

OFFICERS' MEETING April 1, 1996

17 members attended: 14 officers / deputies / champions, 3 members of the populace

Agendas from different officers were distributed. Prior to the reports the Seneschal asked each officer to briefly state their duties and responsibilities and who of the populace they represented.

The composition of the Finance Committee and the results of the first meeting were presented. The recommended budget was explained. Related paperwork on the interest groups was passed around for comments from the officers. It was announced that the Kingdom Treasurer had recommended that the treasurer step down early to avoid having the majority of the local officers' warrants all ending at the same time.

The interpretation of the new waiver policy in regards to marshall activities was debated. Clarification from Kingdom level officers will be obtained on the matter.

All of the officers were reminded that copies of their quarterly reports are to be sent to the Seneschal and Baronage. Information on arts and sciences activities was requested for that quarterly report.

Upcoming activities were presented. Calligraphy will be having a meeting April 9th. The weekend of the 13th some dancers will perform in the Namron demo for their Med Faire. It was proposed that a Super Wednesday be organized for all group activities. This is still in the planning stages.

The Herald has two items from the group to be sent up to the Kingdom submissions herald. The Treasurer is waiting on some outstanding checks to finalize the report on the Mongols event. Handling of un-cashed checks was covered. The Chatelaine has started advertising in local publications to attract new members:

Fighter practice will move to Watson Park, beginning Sunday the 7th. The possibility of an evening practice during the week is being looked into. Those wishing to do the fighting demonstration at Ren Faire are to come to fighter practice. Demos and demo fighting will be covered.

Upcoming events were covered. BUSH, the Baronial University for Societal Humanities, will be held April 6th, at Minisa Park Building. 6 to 7 outside teachers are

Greetings are heartily extended unto Their Excellencies Vatavia and Their populace from Their Baronial Champions.

Bear Fest III is just around the corner and with that comes the Spring Baronial Championship. The champions are very grateful to Their Excellencies and the good citizens of Westumbria for permitting us the opportunity to have the championship at Bear Fest. We are looking for a large turnout in each of the areas. Below is the different criteria for each championship. Please note that while anyone from anywhere can win the different competitions, onlythe highest ranking Vatavian can be champion. Feel free to contact the appropriate champion with any questions you may have. Michael von Bergen has graciously agreed to coordinate the Archer Championship, so please contacthim for questions pertaining to that area.

Borec/Fighter - Bring all your toys, it's gonna be grand! The roll of the dice determines which system you will fight for each bout. The number of systems you are authorized in will determine the odds of rolling a particular system. Number of participants will dictate whether this will be a single or double elimination tourney. Final bout will be two out of three.

A&S - Two arts and one science OR two sciences and one art required. Additionally, anyone wishing to be baronial champion must have attended at least half of all populaces and official baronial events for the last year. Kingdom Criteria will be used.

Luchistnik/Archer - The totals for all the scheduled shoots will be compiled to determine the Archer Champion.

Zevack/Bardic - One piece prose, one piece poetry/song, and one piece performer's choice for the total of three pieces. Kingdom Criteria.

The Champions wish at this time to thank Their Excellencies and the populace for the opportunity to have served as Your champions. We hope that through our humble attempts in each of our areas, the members of the barony benefitted in small way.

From the Renfair autocrat

Vatavia asks that all it's citizens give 4 hours a day to help the barony. If you haven't signed up - do it. If you sign up - show up on time. If you come in through troll, be prepared to tell the troll where you are working, and when. We want everyone to have a wonderful time, and if we all share the work, everyone can. There is no "protected" parking this year - the early bird parks the closest! The best place to park (for us) is directly behind the old Gym (red brick building on the north side of McCormick), but anywhere they have parking is fine. We need to be on site, ready to go at 9:00. There will be a general meeting both mornings on the list field.

The people in charge of the various areas are (drum roll please): Lelia - troll and sales, Gabe - photography, Ala - information, Fergus - fighting, Aislin - Bash a knight, Doc - carosel, Annys/Marie - heraldry, Ida - waterbearing, Eliane - dance, Me - living history and everything else. Give them all a big hand (I mean that in the most literal sense).

Our Barony does this demo to earn money and recruit new people. We hope you have a great time, but remember, we are here to work for our Barony. Since this is a time-specfic demo, only a certain type of garb will work. Please have your garb approved by Phillipa and remember, wear only the garb approved by her. We have gotten great feedback from the KN co-ordinators because we stick to this. They have begun to believe that we do have an idea about the times we are trying to recreate.

You might ask yourself why we care what they think, and that's a good question. In the past, when we where a younger group, (and building everything from scratch) we wore what we had. Lots of polyester. Tennis shoes. Jeans to fight in. We knew we were slowly building our SCA gear, and we would do better in time. BUT, KN only knew that we where calling ourselves a non-profit, educational organization, and they didn't think much of our idea of "education". In many ways, this is a small community, and perceptions are shared. Just ask some of the people at WSU. We had never done anything on the WSU campus, but the impression many of the staff had was very negative. Word travels. Anyone who has tried to get a new site for an event can tell you how important it is for that "word" to be a good one.

The ambiance at Renfair is unique. It's the closest thing to a medeval village we are likely to experience in 20th century Kansas. Enjoy it, have a great time, just remember that we, the Barony of Vatavia, are there to help make the magic for 30,000 moderns.

And now the EXCITING conclusion to "Estrella - according to Pay"

In the first bridge we were the third unit in. The object was to take 60% of the bridge. The two units in front of us were all light cav/skirmishers. Before the beginning of battle, at Valen's prodding, I declared this battle to be for our lovely Queen and my dear comrade Adilith. (She cried and made us cry when she heard.) At the gun, they ran full tilt into the running units from the other side. Both sides took horrendous loses at the half way mark on the bridge. After about 3-4 minutes of fighting we were the front rank. We pushed the foe back a step until the bodies got so thick that we could not advance. (No holds called for clearing the dead. We grounded the shields and started to kill the foe in great numbers with little losses. But, we could not advance over the bodies. Gilligan called for the shields to retire so that the dead could be drug out of the way and we could get at the foe. Of the original 8 scutums that wen in, 6 retired to the rear. We formed a reserve unit to the rear of the bridge. The dead still kept either side from advancing. Great carnage ensued but neither side could push the other so the battle ended as a draw. 50% of the Calon army survived the battle.

The next battle we were held in reserve. After about 12 minutes of a 30 minute battle the overall commander asked us to supply a break through. We went up the right flank in a column of 4. Our commander asked that the first 4 scutums be of the highest quality. He hand picked them. They were Count/Duke Valens, Duke Gabe, Count Cire and Old, Fat, Slow Pavel. (I was/am very proud to have made that cut.) As we advanced the right two scutums (Valens and I) were jammed up on the 4 ranks of spear fighters that were engaged. Cire and Gabe took two columns to the fore and were engaged. Cire and Gabe took the two columns to the fore and were causing some damage to the foe. But they needed a strong right anchor. I was beginning to dispair of getting among the foe when Valens recognized the leader of the spearmen blocking us. (Duke Veron I believe.) Valens got his attention and told him that if he would let us through we would get him to the foe. He took one look and moved his fighters with the call of "Move over boys the Pro's are here." As I advanced I noticed that our other two columns were heavily engaged with the middle of the foe's line. I chose the gap in the two shields nearest the right side of the bridge. Leaping two dead bodies (Pavel leaping, kinda boggles the mind a little doesn't it?) I landed, on my knees, blowing the outside shield off the bridge. Valens jumped right into my hip pocket with his scutum. So we have two scuti hard pressed into the right flank of the foe. A mixed column of Veron's spear and Calon troops is pressing hard on Valen's and my left flank. Valens and I are throwing hard wraps into the unprotected sides of the troops crushed in front of us. (The marshals commented on the ferocity of our attack.) The foe's line was weakening every second. Right as they started to really break a giant of a man decided that I was too dangerous to live. He stepped up to me, ignoring Kian and Hufta'a pole shots. Grabbed the top corner of my scutum and my left knee. Picked me up like I weighed nothing (270 lb of Pavel was mildly disconcerted by this) And threw me from the bridge and out of the fight. Our forces went on to carry the bridge. I swam to shore to prepare for the next battle.

We were once again to play last reserve. The Outlands were our Allies for this one. We did not fight, as the Outlands carried the bridge with no help from us. They fought well. We stood in a tight formation to give the catapult a good target. It fired at us, the last to the battle. With us not dodging and packed into a good target it got one kill, Kian (the biggest target.) Still the siege weapons added to the feel of the battles.

Next was the three way castle battle. We were with the Outlands. Our plan was to attack to our right and ignore the left. The Thiegns of the Outlands (sorta a Hyrd) were to attack all out and hold back their scrimishers. (I thought they would have been better used as leavening for the men at arms and Red Company of the Outlands army. The Outlands has plenty of Chiv to use as fire and forget weapons.) At the gun the army took

off at fast run. This quickly left me behind. My two dedicated arty (Hufta and Kian) stuck with me. When I got to the line it was a mess. Many of the scuti had died because of the confusion of our attack. I moved to the center of the foes line and dropped. Was able to get quite a few good clean kills on folks who extended past me. Hufta and Kian were wreaking great damage to the ranks in front of me. We soon had pushed them to their gate and were trying to push them out. I looked to my right and there was Adilith with her little roman center grip trying a unassisted charge. I lumbered to my feet and jumped to cover her left side, with Kian and Hufta still with me, as we advanced into the foe's right flank, we were making great head way. Then a man larger than Kian did a full bore charge and caught me with my legs among the dead. The strike bowled me over and gakked my knee pretty good. (ouch. OUCH!) As I was going down I was doing a damage assessment. I had decided that I was hurt about the time the large fighter landed on top of me. (As he knocked me down he un-masked the twin firepower of Hufta and Kian with 7.5; glaves.) I then decided that I was indeed hurt and started, politely but with great conviction, asking for a hold. (screamed my bloody head off.) Calon troops carried me to the side of the battle in the resulting hold. To keep my fighting pants from being cut I had them strip them off. The chirurgeon commented with suprise that I was wearing purple underwear. Bronwyn and Adilith assured them this was right and proper thing as I was a Calon soldier. (no lace, KSCA wear lacy frilly undies, we MSCA just wear colorful but plain undies. Catch me at an event in the right frame and I will tell you the whole story.) After a little discussion the chirurgeon agreed that I was going to the Calon camp and not Chirurgion Point. Her Gracious Majesty rode with me to camp. To distract me from the 'slight discomfort' of my knee we sang 'No Nobeas" all the way. I'm not sure how that battle ended to the resurrection battle. Some other will have to tell of those.

The last night was upon us. Everyone leaving left food and drink for us braving the last night. It was a great night of story telling, drinking and eating. Was very good to be Calon then as folks kept coming up and telling us what a great job we did.

Before I forget. Our logistics troops did a great job this year. The water and gatoraid were never far from a thirsty lip. The soup was hot and plentiful. There were fighter biscuits, dried apples, jerky and oranges for the taking. Our support troops did a great job. Thanks guys.

I will not bore the reader with story of the trip home. Suffice it to say that it took us 60 hours, over \$700.00 in repairs and two separate forced layovers. *sigh*
