

# Weaving Interest Group

The weaving interest group is starting back up again. We will be meeting the Monday following Populace Meeting, 7:00p.m., at Dawson Methodist Church, 2741 Laura.

This is for people interested in or curious about weaving and for poeple who are experienced weavers. I would like to be able to teach old and new techniques; share ideas, solutions, and problems; make items for the Baronial Treasure Chest and items to sell at Renfaire; do weaving at demos and events.....

Right now I can get people started on the following things:

Inkle weaving: straight and plain; tubular; pick-up technique Card weaving: straight and plain; double face technique Tapestry weaving: introductory

You don't need a loom to come see if you are interested. For inkle weaving, you will need an inkle loom. Currently, all our loaners are out. We can tell you where to get one, help you get one, how to make

one. Card weaving doesn't need a loom, but it's much more convenient (We usually use inkle looms for this, too.) Tapestry weaving also requires a loom, but it is simpler to make than an inkle loom.




