


Greetings to the Populace.

OFFICERS' MEETING, JAN. 2025

OFFICERS' MEETING January 8, 2025 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon , Wichita, KS 67226

14 members participated: 11 Baronage/ officers/ deputies- (7 online); 3 members of the populace

Winter War Maneuvers will be held here on February 22nd. Preregistration paperwork will be completed this evening and turned in to Kingdom. The site is paid for. Plans for Privy Chambers are being made. The preliminary planning for Valor was presented. A completed bid and flier will be made. A bid is required for the Vatavian rotation to host Spring Crown in 2026. The bid deadline is April 11, 2024.

The Vatavian New Year's party is scheduled for this Sunday the 12th at Make ICT from 10a- 4pm. Members will be notified in advance if weather conditions necessitate canceling the event. There is a spreadsheet set up to list finger foods and snacks individuals plan to bring. Also bring your favorite games. There will also be a Winter themed arts and sciences competition; Those wishing to participate in the white elephant gift exchange should bring a PG item of \$10-\$20 or less.

Arts and Sciences Minister, Chatelaine, and Chronicler had nothing to report. The Chronicler did state the last quarter Dragonflyre is available on Facebook and the Baronial website. Work is being done to get new brochures printed. The Baronial Order of Precedence (OP) is up on the Baronial website and essentially up to date. The results of Vatavian items decided in December are expected in February. Training will be available for those interested in doing any type of voice heraldry. Master Jóhann will be assuming White Hawk Herald to their incoming Majesties in February. This will give others an opportunity to become a 'shout-y' person.

The Exchequer reported a balance of \$20,570.11. She plans to pay the entire storage unit rental for the year. This will eliminate monthly billing and reduce the number of checks needed. More checks are currently needed. She reported that the financial paperwork on Crown has been completed. It was clarified that a fourth quarter report is not required for her office. The financial Domesday is coming up. She is working with the Kingdom Exchequer to wrap up the report for last year's Domesday due to the bank change and situations that occurred in 2023. The Winter War Maneuvers pre-registration approval and enclosure kits for the new pop-ups will be considered at this evening's finance committee meeting.

The Property Master reported that storage shed has been reorganized and the rolling shelving assembled. Inventory of the Baronial property will be sent to the Exchequer.

Fighter practice continues despite problematic weather. The practice on February 19th is canceled to allow fighters to join other Calontiri attending the Vindheim War Practice in Tuttle OK. Confirmation has been received on the loaner armor order. The new Armored Combat handbook is posted on the Calontir website. All are encouraged to check it. It has been expanded and more detailed. Armored Combat Marshal are all now classified as warranted. However reports are not required from these marshals except in specific instances. An explanation is available on the Calontir Earl Marshal's website.

Local group marshals and Marshals-in-Charge still are required to make reports.

There were not Cut and Thrust or Archery Marshal reports.

Individuals needing transportation to events should contact Their Excellencies who will help in make arrangements and/or contacting potential ride shares.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

FINANCE MEETING, JAN. 8 2025

A brief meeting of the finance committee was held after the monthly Officers' Meeting at Make ICT January 8, 2024. Committee members present were HE Robert the Scott, HL Brinky, M Marie and online Ly Alicia and Ld Úlfr. Also participating HL Catlin Marie- Deputy Seneschal, HL Øyrikr- one of the event stewards, and Ld Óttarr L.

Since the flier for Winter War Maneuvers has been published the pre-registration paperwork can be submitted. It requires the approval of the finance committee. It was approved and sent in during the meeting.

HL Brinky moved to obtain two enclosures, at a cost of \$189.90 each, to use with the pop-ups to provide privy chambers for this event. HE Robert seconded the motion. The purchase was dis-

cussed. Total cost with tax is \$412.19. There would be no shipping charge. After discussion the purchase was approved. It was noted during discussion that the site fee was paid in 2024. The approved 2025 budget for the event of \$2400 includes paying the site fee for the next War Maneuvers in 2026.

There being no other finance business the meeting closed.

OFFICERS' MEETING, FEB. 2025

OFFICERS' MEETING February 5, 2025 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon , Wichita, KS 67226

16 members attended- 6 via online: 15 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ event stewards; 1 member of the populace

Final plans for Winter War Maneuvers here February 22 are almost complete. Baronial property will be loaded into the trailer Friday evening. Set up will start at 8 am Saturday morning. The site is dry with no outside food allowed. Schedule will be finalized at the event. As this will be the first event for Their Majesties since Their Coronation, Their Excellencies would like to present largess. All are encouraged to donate. Several members are currently working on items. Purchased items that are period in style are acceptable.

The Spring Great Plains Renaissance Festival will be the same weekend as Spring Crown. Those interested in doing announcing in the Dell are needed. The local Champions' event will be in October.

The Seneschal has reserved the Make ICT room for Wednesdays and Sundays for the entire year. Cancellations will be posted on the Baronial website. Work continues to update the local Order of Precedence on the site. The Chatelaine has had no new contacts since last month. A presentation request from the Museum of World Treasures during the Spring break was approved. The Caltrop Herald has been attending online meetings. The recent registrations were announced. It was also announced that heraldic consultations will be done at Winter War Maneuvers.

A class on making garb may be held prior to the Renaissance Festival for Barony and Make ICT members. The recent Dragonflyre has been posted. The deadline for the next publication is March 10th.

The Exchequer reported a balance of \$19,781.45. The final payment to the University Congregational Church has been made but not yet cleared the bank. The current report is done. She is waiting on the Kingdom Exchequer to finish on the 2023 report. Once the outstanding check to the storage facility clears the bank rental will be paid for the rest of the year. The property Master requested a list of all Baronial property needed for Winter War Maneuvers. The Knight Marshal announced that the armor order had been received. Some loaner equipment still needs to be assembled. There is a room conflict February 23rd, the day after Winter War Maneuvers. Unless the weather allows for outside practice, it may have to be canceled.

Valor planning continues. A Tavern Deputy is still needed. It was suggested to see if one of the nearby local groups would like to run tavern as a fund raiser for their local group. If no local member comes forward the Seneschal will contact the three close groups. The site will be the same as last year's event.

The required Vatavian bid for Crown April 2026 needs to be into Kingdom April 11, 2025. It was stressed that basically Kingdom runs the event. The hosting group supplies the site and support. Those interested should contact the Seneschal.

Her Excellency reported on the progress of local projects. She repeated the request for largess to present at Winter War Maneuvers.

Ld. Lugaid announced that the history club he was involved with at WSU was planning to get a Scottish professor to come talk to the club in early March. He asked to see how much interest there might be among the local group in this presentation.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

OFFICERS' MEETING, MAR. 2025

OFFICERS' MEETING March 5, 2025 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon , Wichita, KS 67226

22 members attended: 12 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ event stewards; 10 members of the populace

Winter War Maneuvers was a success despite last minute complications. The event was was discussed; and, and it was proposed for a bid will be presented to Kingdom to host the event next year. Suitable sites are being checked for Vatavia's required bid for Crown in the Spring of 2026. The bid deadline is April 11th.

There is a presentation at the Museum of World Treasures March 21th, 11 am. to 1 pm. for their Spring break camp. A request has been received from Coney Marsh to help participate in a Renaissance fair in Dodge City the first weekend in May. Contact information was provided to plan for this. The request to be involved in a Ren fair in Topeka was declined and will be left to individual members to attend if they wish. Vatavia's Champions' event will be held sometime in October.

The local Great Plains Renaissance Festival is April 12th - 13th. Some officers will need to have their deputies do the planning for

their area. Several will need to be at Crown instead which is the same weekend. Members are needed to operate the pop booth concession at the Festival.

The deadline for items to be sent for publication in the Dragonflyre is March 10th. Those attending Gulf Wars will have an extension deadline to when they have returned. It was stressed that due to compatibility issues Goggle docs need to be submitted by being cut and pasted into the sending email. The web site calendar is up to date. Outages on the web site have been fixed. OP data entry continues. The Chatelaine loaner garb, Gold Key, continues to be closed for accepting donations. The Caltrop Herald reported on heraldic activities at War Maneuvers. Voice heralds are needed to help at the Spring Ren. Festival.

The Exchequer reported a balance of \$22,206.65. The War Maneuvers funds have been deposited and also the Pay Pal funds received from Kingdom for Crown. Two checks will be done this evening. It was reported that War Maneuvers made \$285 even though there was less attendance then planned on.

The Property Master reported that Vatavia is currently storing 'the rope' used by Kingdom for war maneuver practice. It needs to be

moved to check on the location of the new shade fly roofs. The roofs are required when using the sides for the shade flies.

Fighter practice will be moving outside with the weather warming up. Arrangements are being made to hold archery practice at Alia's and Úlfr's. There are safety concerns for using Make ICT.

Valor in May still needs tavern planning. A couple individuals have been suggested to head this event need. It was noted that one volunteer is actually very busy. Theobald College, Westumbria and Spinning Winds will be asked if they would like to do Valor tavern to provide an opportunity for their group to make funds for themselves.

The Valor flier will be in the April MEWS after which the pre-registration can be set up and the website posted.

At the beginning of the meeting the Seneschal had reminded everyone to leave modern politics out of SCA gatherings. At the end of the meeting he noted that several officers would be coming up on the end of their office tenure. He asked them to consider whether they want to extend their time in office. If they will be stepping down they need to determine when and who will succeed them.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.


