In the Finals, it shall be best two out of three of three. Each finalist shall select a weapon form for one round. The Crown shall select shield and buckler (no larger than 18 inches) for the final round.

To be considered, fighters **MUST** be able to span their shield, and each couple must submit the following:

- Names of both Fighter and Consort
- Proof of current SCA Membership for the fighter and consort at the time of the tournament
- If membership is due to expire at any time during the reign, proof of renewal within 10 days of winning Crown Tournament will be required
- List of SCA events attended within the past 12 months
- A copy of a legal ID for the fighter and

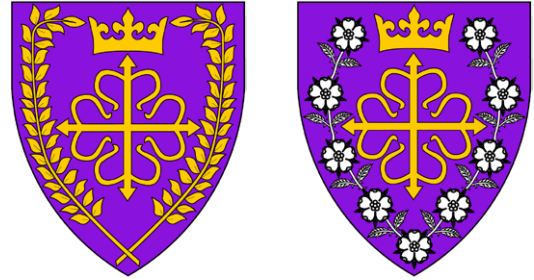
consort. Both must reside in Calontir (or Treaty) and meet the age requirements of Kingdom law.

— Meeting Minutes —

OFFICERS MEETING, SEPTEMBER 2025

September 3, 2025 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon , Wichita, KS 67226

20 members attended: 10 Baronage/ officers/ deputies/ event stewards; 10 members of the populace

Planning for the Renaissance Festival September 27th-28th was discussed. Suggestions for changes to the Dell were made. It was announced that there would be two pop booth concession, one water only. Once again there is a coinciding event, Kingdom Arts and Sciences. Volunteers will need to cover additional areas. Sign up for the pop booths will be posted soon. The Barony will provide Valor food for Dell volunteers. Donations will be requested to help defray the expenses from that event's cancellation. Personal banners are also requested to decorate the Dell. The Óttarr will be coordinating the A and S displays and demonstrations. HL Corrigan had Festival posters for members take to display around town.

The request to assist Westumbria at a demo September 7th at Ft. Hays had to be declined. Our members would not be available with King's Companie of Archers event the same weekend. HL Torin made plans to go help. An invitation to participate in Wichita Public Library's DIY event November 1st is being considered. There is an October 1st deadline to register. Some members have been discussing resuming presenting at local conventions ass recruitment opportunities. It was noted any member can bring a request to the officers for consideration.

The current status of Vatavia heraldic proposals in process was given. There is a 60 anniversary online memorial project. Those wishing to help can do so Wednesday evenings at meetings or personally at the site. The MEWS has the link. The Chatelaine has ordered the business cards. They will be available by the Ren. Festival. The deadline for all submissions and letters, including Champion letters, is September 10th. The Baronial web site OP continues to be updated and past Dragonflyres archived.

The Exchequer reported a balance of \$17,972.48. The Kingdom check for Valor pre-registration in the amount of \$777 has been received and deposited. Emails will be sent to those who pre-registered regarding requesting reimbursement. There will be a deadline to make the request.

Fighter practice will continue outdoors as long as the weather permits before moving indoors. Members are reminded that only SCA members should be allowed entry through the door near the practice site. All Make ICT members and guests are to use the main entry door. The position of Cut and Thrust Marshal is still open. Archery practice information still needs to be posted on the Baronial calendar.

There are applications for the positions of Arts and Sciences Minister and Exchequer. Also a member has expressed interest in the Minister of Youth position. Interviews will be scheduled by the Seneschal and Baronage. The Web Minister will teach anyone interested in learning the system and tools for the position.

His Excellency reminded members to make award recommendations for both Kingdom and Baronial awards.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

OFFICERS MEETING, AUGUST 2025

August 6, 2025 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon, Wichita, KS 67226

9 Baronage/ officers/ deputies There were 8 members of the populace also present.

The Seneschal informed the populace that a non-member of either the SCA or Make ICT had entered the building through a propped open door during a fighter practice. The individual was stopped by a Make ICT member when found roaming around. People at practice need to watch that only members are entering, especially if doors are being left open for easy access for those at fighter practice.

Regional fighter practice is in Theobald August 9th. Winter War Maneuvers 2026 will be in Vatavia. The site is already reserved and paid for. Valor next year will use the plans made for this year. Any member interested in being a co-event steward for either of these events should talk to the steward for each event. It is an opportunity to learn how to host an event. It was noted that majority of the work is already in place.

Champions' will be August 16th at Úlfr's and Alia's manor. Bierocks will be provided by the Barony. Donations will be collected to cover the food cost. Side dishes will be the responsibility of the populace.

The other Valor meats will be used for meals at the Renaissance Festival in September. With Kingdom Arts and Sciences being the same weekend once again all those remaining in the Barony are asked to donate some time to help in the Dell and at the pop booths.

The Arts and Sciences announced that Master Jóhann will do a class on voice heraldry August 29th prior to the Ren. Festival . Caltrop staff updated the status of Vativian proposals in process. The deadline for officer letters and any other submissions to the Dragonflyre is September 10th. The Web Minister has worked on the corrections to the Baronial web site; and, checked and updated entries in the Kingdom OP.

The Exchequer reported a balance of \$18,194.71. She reported that the required Make ICT membership is done through the year; and the storage rental is also paid through December. Officers were asked by the Seneschal to check where they were on their budget for the year. With the cancellation of Valor economizing and delaying expenditures to next year is requested. The Chatelaine is working on a quote for printing business cards which will be needed for the Festival.

The Knight Marshal announced that the new rattan handbook is online. The main issue is that fighters need to read the new guidelines. Major changes are sword and shield is not required as a first authorization; authorizations will be for only 4 years at which time re-authorizing will be required; and thrown weapons are allowed in tournaments. Fighter practice for August 10th will be determined if there are those, especially from outside the Barony, who wish to practice after the regional practice the day before.

The Archer Marshal will be getting access to the Baronial website and calendar in the near future. Currently archery information is available only on the Baronial Facebook site.

The end of the warrant for several officers will be coming up in the near future. There are also open officer positions. The Exchequer will step down at the end of this year. She would like her successor to be involved with the office before then to have an easy transition. Her deputy will be handling the pop booth at the Festival in September. She needs to be at Kingdom arts and Sciences that same weekend. The Arts and Sciences Minister had planned to step down at the Festival but may delay that change of office as well due to the Kingdom event. The Cut and Thrust Marshal and Minister of Youth positions are still open.

The next required bid proposal for the Barony is for Fall Crown 2027 and needs to be submitted by November 2026. This does not mean

that competing bids for any of the Kingdom events- Masters of the Duel, Queen's Prize tourney, Kingdom Arts and Sciences, Coronation, Crown, KCoA- cannot be made and submitted for consideration. Any member can submit a bid for an event they would like to host to the Baronage, Seneschal and populace.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

FINANCE MEETING, AUGUST 2025

Finance minutes 8-6-2025

A brief, unscheduled meeting of the finance committee was held at Make ICT on August 6, 2025 after the monthly Officers' meeting. Committee members present were HE Robert, HL Brinky, Ly Alicia, Ld Úlfr and M. Marie. Members of the populace attending were HL Corrigan, Ld Kentaro, HL Øyrikr, and HL Tove.

Ld Úlfr moved to rent a port-a-john for the Champions' event August 16th at a total cost of \$90.53. HL Brinky seconded the motion; it passed. A motion was made by HL Brinky to use foodstuffs obtained for Valor and frozen when that event was canceled; bierocks to be used at the Champions' event and the hamburgers, hot dogs and brats for meals during Ren Festival in September. Lady Alicia seconded the motion. It passed.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

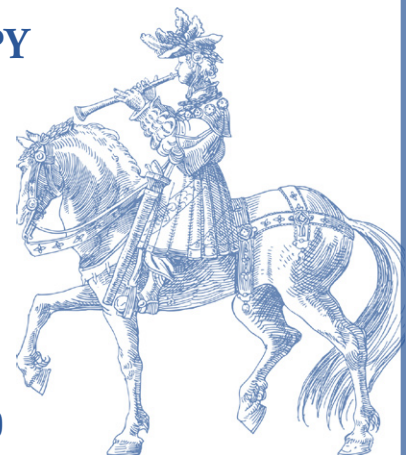
