

Please send your LOI to both the Crown, crown@calontir.org and the Kingdom Seneschal, seneschal@calontir.org.







FINANCE MEETING, JUNE 2024

An unscheduled meeting of the finance committee was held June 26, 2024 after the monthly populace meeting to consider an event bid. Committee members present were Joshua Thompson/Ld Brinky Fálkason, Robert Botkin/HE Robert Steven Mac Laren, Heidi Botkin/HE Heidi Anne Draper, Alicia Nielsen/Ly Alicia Niel, and Mary J. Day/HE Marie Chantal Delaire. Populace in attendance were Caitlin Lee/HL Aia Gold Bearer and Bridgett Russell/Noble Valeriano di Rossi.

Caitlin Lee/HL Aia Gold Bearer and Bridgett Russell/ Noble Valeriano di Rossi presented a proposal for a local event to be held in Kechi, Kansas October 26th, 2024 at the Kechi Community Center. This would be a costume event with the theme, Mythos, come as your favorite god or monster. Details on competitions, pot luck assignments, and expenses for this proposed event were given. Robert Botkin/ HE Robert Steven Mac Laren moved to accept the bid; Joshua Thompson/ Ld Brinky Fálkason seconded the motion. It was approved and payment for site rental was done.

There being no other business Exchequer Alicia Nielsen/ Ly Alicia Niel closed the meeting.

OFFICERS' MEETING, JULY 2024

OFFICERS' MEETING July 3, 2024 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon , Wichita, KS 67226

9 individuals attended: 7 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ event stewards; 2 members of Make ICT.

Key holders must be present at all times that there are members in the building at our meeting times. There are four Vatavia member key holders: Arts and Sciences Minister, Fighter Marshal and 2 members of the populace who will be issued keys. Members are not to roam around the building without a key holder. The door to the outside is requested to be kept as closed as possible, just closed till the open bolt is against the door frame.

Members are encouraged to travel to events this summer. Car pooling gives more Vatavians a chance to attend events, reduces travel costs, and provides an opportunity to be with fellow populace. Coronation is in Mag Mor July 13th. The flier for Crown in Vatavia in November has been received by Kingdom. Once pre-registration is set up it will be posted on the Kingdom calendar. Weather permitting fighting will be done outside. It was stressed that absolutely no stakes can be used on outside shade items. A suggestions was made to see if the Barony could sponsor the next Calon Con.

There will be a local event on October 26th at the Kechi Community Center. The event is 'Mythos, Gods or Monsters'. Costumes are encouraged from your myth pantheon or one that you think looks cool. There will be a costume contest. Myth themed food are encouraged, for example, olives as Odin's eye. There are no confirmed demonstration/ presentations at this time.

The notification of the May heraldic registrations is expected any day. It was requested that Roll number #12 be made to display the recent registrations. The Chronicler requested articles, artwork, persona stories, etc. It was noted on photos of individuals a separate model release is needed; public settings need a photographers release. The next deadline for Dragonflyre submissions is September 10th. The Chatelaine reported that the Calon Con meeting stressed having loaner garb in good condition and that someone would want to wear.

The new Web Minister Brinky is making changes to the web site. The minutes for Officers' and finance meetings have been removed since these are already available quarterly in the Dragonflyre. He will be updating the calendar regularly and requested information on activities or changes be to him the beginning of the month. He will also be getting our meetings posted to the Make ICT calendar. He would like to have head shots of each officer to post.

The Property Master reported that the name of the storage shed needs to be changed. For the Exchequer he reported that they had still not made the changes to the Baronial bank account due to difficulties with the bank itself. Also any payments to our previous meeting location need to be completed.

There were no reports from the Knight Marshal or officers for Arts and Sciences, and Social Media.

The Baronage thanked the officer corps for working so well together. Warranted officers were reminded that reports are due the 10th

The new Seneschal. Ld. Brinky, had started the meeting by stating his goal to have short meetings with only those officers reporting that actually had something to report. He asked that all questions be kept until the end. He asked the officers about meeting times. IT will stay the first Wednesdays of each month at 7 pm. A short break was taken for him to talk with the Make ICT Director of operations about calendar access and getting all necessary procedures completed for Ld. Brinky to attend the Saturday Orientation to finish getting his key card. When the meeting resumed the open offices were announced: Cut and Thrust, Archer Marshal, Minister of Youth, and Caltrop which already has announced a July 5th deadline for letters of application.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

FINANCE MEETING, JULY 2024

An unscheduled meeting of the finance committee was held July 17, 2024 at the weekly meeting. After court there was an open discussion with the populace about proposed events for Queen's Prize, Winter War Maneuvers and a demo in December. The finance meeting was opened after this discussion. Committee members present were Ld Brinki Fálkason, HE Robert Steven Mac Laren, HE Heidi Anne Draper, Ly Alicia Niel, and HE Marie Chantal Delaire. prior Exchequer Úlfr Halfdan and all the Populace at the weekly meeting.

The finance meeting opened. A bid is being done to host Queen's Prize here in March 2025. When finalized it will be presented to the finance committee. HL ØyrikR announced that the War Council had requested Vatavia host the 2025 Winter War Maneuvers here on February 22, 2025. Details of his bid were presented and discussed in the open meeting. Farha site rental has increased significantly, \$2260.00 for use 8am-5pm. Additional expenses would make the entire event cost \$2338.00. With an anticipated attendance of 200, maintaining the same event site fee as 2023, \$25 non member, \$15 members, a net profit of \$662.00 is expected. Ld Brinkey moved to accept the bid to host Winter War Maneuvers here; HE Heidi seconded the motion. The motion was passed.

There being no other finance business the meeting adjourned.

OFFICERS' MEETING, AUGUST 2024

OFFICERS' MEETING August 7, 2024 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon , Wichita, KS 67226

14 members attended: 8 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ event stewards; 6 members of the populace

Three Kingdom events in August are on the calendar, two in lowa, St. Augustine's Fair the 16th and Raid or Trade on Labor Day weekend. Cattle Raids in Nebraska August 24th will have several Vatavians attending. King's Companie of Archers is September 14th at the Lilies site. Ld Ragnvaldr is the Vatavian team Captain. HL Aia will be elevated to the Order of the Laurel September 21st at Kingdom Arts and Sciences in Missouri. October has several events. Autumn Arrows is October 5th. The 19th is 1381 Chronicles in Three Rivers and Beary Scary in Westumbria. Some interested members have suggested to move the Lilies event to the Fall. A mini Lilies style event, called Chilies, is planned from Thursday October 10th – Monday October 14th.

Crown will be in Vatavia November 9th. The required paperwork is being finalized. There will be a silent auction held at Crown. The site has been reserved for Winter War Maneuvers here February 22, 2025. A bid to hold Queen's Prize in Vatavia in 2025 will be sent in.

The end of September is the Fall Great Plains Renaissance Festival on the 28th -29th. Field heralds are needed for the fighting presentations. Interested members will be trained if needed. Plans will be discussed next month. October 26th is the local event 'Mythos, Gods or Monsters'. The flier will be out soon.

The presentation at the Museum of World Treasures the 3rd had the group talking to about a third of the guests. A couple of those came to the fighter practice the next day. Monday afternoon August 19th there is a presentation at the Active Senior Apartments in northwest Wichita. An invitation will be considered to participate in the Wichita Library DIY event November 2nd. Details are being arranged to be at Tsunami Con December 6th -8th.

The Web Minister will be transferring articles and other items from the old site. The Baronial OP was discussed. The Kingdom is planning to make it possible for Baronial OP's to be maintained on the Kingdom site. It was noted that His Majesty Robert commented he had seen the new site and liked it. The new Caltrop reported on the status of three Vatavian proposals. The deadline for items to be to the Chronicler is September 10th.

The Exchequer is working on the finalizing the move to the new bank. Payments are on hold for the transfer to be completed so payments will be done in a timely fashion. The Property Master will be scheduling a work day to prepare for the Renaissance Festival. His Excellency stated he would be repairing the shade fly and painting the poles.

There was no report from the Knight Marshal. Archery is on hiatus pending the site being arranged.

His Excellency thanked members for the positive environment in the Barony. He repeated the events on the calendar. Those officers responsible for activities, especially weekly ones, need to inform the Web Minister of any changes. Officers that have access on the site should make the changes themselves in a timely fashion themselves. Largess is needed for Crown in November and for the next Valor.

At the start of the meeting the Seneschal restated the goal of keeping meeting short. He reiterated about making meeting cancellations on the calendar. There are four officers that have Make ICT memberships. They are responsible for meetings and finding a replacement if they are unable to make a meeting or cancel the meeting. He had also gone over the event calendar at the start of the meeting.

The positions for the Minister of Youth and the Cut and Thrust Marshal are still open.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

OFFICERS' MEETING September 4, 2024 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon , Wichita, KS 67226

13 members attended: 11 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ event stewards; 2 members of the populace

The Fall calendar of events is very full. September 13th-15th is King's Companie of Archers. Vatavia has a team going. September 21st is Kingdom Arts and Sciences in St. Jo where Vatavian HL Aia will be elevated to the Order of the Laurel. October 10th-13th is the Lilies style event, Chillies. Then October is 1831 Chronicles at Barony of Three Rivers and Beary Scary in Westumbria. November 9th is Crown here in Vatavia followed a week later with the traditional Toys for Tots in Wyvern Cliffe (Jefferson City MO) Theobald's annual Midwinter Knights Dream is scheduled for December 7th.

The Vatavian bid for Winter War Maneuvers February 22, 2025 has been accepted. A bid for Queen's Prize 2025 has been sent in.

Locally, Champions will be held during the Great Plains Renaissance Festival presentation September 28th-29th, with set up on the evening of the 27th. October 26th is the Vatavian Mythos event. It was decided to accept the invitation to participate in the Wichita Public Library's DIY day event on November 2 nd from 10a-5pm.

The mock judging arts and sciences 'class' will be next Wednesday September 11th. Suggestions or offers to teach are needed for the last quarter of the year. As many Vatavians as can are encouraged to attend Kingdom Arts and Sciences. Officer letters and submissions of photos and artwork for the Dragonflyre are due by September 10th. Caltrop reported that three Vatavian proposals have been sent on to Laurel for registration. There were no voice heraldry activities this month. Individuals interested in doing field heraldry, or who would like to learn, are needed for the Renaissance Festival.

The Web Minister continues to work on the site. Several officers have access to keep the calendar updated. The Seneschal stressed that activities at Make ICT need to be canceled if the Make ICT badge holders can not be present.

The Exchequer reported a balance of \$23,053.39. Checks on the old account have cleared. Once the transfer to the new bank is finalized this week, the last payment will be made to University Congregational Church. The tithe has been sent in. Formal presentation will be at Crown. U-Haul rental for the Renaissance Festival and purchase of instant canopies will be presented at the finance committee meeting.

Fighter practice is canceled for September 21st to allow members at attend the Kingdom arts and Sciences event. There will be no practice the last weekend September 29th due to the Great Plains Renaissance Festival. The position of Cut and Thrust Marshal is still vacant.

The Crown stewards have updated on the website. They announced the different deputies and their responsibility during the event. Sign

up sheets for volunteers are available today.

Vatavia's Champions' competitions will be held during the Renaissance Festival. Archery will be done on Saturday after closing at 6 pm. The range will be limited. Officers will be responsible for organizing area activities covered by their office. There will be security. However people leaving items do so at their own risk.

The Baronage asked for award recommendations for both Kingdom and Baronial. Their Majesties really like to present awards to local members at their group's events. HE Robert went over events on the calendar. Westumbria is arranging for Vatavians to help with their Beary Scary event October 19th. Several Vatavians that usual help have obligations to be at another event the same day. HE Robert also issued a personal challenge on the costume competition planned for the local Mythos event October 26th.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

FINANCE MEETING, SEPT 2024

A meeting of the financial committee was held September 4, 2024 at the Make ICT 5920 E. Mt. Vernon Wichita Kansas. Committee members present HE Robert the Scott, HL Brinky, LY Alicia, Ld. Úlfr Halfdane, M. Marie; event stewards HL Óttarr S. and HL Corrigan; populace member Ld Lugaid mac Erca.

Exchequer Ly. Alicia opened the meeting. Informational was presented on heavy duty instant canopies from Euro Max. These are the same as used by the Great Plains Renaissance Festival for the last several years. A 10 X 20 with weights is \$1185.90. There would be tax on the purchase but no shipping charge. During discussion it was noted these canopies would be useful at the Kingdom and local events both indoors and outdoors where the use of stakes is prohibited. It was moved by HE Robert to budget \$2500 for the purchase of two canopies. Seneschal Brinky seconded the motion. It was passed.

Rental of a U-Haul to transport Baronial property needed for the Fall Renaissance Festival was discussed. Otherwise members with trucks and SUV would needed to be organized to make the trips necessary both the Friday and Sunday of the Festival. HL Brinky moved to allot \$250 for the rental, fuel, and insurance. HE Robert was the loudest seconding the motion. It was approved. Water bearing expenses was mentioned. It was noted that there is a budget for the two Ren fairs already in the yearly budget.

It was announced that fabric had been ordered and delivered for the next three panels of the roll of arms. This is already in the budget since the rolls are considered regalia. The purchase order for \$27.97 will be delivered to the Exchequer.

There being no other business Ly. Alicia declared the meeting closed.
