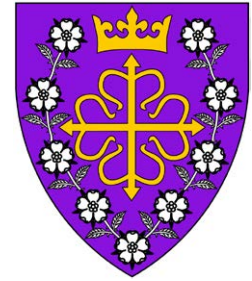
Calontir!

As the days are colder, and the weather is icy, we look forward to future events.

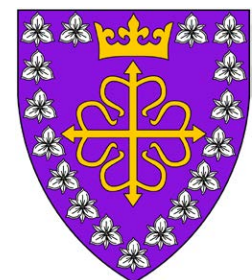
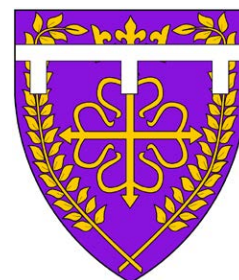

FROM THE CALTROP HERALD

Salve a tutti (Hello everyone)! I am honored to have served as your Caltrop Herald since July this year! But what is heraldry, and how is it important? To me, heraldry generally encompasses communication. Voice heraldry is vocal communication during courts, for camp sites outdoors, during tournaments, and more. Loud voices and proper vocal projection techniques are important, so that messages are heard across areas that are large, noisy, or with potentially bad acoustics.

Book heraldry is the research of names and devices. Names are how we refer to each other in this SCA game. Devices are like personal logos that we use for identification that we can display on ourselves and on our personal belongings. It is important for names and devices to have historical plausibility, as well as not accidentally match that of a real person or controversial thing. But most of all, the joy of self-expression is important when researching and registering names and devices!

I cannot give enough thanks to my experienced Caltrop staff Johann Steinarsson and Marie Chantal Delaire in helping me settle into my new Caltrop Pursivant role these last few months. However, we are always welcoming and in need of people eager in the heraldic arts. Upcoming, we will have a high need for voice heraldry for the Winter War Maneuvers event that Vatavia will be hosting on Saturday February 22, 2025. This event is to prepare the Kingdom of Calontir army for battle formation and strategy for Gulf Wars in coming March. Voice heraldry in noisy tournament settings will be much needed and appreciated here!

OFFICERS' MEETING, OCT. 2024

October 2, 2024 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon, Wichita, KS 67226

1 members participated: 9 Baronage/ officers/ deputies; 1 event stewards; 1 member of the populace

The new guests attending the meeting were introduced. Most had been in the SCA Dell last weekend.

Preliminary paperwork for Winter War Maneuvers here in February 2025 has been started. No decision has been made on the Vativian bid for Queen's Prize here next year. Vativia's Crown plans for this November 9th are being finalized with sign up sheets for set-up/tear down and feast serving available at this meeting. Crown pre-registration is ready. It was announced that there would be a court held at populace, October 16th. Members were reminded to dress up in garb for that meeting. The local Mythos event is October 26th, 3-7 pm at the Kechi City Hall. The presentation request from the Wichita Public Library to participate in the DIY Day November 2nd has been accepted. Hands on activity items are planned.

The Caltrop Herald thanked all those who helped with voice heraldry at the Fall Renaissance Festival. The staff reported on current proposals in process. The Dragonflyre will be sent to the Web Minister today for posting. The Web Minister announced that archiving of the Dragonflyres is done for 1986-1993. A local spreadsheet of all the local awards is being produced. It will be maintained in addition to having the information available on the Kingdom Order of Precedence.

Paperwork for the account at the new bank has been completed and the funds transferred. There was \$23,063.39. A gratuity of \$700 was received from Eagles Realm for our operation of their pop booth at the last Festival. The Exchequer thanked all the members who worked the concession. The Property Master will be scheduling in the near future a Saturday to clean out the storage shed, inventory, and assemble the wheeled racks.

The Knight Marshal reported that there were more fighters participating this year at the Festival. Two new fighters were authorized and new fighters present at this evenings meeting. Fighters should check the local calendar for cancellations of practice due to the unavailability of a warranted marshal. It was noted that does not

mean other non-martial activities are also canceled. Whether there is a practice after the local Mythos event has not been decided at this time. The Cut and Thrust Marshal position is still open.

There is no archery practice scheduled at this time. A presentation to the Make ICT Board to have missile weapon activities and practice will be made in the near future.

Their Excellencies thanked the populace for their work during the Fall Great Plains Renaissance Festival. They requested feedback on the holding of the local Champions' competitions at the same time. Personally, They found it to make things even more busy and more tiring.

The Seneschal reminded officers that quarterly reports for most are due the 15th of this month. This includes any warranted marshals. It was noted some offices, such as Exchequer, have different deadlines and should check when their reports are due in.

The Web Minister is looking for a deputy/emergency Web Minister. It was stressed that maintaining the web site is actually easy.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

FINANCE MEETING, OCT. 2024

An unscheduled meeting of the financial committee was held October 16, 2024 at the Make ICT 5920 E. Mt. Vernon Wichita Kansas. Committee members present HE Robert the Scott, HL Brinky, Ly Alicia, Ld Lugaid, Ld.Úlfr Halfdane, M. Marie; populace member Master Jóhann Steinarsson and HL Corrigan.

The meeting was requested by HE Robert the Scott. He had received a request from Westumbria for the use of Baronial property at their event October 19th: list field stands and rope, missile weapon stump, archery stands, an adult and a youth bow and arrows. HE Robert moved to approve this request; HL Brinky seconded the motion. It was approved.

There being no other business Ly. Alicia declared the meeting closed.

OFFICERS' MEETING, NOV. 2024

November 6, 2024 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon, Wichita, KS 67226

13 members attended: 9 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ 1 event steward; 3 members of the populace

Crown tournament is this weekend November 9th in Vatavia. Contingency plans are in place for actives to be inside. Help is requested if that is required. November 16th is Toys for Tots in Wyvern Cliffe. November 30th-December 1st is the online Knowne World Newcomers' Symposium. December 7th Theobald College will have its Midwinter Knights Dream which several Vataivians will help put on. December 14th Kris Kinder Ly Alicia will become apprentice to Mistress Vashti.

The November 2 nd presentation at the Wichita Public Library had a good turnout despite the weather. The proposed presentation at Tsunami Con the first weekend in December will not be done this year. The steward for the event will be out of town. Their Excellencies have set aside January 11th for a local New Year's party. The site will be decided later. The Chatelaine has had several contacts from interested individuals. The Caltrop Herald has been participating in Kingdom heraldic meetings online. Master Jóhann will be assisting with tournament heraldry at Crown. Notification of Vataivian proposals in process will be received the beginning of next year. The deadline for submissions to the Dragonflyre is December 10th.

The Web Minister will be checking on policy for archive back Dragonflyre issues which contain personal information which was required at that time. Work on the OP continues. November 23rd starting at 10 am the Property Master will be doing a clean up of the storage shed and inventory of Baronial property. Two or three people are needed to assist with this job.

The Exchequer reported a balance of \$20,091.97. The bank transfer has been completed. The funds transfer back to Theobald College has been done; the backlog of reimbursements; and seed money for Crown. The final payment to the University Congregational Church needs paperwork from the Church. The two shade flies have been obtained. Budget planning for 2025 will start soon.

Fighter practice moved inside with the inclement weather. Practice is also back to the winter start time, 10 am. The Make ICT calendar will be updated on that. The Knight Marshal noted that he has budget for this year remaining. The flier for Winter War Maneuvers here February 22, 2025 was reviewed before forwarding to Kingdom.

The Vataivian bid for Queen's Prize Tournament was not selected. It was also noted that Society policy now requires a \$5 (five dollar) discount to be done for pre-registrations.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

FINANCE MEETING, DEC. 2024

Wichita Kansas. Committee members present were HE Robert the Scott, HL Brinky, LY Alicia, M. Marie; for the populace, member Mistress Aia Gold Bearer. Seven other members of those present attended this meeting. After discussion of each line item of the budget HL Brinky moved to accept the proposed budget for 2025. Mistress Aia seconded the motion. The 2025 budget was approved.

It was noted that the last couple years saw increased revenues for the Barony. This is the result of four Kingdom events in 2023: Winter War Maneuvers, Spring Coronation, Masters of the Duel and Valor. This year's Kingdom events, Valor and Crown, saw unexpected profits because of reduced expenditures and unexpected attendance respectively.

OFFICERS' MEETING, DEC. 2024

December 4, 2024 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon, Wichita, KS 67226

20 members attended: 9 Baronage/ officers/ deputies; 11 members of the populace, most working on a project

This weekend, December 7th, Vatavians will be assisting Theobald in activities for their Midwinter Knights' Dream. The schedule of Kingdom events in Vatavia in 2025 were covered. Winter War Maneuvers February 22nd site has been paid for. The Mews ad, flier and website are done and pre-registration is being finalized. A site for Valor has not yet been finalized. Options at the El Dorado Lake and possibly returning to Whispering Winds are being considered. Once decided the event bid will be made.

The weekly Wednesday meetings at Make ICT are canceled for Christmas Day and New Year's Day. The January Officers' meeting is moved to January 8th. The Vatavia New Year's celebration will be at Make ICT January 12th. Snacks, games and fighting are planned. The time for the event needs to be finalized but is tentatively planned for 10am-4pm. Their Excellencies will be getting with Their Champions' to select a date and plan the Champions' event for 2025. Next Wednesday December 11th Master Jóhann

will do a class on the basics of court heraldry including the behind the scenes organization and planning for a court. It was also announced that he will be assuming the position of White Hawk for the reign of Orren and Lyra. Caltrop staff will be covering those voice heraldry needs of the Barony during that time. Master Jóhann is also the chief herald to organize heraldic activities at Lilies. Caltrop also reported on activities of the staff. It was announced that there would be no Crazy Uji heraldic submissions discount during Kris Kinder this year. Mistress Aia has been in contact with several interested new members. One is in attendance this evening. Brochures need to be printed. She also announced that she is the Royal Scribe for Orren and Lyra. She plans to have pre-prints available by Kris Kinder.

The Exchequer had not yet received the bank statement. There is approximately a little over \$21,000 in the account. It was noted that the last couple years saw increased revenues for the Barony. This is the result of four Kingdom events in 2023: Winter War Maneuvers, Spring Coronation, Masters of the Duel and Valor. This year's Kingdom events, Valor and Crown, resulted in unexpected profits. The Property Minister will be reorganizing the storage shed as property is used. The Web Minister reported that work continues on getting the Vatavia Order of Precedence completely updated. It is a goal for 2025 to have it on the site.

The Knight Marshal reported on the acquisition of pieces for the loaner armor. Gorgets are needed. Ld. Torin has been working on making additional pieces. Several new fighters have been coming to the Sunday practices. A presentation will be made to the Make ICT Board about holding archery practice at the Make ICT site. Archery practice is in limbo at this time.

His Excellency and two other Vatavians are planning to attend the War of the Phoenix February 11th-17th, right after Coronation and ending right before Winter War Maneuvers. Over Winter break he will be picking up the rope that is used for different scenarios done at Winter War Maneuvers. Dates for the Provincial event need to be obtained.

Award recommendations are requested for both Kingdom and Baronial awards. It was added that Vatavia works with Coney Marsh, Theobald and Westumbria to get award recognition for their members.

The Seneschal wants all officers to state their goals for their office for 2025 at the January meeting. He reminded officers that the deadline for letters to the Dragonflyre is December 10.

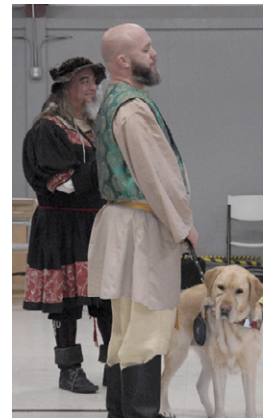
