportation of contributions to Coronation. If you do not

have a local contact person, (You guessed it!) contact Demetrius.

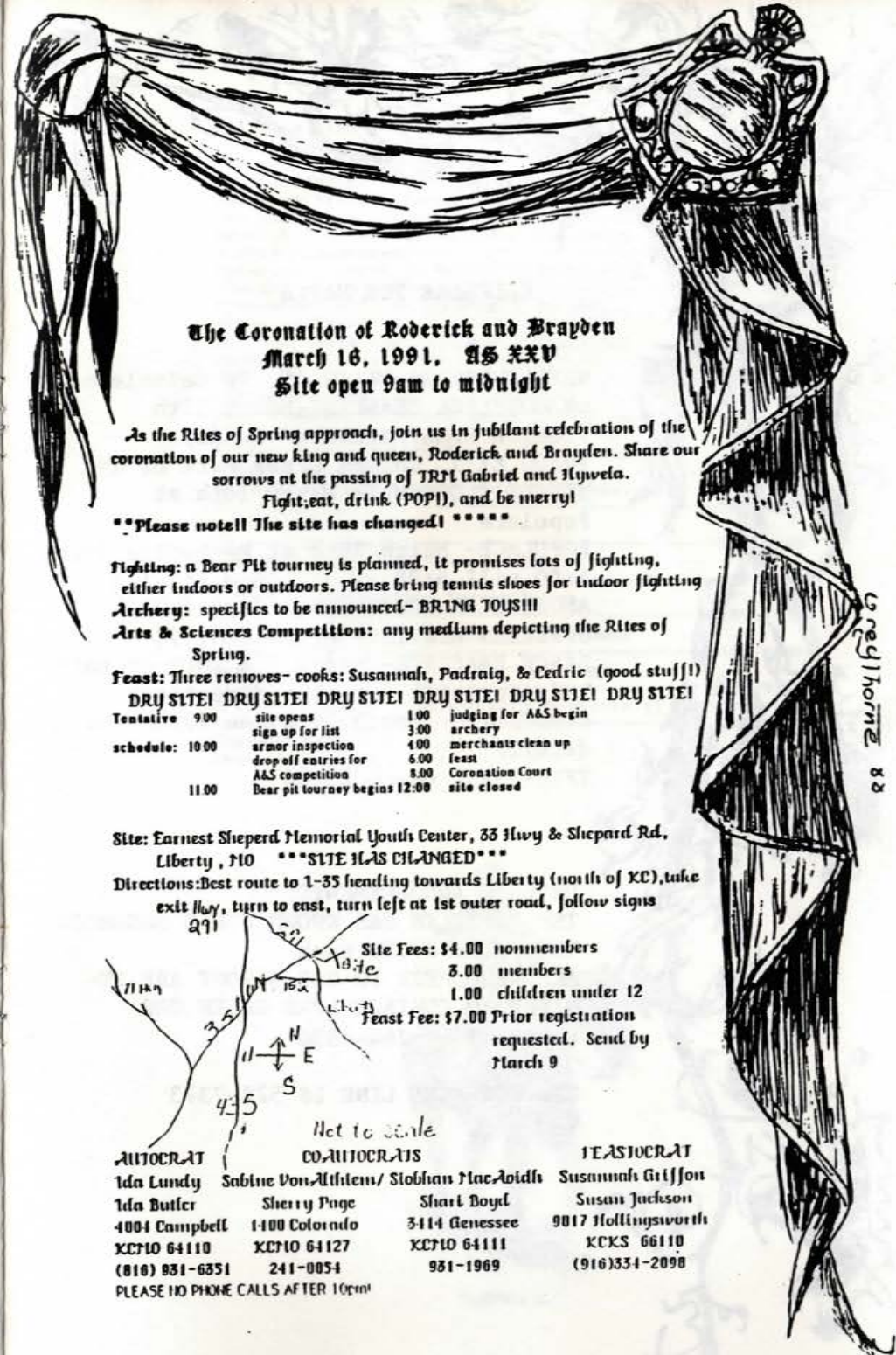
