is an honor, and we cannot wait to share that moment with all of you.





Greetings to the Great Populace of Calontir!



— Meeting Minutes —

OFFICERS MEETING, OCT. 2025

October 1 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon, Wichita, KS 67226

24 members attended: 8 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ event stewards; 16 members of the populace

The Seneschal reported on the number of QR contacts from the Renaissance Festival. Officers were reminded to get their quarterly reports in by their due date. Updating of the web site continues.

The Exchequer reported that \$4788 in sales was done at the Festival pop concessions earning the group a \$500 gratuity from Eagles Realm Entertainment. There was also \$95 in donations for the Barony provided food during the Festival weekend. Both have been deposited. The current balance is \$18,267.43.

The Arts and Sciences Minister thanked who did demonstrations and provided displays at the Festival. Planning for on the Minneha School and DYI Day at the Public Library was given.

Their Excellencies encouraged members to attend the Chillies Winterfylleth event October 9th-13th at the Lilies site in Smithville MO. Our two patent pending knights will be elevated at that event. Award recommendations for both Kingdom and Baronial recognition are needed. Any member can make a recommendation for any of the awards.

There being no other business the meeting opened for all the members to discuss the recent Renaissance Festival: good things and improvements.

Fall Great Plains Renaissance Festival discussion

After the October Officers' business meeting a discussion on the recent Renaissance Festival was begun. All present members were welcome to join this 'post mortem.' On the agenda were what things should be continued and what recommendations for improvements should be considered.

Recommendations on specific soda products and signage for the second drinks station and signage for the location of the Festival entrance posted at the back of the site will be passed on to Eagles

Realm Entertainment. Also they will be informed of the patrons' appreciation of the reasonable pricing for beverages and water.

Having a designated camping area out of sight behind the Baronial set up should be continued. It is especially helpful for those out-of-town members who come to help and join us. The kitchen tent is something to continue to do as well. It was suggested to relocate it, possibly behind the Baronial tent, to increase the line of sight to the fighters' shade area. An extra shade fly was suggested and/or using some pop-up walls to increase shade as the day progresses. This could possibly result in more guest access to visit and talk with the fighters. Fighters coming out to talk to the guests was also mentioned. Having the entrance area on the fighting field and line up area to the side opposite the A/S tents was recommended to be continued.

The drumming was mentioned as attracting people to the Dell. More drumming and more drums were recommended. Other music was suggested. Several felt a boombox would be inappropriate. It was noted any additional music would need to keep the audio done during fighting presentations in mind.

On the arts and sciences was suggested to have a clothing dummy dressed in full armor on display. The missile weapons presentation on the field kept people in the Dell when there was no fighting on the field being done. Audience suggested throwing scenarios, i.e. throwing under the leg. Getting the guests involved with the foam axes during the fighting presentations was well received by the guests. It was noted that for safety this would have to be more structured in the future. Bean bags were suggested as an alternative. It was suggested that this could even be a fund raiser 3 bags to throw for \$1. This brought up the idea to bring back archery to the Dell. It was noted it does do well as a fund raiser; but, it also requires a good deal of manpower on top of having the two drink concessions.

It was suggested to do some sort of theme for each Fall and Spring Festival. It was also recommended to do dancing. It was pointed out that dance is done at the Spring Festival with having a May Pole. It was also suggested to have a fun follow up Wednesday meeting after a Festival. This year Officers' was the next Wednesday, not an

interesting follow up for potential new members.

This discussion and white board notes was copied to be used for planning the next Spring Renaissance Festival.

FINANCE MEETING, OCT 2025

A brief, unscheduled meeting of the finance committee was held at Make ICT on October 1, 2025 after the monthly Officers' meeting. Committee members present were HE Robert, HL Brynki, HL Alicia, M. Marie and Ld Kolsveinn representing the populace. Noble Valeriano was also present.

HE Robert requested to take the two Baronial incenatrons to be used at the elevation ceremonies at Chilies Winterfylleth this October. After a brief discussion the motion was made by HE Robert; seconded by HL Alicia. The motion passed.

HL Brynki requested to remove the large green benches from inventory. They were donated to the group some years ago. The benches are cumbersome and seldom used. HE Robert moved to remove the benches as Baronial property. Several seconded the motion. It was approved. The benches will be offered back to the original person before putting out an offer to other individuals and/or groups.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

OFFICERS' MEETING, NOV 2025

November 5, 2025 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon , Wichita, KS 67226

17 members attended: 13 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ event stewards; 4 members of the populace

Winter War Maneuvers will be held here in Vatavia February 21st. The event flier will be updated and submitted shortly. Valor planners will be checking other possible sites before making a final decision on reserving the El Dorado Park site again. HE Robert was approached about being a sponsor for Chilies 2026. There is interest in sponsoring. However no decision will be made until after reviewing this year's Chilies event report.

The November 26 th A and S meeting will be a "Friends-giving"; party starting about 6:30pm. A food sign up sheet will be posted. The New Year's celebration will be scheduled in the near future. It was noted that there could be a conflict with the Make ICT December 3rd ,13th birthday party and our monthly Officers' meeting. Details on Make ICT's party plans will be available later this week.

The Caltrop Herald and Master Jóhann heralded at this year's Chilies event. Master Jóhann will also be heralding the Crown tournament and at Toys for Tots. The status of heraldic proposals in process was provided. The deadline for letters, artwork and submissions to the Dragonflyre is December 10th . HL Alicia has stepped into the Arts and Sciences Minister position.

The Exchequer reported a balance after one check payment of \$18,101.70. HL Alicia will step down as Exchequer the beginning of next year; and , HL Tove will be the new Exchequer. Arrangements and the official posting for members to request their pre-registration payments for the canceled Valor event are still being finalized.

The Knight Marshall is not accepting donations of armored combat equipment. Instead he encouraged fighters to bring extra armor for others to use or to gift items to newer fighters. He stated the loaner armor could use an additional loaner helm, but it is not an immediate need.

The Baronage requested donations of largess and ideas for largess. Their Excellencies have a supply of fabric that could be used to make messenger bags. Work nights can be scheduled to work on those and other largess projects. The remaining tabards for Vindheim are 85% done. Award recommendations were also requested for both the Barony and Kingdom. It was noted that all awards have certain criteria for consideration. The award recommendation form on the Baronial website does work and does forward recommendations.

Officers are encouraged to discuss their offices with interested individuals. Deputies do not necessarily automatically step into an office nor is it required. The Chronicler currently has a deputy. He has no plans to step down immediately. Letters of application are still open for this office to allow for more interested individuals to apply.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

OFFICERS' MEETING, DEC 2025

Dec. 3, 2025 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon, Wichita, KS 67226

23 members were present: 11 Baronage/ officers/ deputies were in the meeting.

Midwinter Knights Dream is December 6th in Theobald. His Excellency Robert encouraged members to come and announced indoor missile activities are planned. The next week December 13th at Kris Kinder two Vatavians will be elevated to the Pelican peerage; His Excellency Robert and Óttarr Surtsson. Winter War Maneuvers is here February 21st. Information will be in the January MEWS and is on the Kingdom website. Starting next year Vatavian Kingdom events will not be cross posted on the Baronial website.

The final decision on equestrian activities at Valor will be made after consulting with Kingdom on the new Society equestrian insurance policies. El Dorado Lake scheduling and reservations open later this month. There is a lake site that can accommodate equestrian activities.

The Chatelaine is working with the Barony's newest member. Caltrop reported on Vatavian heraldic contributions at Toys for Tots. No new information has been received on the status of our proposals in process. The next Dragonflyre deadline December 10th was announced by the Chronicler. It will cover the first quarter information for 2026. Meeting schedules and any changes or cancellations should be turned in its calendar.

The Exchequer will be starting the paperwork to change the bank account information to incoming officers. There have been no transactions in the last month on the account. The end of year report is being compiled. She will be stepping down the beginning

of the year. At that time she will step into the position of Arts and Sciences Minister.

The Knight Marshal explained the new Society policy on fighter re-authorization. It will become a 4-year requirement starting in June 2026. Policy is for both actual fighting and knowledge of current rules and theory fundamentals. Our Knight Marshal suggested everyone re-authorize the beginning of 2026 regardless of the expiration date on their fighter card. The procedure to do this is to be discussed at Kris Kinder.

There will also be an open meeting of the War Council there at 1-2pm. Meister Joachim announced that he is the 'general' for the Gulf War Lobster Tournament, which is a war point, being held the first Monday of the War.

FINANCE MEETING, DEC 2025

A brief, unscheduled meeting of the finance committee was held at Make ICT on December 3, 2025 after the monthly Officers' meeting. Committee members present were HE Robert, HL Brynki, HL Alicia, M. Marie and HL Tove representing the populace.

HE M. Marie had received a request last weekend to bring the Baronial 'erector set' to the Midwinter Knights Dream event December 6th in Theobald College. She moved that this request be approved. HE Robert and HL Brynki both seconded the motion. It was approved. There being no other business at this time HL Alicia moved to close the meeting; HE Robert seconded. The meeting adjourned.




