

This gives everyone some time for consideration. Gwayne desires that this be kept simple, so that your imagination can go wild. These are the basic requirements:

the word "valor" within the design
a sword incorporated within the design
a dragonfly incorporated within the design
2 stones of blue or gold or both

### Garlick Pickled Eggs

20 eggs, hard boiled and peeled 8 cloves of garlic slivered 1tsp mustard seed 1tsp cardamon seed 2 tsp salt 1 TB dried tarragon or 4 sprigs fresh 1-1/2 quarts of cider vinegar 2 bay (laurel) leaves 2 tsp black peppercorns

Pack eggs, as tightly as possible in two I quart jars (wide mouth work best), with 2 sprigs tarragon (or 1/2 Tb dried) and 4 cloves garlic.

Combine all remaining ingredients in a pot (glass or enamel is recommended) and bring to a boil. Simmer gently 15 minutes. Strain the whole spices out and pour the hot vinegar into the jars. Leave approximately 1/2 inch of head space. Place lids on jars, seal and process in a boiling water bath for 10 minutes. Remove and cool.

Transportation requires only that the jars be kept out of direct sunlight and extreme heat.
