Calontir moves forward with strength, with pride, and with the unbreakable spirit that has always defined Our Kingdom

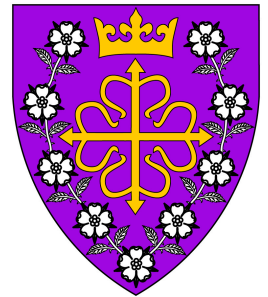
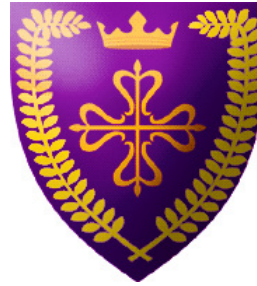

— Meeting Minutes —

OFFICERS MEETING, JAN 2026

January 6 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon, Wichita, KS 67226

20 members were present: 12 Baronage/ officers/ deputies were involved in the meeting.

His Excellency will be attending the Vindheim Coronet Tournament in Stillwater OK January 10th . Others are encouraged to support our neighbor's event. Clothiers is January 24 th in Independence MO where Master Joachim will be elevated as one of the three premiers of Calontir's Order of the Mark. Coronation is February 14 th in Roca, NE just outside, south, of Lincoln, NE. Winter War Maneuvers will be in Vatavia, February 21 st .

The Baronial New Year's party will be January 18 th at Make ICT in conjunction with fighter practice. Make ICT will be asked to extend our scheduled time that day. The Spring Great Plains Renaissance Festival in April is on the same date as Queen's Prize Tournament, April 18th-19 th . His Excellency will attend QPT; Her Excellence Heidi will attend the Ren Festival.

The Chronicler reported that the Dragonflyre has been published and will be posted on the website soon. The Chatelaine has contacted an interested new member whose information was forwarded from Kingdom. Caltrop staff updated the status of heraldic proposals. No presentation requests have been received. No arts and sciences classes have been scheduled yet for this month.

The Baronial account balance is unchanged from last month, \$18,191.70. There has been a request to use last year's Valor pre-registration for this year's event. The Kingdom Exchequer will be contacted to determine the feasibility of this requested transaction. Paperwork is proceeding to transition the office to the incoming Exchequer. This will be done before the current officer's warrant ends in February, There will be a meeting of the finance committee to discuss, modify if needed and approve the budget for 2026.



Fighter practice continues outdoors, weather permitting; and, when inclement, practice will move inside.

The Baronage encourage doing ride shares to away events. Valor 44 will utilize all the plans for the Valor that was canceled last year. The El Dorado site has already been reserved. Vatavia is one of two Baronies that has been asked to sponsor the Kingdom Chilies event in October. The 2026 Baronial budget will be sent to the Kingdom Exchequer. It is one of the requirements to insure a sponsoring group is financially secure to be able to donate to the funding of this event.

The Seneschal reminded officers that year end reports are coming due. The positions of Minister of Youth and Cut and Thrust Minister are still open for interested applicants. Chronicle interviews will be held after the finance committee meeting this evening.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.



FINANCE MEETING, FEB 2026

A meeting of the finance committee was held at Make ICT on February 18, 2026. Committee members present were HE Robert, HL Brynki, HL Alicia, Ld Úlfr, M. Marie and the incoming Exchequer and deputy Seneschal. Four other members of the populace attended.

HL Brynki presented the co-sponsor agreement to host Chilies Winterfylleth III between the Barony of Vatavia and the Barony of Lonely Tower to be held October 10th- 12th, 2026 at Kelsey Short Youth Camp, Smithville MO. The event budget was with the agreement.

The event stewards will be Sir Hálfgrímr hafrek and Sir Emma Ness. plus the Exchequers of both Baronies. The funds will be combined in the Vatavian banking account. Separate expenditure tracking will be maintain much as the Caltrop Herald has done historically: separate accounting ledger but all funds in the Baronial account. All profits, and any losses, to be shared jointly 50/50 percent. Any inventory acquired for the event that remains after the event will be split by a post event agreement. Any expenditure over a budgeted line item amount or over \$200 must be approved by both event stewards and both Baronies. Reporting timelines are stipulated in the agreement.

HL Brynki moved to accept the agreement and budget; Ld Úlfr seconded. The motion passed. There being no other business the meeting adjourned.

An unscheduled meeting of the finance committee was held at Make ICT on February 25, 2026 to request the use of the Baronial scutums and scutarii at Gulf Wars. Present were HE Robert, Sir Brynki, HL Tove, M. Marie and Sir Øyrikr. HE Robert made the request for the scutums, seconded by Sir Brynki; Sir Øyrikr requested the scutarii as well, seconded by Sir Brynki. Both motions passed. There being no other business the meeting closed.

OFFICERS MEETING, FEB 2026

OFFICERS' MEETING February 4, 2026 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon , Wichita, KS 67226
24 members were present: 13 Baronage/ officers/ deputies were involved in the meeting.

Preparations for Winter War Maneuvers are complete. Volunteers will be needed the day of the event for set up. The event's website will be updated with current information. Volunteers and deputies for canceled Valor 2025 have been contacted and confirmed for doing the same responsibilities for Valor 2026. Draft paperwork is at Kingdom to be finalized for the agreement between the Kingdom, Lonely Tower and Vatavia for the two Baronies to sponsor Chilies in October.

The Great Plains Renaissance Festival is April 18th -19 th . This is again the same date as Kingdom Queen's Prize Tournament. With fewer members available to volunteer it might not be feasible to an archery concession in addition to the pop booths. An updated Vatavian photo for Festival promotions materials was suggested.

The Caltrop Herald reported the registration of Master Jóhann's Walker Herald Heraldic Title and HL Matthias's badge. There will be voice heraldry opportunities at Winter War Maneuvers. There are plans to schedule a shield making class. Make ICT has asked that our classes be noted on their calendar for interested individuals to be able to attend. The new Chronicler, Ly. Murasaki will be working with HL Corrigan to transition that office.]

The current balance in the Baronial account is \$18, 191.70. The Society level changes to the bank account for the incoming Exchequer should be completed any day now. Paperwork for pre-registration for Winter War Maneuvers has been submitted.

Sunday fighter practice will not be held the day after Winter War Maneuvers February 22nd and, probably will not be held the Sunday, February 15 th , after Coronation. Practice will be held Super Bowl Sunday since the game is later in the day.

Their Excellencies informed the populace that They will announce at Winter War Maneuvers that They will be stepping down at Valor. Their Court Baronage scroll is to be a Barony populace group project with contributions by all. HL Corrigan will coordinate this.

They encouraged all who can to attend Coronation in Nebraska. At that event largess for Vindheim must be completed for delivery to the Crown. Other Largess will still be needed for Valor.

At this time there is no required Kingdom event bid scheduled for Vatavia until 2027. However, any member interested in putting in a bid for a Kingdom event can do so. Information on the Oaklawn site has been obtained and is available.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.



OFFICERS MEETING, MAR 2026

March 4, 2026 at Make ICT 5920 E Mt. Vernon , Wichita, KS 67226

25 members were present: 16 Baronage/ officers/ deputies were involved in the meeting.

His Excellency Robert instructed everyone going to have fun at Gulf Wars. Winter War Maneuvers reports and paperwork are done. Farha Sports Center would like to have us back next year. A bid is being made to present to Kingdom to host this event again in 2027. The paperwork is being arranged to deputize the area leads and event stewards for Chilies.

Vatavia will be at the Great Plains Spring Renaissance Festival, the same weekend as Queen's Prize which several Vatavians will need to be attending. So once again members will be needed to represent the Barony in the Dell. Valor planning continues with a few changes from the planning made for last year's canceled event. It was stressed that Valor will happen whatever the weather. Some deputy positions were filled at this meeting. The entire schedule will be posted soon. There will be 2 vigils and one elevation at the event.

Caltrop summarize the contributions made by the Vatavian heraldic staff during Winter War Maneuvers. A couple of new members have name proposals in process. The Baronial web site has been updated and current. The calendar has been moved to the front page for quick access. There were no reports for Arts and Sciences, Property Master, Archery, Chatelaine, Chronicler, nor new demonstration requests from the community.

The Knight Marshal announced that there would be no fighter practice the Sundays of Gulf Wars. The last three weeks saw 6 authorizations for local members. The Marshal asked fighters to consider loaning or selling any old, no longer used armor to the newer fighters.

There is a Vatavian bid to be presented to the financial committee for Vatavia to host this year's King's Companie of Archers event in September. This November the scheduled rotation bid for Fall Crown 2027 is due from Vatavia. A submittable bid using the Oaklawn Activity Center site from Spring Crown already exists. All that is needed is an event steward. It was noted this site would also work for Kingdom Arts and Sciences for this year and next year's Queen Prize. The Seneschal strongly encourages that bids be turned in for these events.

Several convention presentation possibilities are being researched. Several for this year coincide with Gulf Wars and Lilies. Unfortunately some conventions require membership and /or booth rentals. Specific details are being checked for Tsunami Con in Wichita. Two other cons members participate in will be checked.

Several officers are coming to the end of their term this July. Each officer present was asked if they had ideas about successors to their position. The Seneschal /Web Minister will be stepping down the end of this year. Caltrop is helping others learn the position since she steps down in July. The Knight Marshal announced he would step down at Valor along with Their Excellencies. The Chatelaine has a deputy that may take over. The positions of Minister of Youth and Cut and Thrust Marshal are still vacant. The possible end date for those not present were mentioned.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.
