

Mid-Period Garb Workshop

This workshop is being held for the purpose of experimenting to discover how to cut and make mid-period garb. We are considering the bliaut, cotehardie, houppelande, sideless surcoat and kirtle. You will need to bring the following items.

An old sheet, or two or three, or <u>cheap</u> muslin for cutting and fitting mock-up pattern for your garb. A tape measure. Scissors. Straight pins. A fabric marking pen or chalk, color to contrast with your fabric.

Any of the following items which you can bring will be very helpful.

A portable sewing machine. A table to put the sewing machine on. Electrical extension cord.

Limited camping available - Must contact Ld. Andries ahead of time.





# THIRD ANNUAL V'TAVIAN ARTS & SCIENCES AND MARTIAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Sunday, October 13th in the Sedgwick county park (next to the zoo), V'Tavia will renew its pledge to the arts and sciences by selecting a new champion. Lord Demetrius, the current champion encourages all to participate. On that same day the martial Champion for the Barony of V'Tavia will be selected.

# For the arts and Sciences Championship:

1. If you wish to become champion, you must submit 3 entries (no more, no less), at least 1 must be a science and at least 1 must be an art. See Lady Phillipa, Lady Searlaith, Lord Thorgrim, or Lord Demetrius for information about kingdom judging standards and what is a science and what is an art. NOTE: only static arts will be judged as we currently have a bardic champion for performing arts.

2. If you are interesting in entering the competition for best in arts or best in sciences, but not the championship, submit as many entries as you like.

3. If you are interested in feedback or want some suggestions, but don't want to compete, you may enter, request <u>no scores</u> and simply get judges' comments.

4. For those very skilled people whose work we all drool over, who also do not wish to enter competition, this will be an opportunity to show off your stuff so the rest of us may learn from you (no judging).

5. Entries will be accepted from 11:00 to 1:00 (real time). If you need or want something special (the need to serve your

food entry hot or to display the workings of your full-sized trebuchet), please contact Demetrius (777-0770 before 9:30pm) before October 7th. Judging will commence shortly after 1:00 (real time). Any gentle who feels s/he has sufficient skills to judge - using kingdom criteria - in any category is urged to contact Demetrius (if he hasn't already contacted you).

Please let Demetrius know any categories in which you plan to enter before October 7th. Advance warning will help in making sure that judges are available with skills in judging those categories.

# For the Martial Championship

Armor inspection will be from 12:00 to 1:00 (real time). You may only fight in those weapons systems in which you have been authorized. The Knight Marshal encourages all gentles who wish to fight to be on time as he plans to start the competition at 1:00 (real time).

Following judging and the end of martial activities. their Excellencies V'Tavia will hold court. During court, winners of competitions will be announced and the new champions installed. Following court, all the populace is invited to dinner on site (<u>bring your own</u>). The Barony will provide lemonade and grills will be available. The site is wet. Bardic and dance will be available following dinner. Site closes at 9:30, except for cleanup crew.

Site fee is \$1.00. If you agree to stay from 9:30 to 10:00 to help cleanup, there is no site fee and you have the thanks of the autocrat.
