Z-men Straws Pillage Local Pubs

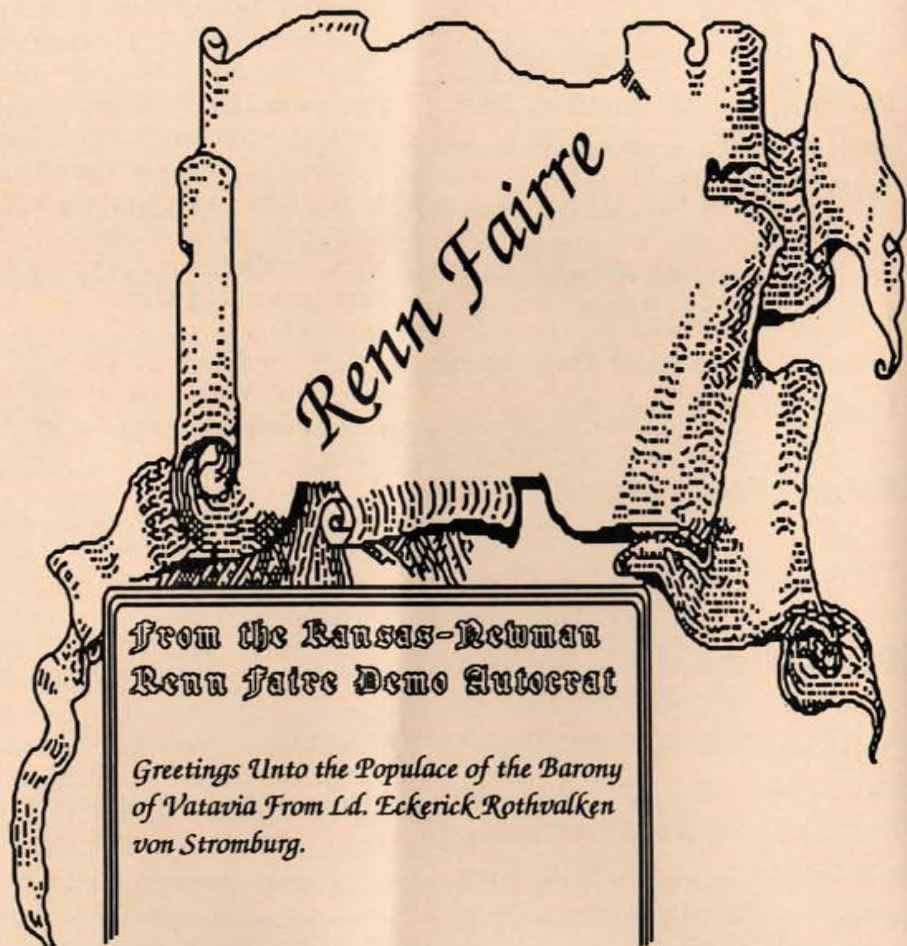

The SCA's expertise in Medieval and Renaissance Arts, Crafts and Customs is an invaluable part of making this Renn Fairre a success. The benefits of this demo are rent free use of Kansas Newmans grounds for practice and small events for the remainder of the year, recruitment of new member to share our Dream, and the raising of the largest share of our yearly baronial operating funds.

As with all such large endeavors, the success of this demo depends on the

The Barony needs dedicated volunteers to man the Archery Booth, Participate in Combat Fighting, Bash A Knight, Dancing, Constibuling, Demonstrating Arts and Sciences in the Medieval living history area which will be enacting a period encampment at a Tourney, or smithing armor or linking chainmail in the armory tent. Waterbearers, hearlds and bards are needed. Those than demonstrate arts and sciences are encouraged to do so

Many items need to be constructed and prepared before the Renn Faire. Besides Personal Renaissance Era Garb, Several Signs and Banners need to be sewn or built. Gear needs to be checked to determine if repairs are necessary, or if items need to be replaced.

As part of a Baronial emphasis on more personal heraldry to decorate our lands, the Barony is making several "Poles and Holes", to be awarded to those who

make their own hearldric banner. This consists of an 8 foot pole with a separate angle iron stake to use as a stand. Makes sure your name is on Eckerich's list if you intend to make a banner.

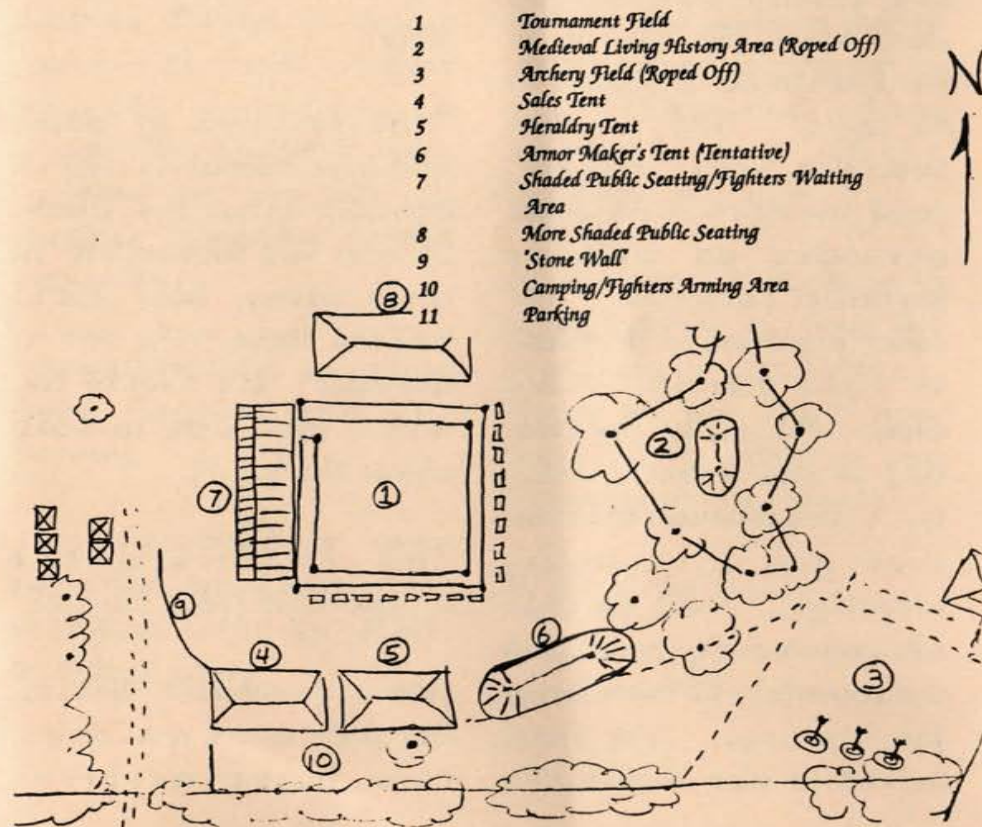

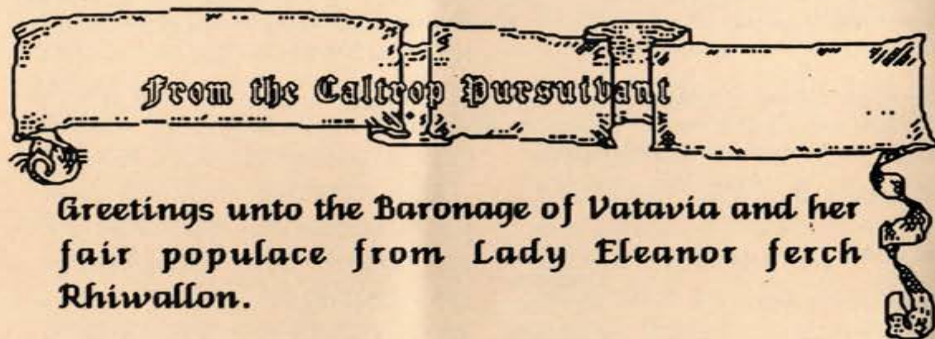

Arthur Bromere-Device. Per fess enarched sable and gules, a lion passant guardant Or maintaining a heart, in chief three arrows inverted argent.

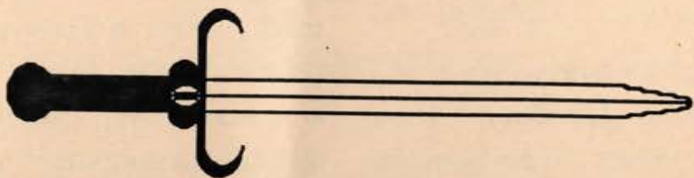
We invite this gentle to consult with us and resubmit as soon as possible.

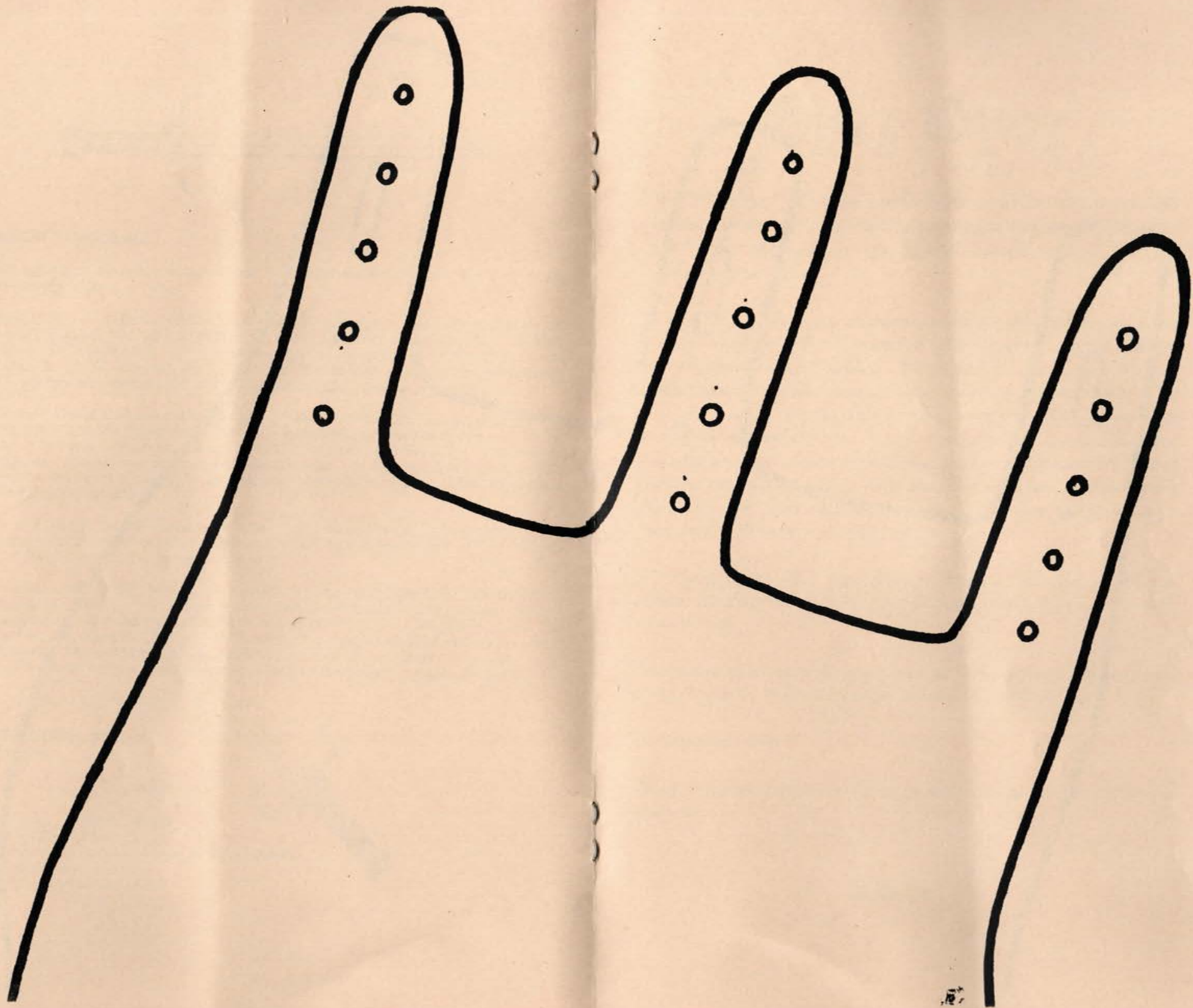

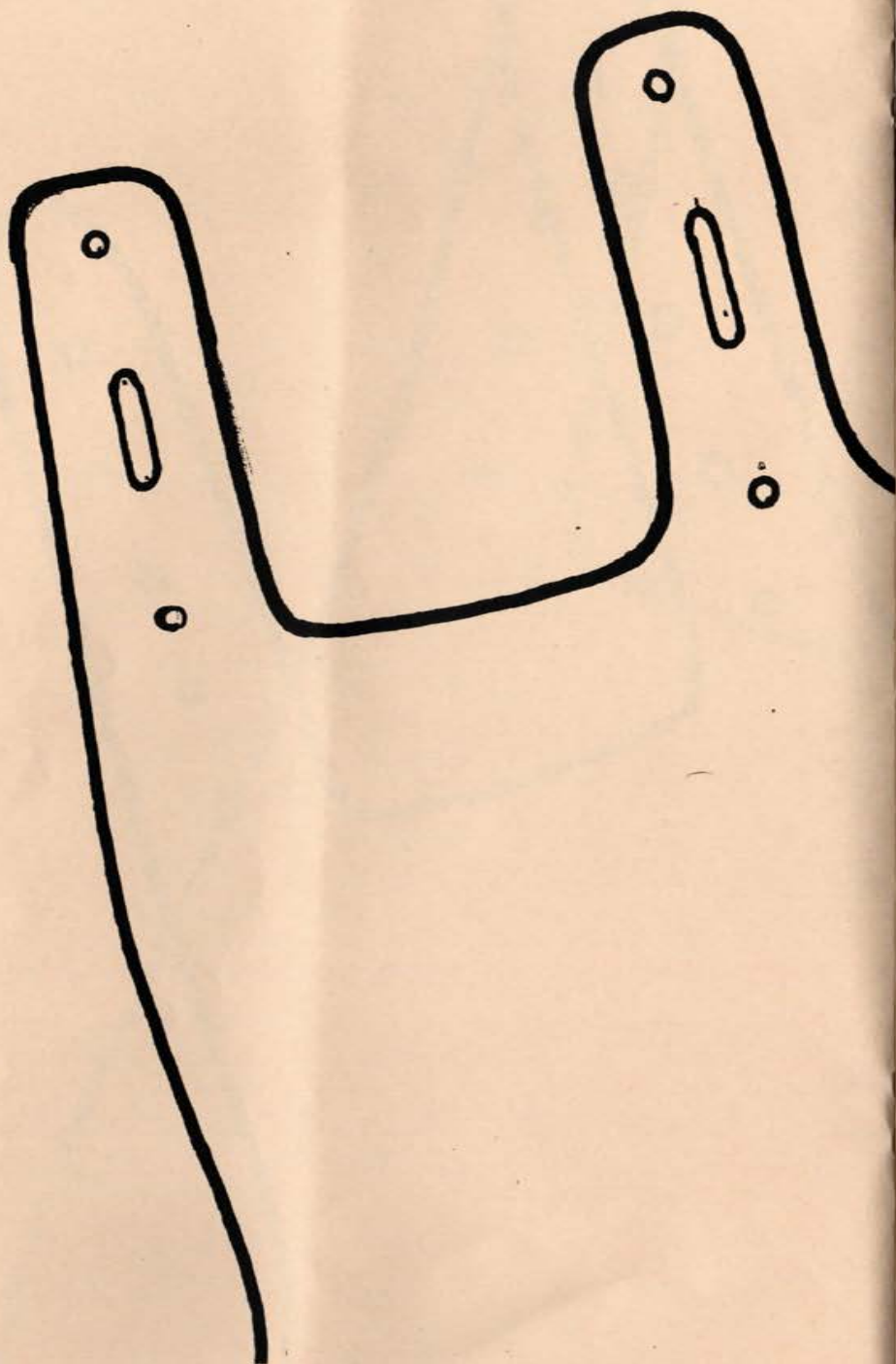

Performing arts and performance-related arts: dance (European and Eastern), choreography, music (vocal and instrumental), music composition, drama, mime, bardic recitation, performance magic, acrobatics (juggling and tumbling)
Representational arts: calligraphy, illumination, drawing, painting, sculpture
Textile and needle arts: costume, accessories, costume design, embroidery, needlework, knitting/knitting/crochet, lace making, pavilion and tent making
Letters: poetry, prose, play writing

SCIENCES:

Sports/combat: armoring, weapon making, bow making and fletching, horse mastery, falconry, gaming
Fiber crafts: spinning, weaving, dyeing
Kitchen crafts: cooking, brewing, herbal craft
Mechanical/technical construction: scientific instruments, musical instruments, siege engines
Crafts (including both practical and decorative aspects): metalwork (including jewelry), leather work, glasswork, woodwork, ivory and horn work, stonework, bookbinding, candle making, cartography

Instructions for Bracer by
Arthur Bromere

The bracer is worn to protect the forearm against string abrasion from the bow.

The armguard is made of 6 to 9 oz. tooling leather, which can be purchased from Tandy Leather. The tools needed are as follows:

(1) a variable hole leather punch. (2) a sharp craft knife able to cut leather, or a pair of leather scissors. (3) an edge beveler. (4) Three 1 inch buckles. (6) A small bottle of leather dye, and a bottle of Tandy Super Sheen leather finish. (7) Optional: enough lace to finish the edge and a lace punch.

Step 1

Take the pattern from the Dragonflyre and trace it to a sturdy piece of poster board, check the fit, if the pattern is too small then increase the height and width, **DO NOT INCREASE THE SIZE OF THE STRAPS.** If the pattern is too large then decrease the height and width. A gap of 1" is normal.

Step 2

Place your pattern onto the back or rough side of the leather, making sure it is for the proper arm. Left arm for right handed, Right arm for left handed archers.

Step 3

After the pattern has been traced to the leather then carefully cut the pattern out. Take the leather punch and punch the holes for the buckles and rivets. On the buckle holes punch two holes at each end and with an exacto knife remove the leather between them. Take the edge beveler and bevel the edge all the way around. Attach the buckles and rivets. If you wish you may then lace the edges and place your designs on the armguard.

Your bracer is now completed.



The Tombstone

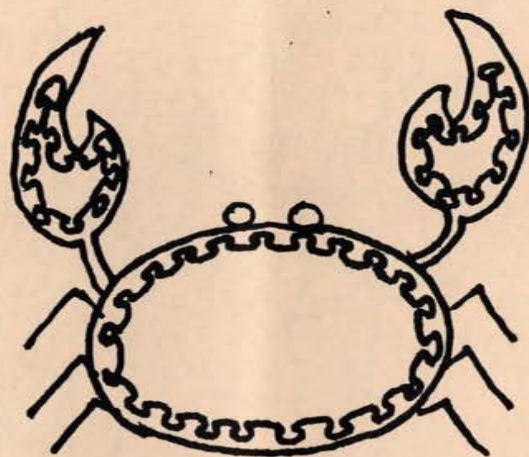
Bright-maid had done her dancing:

CHAMPIONS

For the A&S competition, all entries will be judged according to the Calontir Kingdom Judging Criteria.

Those competing for A&S Champion must enter at least 2 items in at least 3 A&S categories. These item(s) must be entered in both arts and sciences categories. That is to say, the item(s) may not be all science entries or all arts entries.

Single entries are allowed for either judging or comment.

Special prizes will be awarded for cooking and Byzantine research.

Erik will award a special prize for single entries.

Bardic Competition will begin with sign up at the Champions Registry until 2:30 p.m.. Competition will begin at 3:00 p.m. for the 1st and 2nd round. Judging will be by the Baronage and one past Bardic Champion as well as the Current Champion.

Round Three will be held at Feast. Judging will be as afore mentioned, additionally populace (aka popular) acclaim will be considered.

Entries for competition will be vocal renditions of Song or Poetry or Story

(Saga, etc). Instruments may be used for back up and /or enhancement of the vocal rendition. Period instruments are encouraged but not required.

Entries must fall into three categories, Period Work, Newly Composed Period Work, SCA oriented in Period Form, and SCA Filk,

Of the three competition pieces two of the three categories must be used and 2 of the forms must be included.

The last requirement is that one story, poem or song must use Valor 13 as the subject matter.

Bards of Vatavia,

This Championship competition ends my reign as Champion for I shall not compete. I sincerely hope that many of you will undertake this opportunity to compete for the title. Come and partake as it is a fine thing to support our bardic endeavors and enrich our Baronies arts.

The SCA requires minor participants (i.e., those having to have waivers) whose parents or legal guardians are not present at the event to have a valid Medical Authorization form. The SCA recommends use of the Medical Authorization for all minors whose parents or legal guardians are not present.

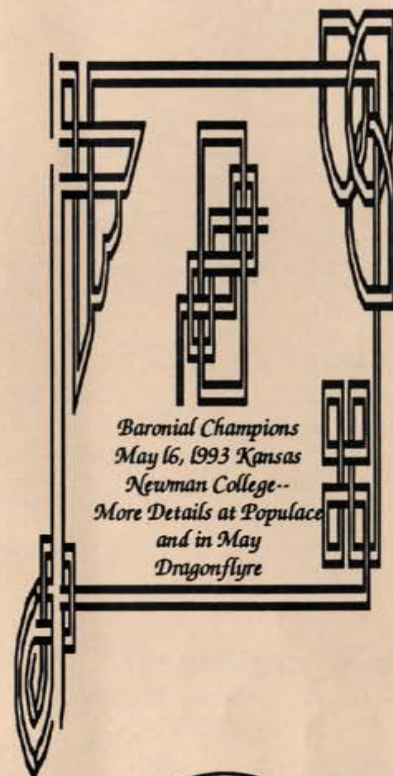
